OHRP is asking you to narrow the scope of this assignment. There have been 52 IRB registration applications submitted by Mount Sinai to our office in the timeframe specified (from 1 Jan 2013 onward). While printing all of the applications in HATS was relatively straightforward, opening the logs for each of the 52 applications to search for initial correspondence through HATS, and then asking our team to search emails related to each of those 52 applications, will be quite burdensome and may not yield any correspondence.

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Is it possible to provide the 52 applications and see whether the requester would consider rescoping the request to focus on correspondence related to a smaller subset of the applications (e.g. the most recent application)?

Until our office receives further clarification from you, your request will remain on hold. If you have not contacted our office within 30 business days from the date of this letter, your request will be administratively closed. Therefore, no action on your part is needed, if you no longer have a need for the records.
