Rally/March Security Plan

OBJECTIVES

- Get everyone there and HOME safe, sound, and without injury or arrest!
- Clearly communicate the entire plan to all Scouts, Team Leads, and High Level Security Contacts
- STICK TO THE PLAN AT ALL TIMES, unless unfolding events dictate otherwise.

RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

1. When any threat is perceived – it is to be radioed immediately to the Security Team Leadership!
2. No Violence is to be Initiated by any Proud Boy at any time! Only if a violent act is committed against a Proud Boy or any attendee of the event are Proud Boys to engage – this is the very meaning of FAFO!!
3. If any violence does spout off, all Proud Boys are expected to respond immediately – only so far as to eliminate and end that threat to them or others. VERY IMPORTANT: Once the threat has been neutralized, WE STOP!! If a Brother is going to the extreme, we pull them back and get them to the back of the line IMMEDIATELY! ***(We have 2 Brothers serving a 4-Year Prison Sentence in NYS for the mere appearance of taking things too far.)***
4. While trolling is a part of what the Proud Boys actively do at rallies and events...this security team MUST be constantly looking around for any perceived threats – we must be poised and calm, even if people are yelling and saying things we might not like or disagree with. The safety of everyone at this event is at stake, and it is up to us to ensure all attendees get home safe and sound!
5. If any Proud Boy engages with any potential threat – BLM or Antifa or agitator – ALWAYS watch hands for weapons - especially skateboards, pipes, bats, knives, bottles of urine, and mace! ***CALL OUT IMMEDIATELY if any weapons are seen, to alert your Brothers!!*** Recognizing these weapons fast and having time to react could be the difference between having the time necessary to eliminate that threat...or getting seriously hurt!
6. No Weapons such as Mace, Batons, Brass Knuckles, Knives with blade longer than 3", stun guns, guns, or other such weapons are allowed in NYC – even for defensive purposes. Please be aware of this, because if these are found on your person, in your possession, or used in any way – it may lead to your arrest. Please be smart about this and wear adequate PPE. Recommendations include Knife/Stab protection, helmets, gloves, boots, etc.
7. If any Normie/MAGA person begins to get into it with a counter-protestor – we are to immediately get in between them and the counter-protestor, deescalate the situation, and get them away from the counter-protestors.

EVENT SECURITY PLAN

Purpose.

The purpose of this Event Security Plan is to create and implement a well-defined, strategic, and organized framework with the chief of objectives being to keep all event attendees safe and secure by quickly identifying, communicating, responding to, and mitigating any threat as quickly as possible. This includes working with Event Organizers, Event Security Personnel, and Law Enforcement personnel – as may be required and necessary to achieve these objectives.

Area(s) of Security Attention

Primary Gathering Location

Columbus Circle, NYC (8th Ave between W 59th Street and W. 61st Street)

Primary March Route (See MAP Addendum 9)

Columbus Circle (W59th St and 8th Ave) to Penn Station (W33rd St and 7th Ave) via. W59th to 5th Ave to W33rd Street to 7th Ave. @PENN STATION (W33rd St and 7th Ave).

Secondary March Route (See MAP Addendum 9)

Columbus Circle to 7th Ave from W59th to W32nd Street @PENN STATION.

Back-Up March Route (See MAP Addendum 9)

Columbus Circle to W59th to 9th Ave to W31st Street to 7th Ave @PENN STATION.

EQUIPMENT

We will be using 3 Modes of Communications throughout this event, to include 2-Way Multi-Channel Radios, the ZELLO Walkie-Talkie app for smart phones, and the Telegram App for smart phones. Should all of these fail, we will fall back to regular phone and/or texting.

Two-Way Radios – 22 Channel w/16 Sub-Channels

These will be used by the Security Officers (listed above) and the Team Leads. As these radios can only be used reliably via. Line of Sight – this should work well for both the Speaker portion of the vent, as well as during the March.

Zello App – 3 Separate Channels will be Created for Use

PB110 Leadership Channel – to be used by Security Officers ONLY

PB110 Scout Channel – to be used by Scout Team

PB110 Crew Channel – to be used by all Security Team Members

Telegram APP – 3 Separate Channels will be Created for Use

Telegram APP will be used as a fail-over or Back-up Comms to relay pertinent information, drop Location Pins (as may be necessary or applicable), and allow Security Team Members (Team Members and Scouts) to upload photos or video in real time.

PB110 Leadership Channel – to be used by Security Officers ONLY

PB110 Scout Channel – to be used by Scout Team

PB110 Crew Channel – to be used by all Security Team Members

Overwatch Command Center:

We will have an Over-Watch position for this rally. This will be someone located remotely from the event who will be monitoring all available BLM and/or Antifa Social Media channels and groups. In addition, they will be monitoring Police Scanners to get first-hand information about potential threats – and will relay this information to Security Leadership, Scout Team, Medics, and Security Members as he feels it to be necessary – using the communication channels established above.

Mobility Tactical Teams:

(1) VP of Team Leads – Zach – this person will be responsible for communicating information from Scouts, Leadership, and/or the Overwatch Command Center to the team leads as quickly as possible. The VP of Team Leads will monitor the placements of the different groups, and will be the one to make the decision on where the Team Leads and their Mobility teams need to go when a threat arises.

(7) 5-8-Man Groups – Each Group will have a Team Lead that will be responsible for communication with leadership and scouts; ensure that Normies and Females do not involve themselves within their team, and that all Team members stay together and move as a cohesive unit. All Team Members are responsible for sticking close and keeping their Team Lead nearby at ALL TIMES. When the Team Lead gives the sign or signal to move – it is imperative the entire team moves as a single unit, quickly and professionally.

Scout Lookout Teams:

(1) VP of Scouts – This person will be responsible for ensuring all Scouts are in their Pre-Designated places/posts – and move to their next posts or locations at the right time. This person will also assess any threat reported by the scouts and communicate that assessment with Security Leadership Team.

(10) 1-Man Teams – All Scouts will be dressed in dark clothing, complete with masks and hoods/hats/etc. All Scouts will NOT wear PB colors, for the sole purpose of blending in. Each Scout will immediately relay any threat sighted to the VP of Scouts, giving them the greatest amount of information regarding the threat as possible. If a scout sees many counter-protestors either forming, advancing, or about to penetrate our

perimeter – they are immediately to sound a MAYDAY call to ensure the proper attention is given to the rising threat.

All Scouts will communicate with each other and the VP of Scouts using a dedicated Zello channel. This will allow all scouts to use their Smartphones with a Bluetooth or wired ear piece to help blend in and avoid detection.

If at any time any Scout is identified or recognized, they are to immediately walk away – without engaging – and double-time it to the center of the event attendees, letting the VP of Scouts know as soon as it is safe to do so! The VP of Scouts will relay the threat to the VP of Team Leads, so that a Tactical Mobilization team can immediately respond to the threat.

The scouts will take their directions, assignments, and duties from the VP of Scouts – David of the NYC Chapter. **We are actively seeking volunteers to be SCOUTS!**

Medical Staff:

We will have possibly as many as 7 PBs within our ranks that have had military or specialized MEDIC Training. These team members will be carrying FirstAID and/or Trauma Kits with them. Should any medical need arise, Leadership will put the call out to the nearest Team Lead and ask that the team responds to that medical emergency. Once our identified MEDIC is on the scene, they are to immediately take over the situation until Medical Emergency personnel show up. While this is happening the rest of the team will be acting in a support/security role for the Medic. **We are actively seeking volunteers to be MEDICS.**

DSS – Dignity Security Service Team

We will also be asking for up to 10 volunteers to help escort and protect any dignitaries that attend or speak at this event. While some dignitaries will require a 2-Person team, most will get a 1-Person team. Each DSS Team member will communicate directly with Security Officers and may listen into the Public chats for the event to learn real-time any threat is coming.

SECURITY BRIEFING SUNDAY, JANUARY 10 – 8:00AM – LOCATION NAMED AT SATURDAY BRIEFING

- Ingress (8:00AM) – All PBs to meet at Penn Station at the Large AMTRAK Open Area at 8:00AM
- Review Last Minute Plans (8:15AM) – Adapt/Adjust Plans, as may be necessary

- Review and Test all Comms (8:30AM) – ensure all Scouts, Team Leads, and Security Officers have comms! Ensure all Team Members have Zello and Telegram setup and configured on their phones.
- Ensure Assignments for Scouts are Clear, and Scouts know their Position
- Prayer and PB Creed (9:10AM)!
- Egress (9:15AM) – All Scouts leave and travel on their own, without Colors. All others board the 2 or 3 Train together and take the subway to Columbus Circle. Everyone stays together the entire time.

ADDENDUM 2. CIVIL DISTURBANCE PLAN (CDP)

If at any time there is a civil disturbance, the following is to be followed by all Security Detail personnel:

1. Force/Violence is ONLY to be used when initiated first by opposition, or if there is perceived to be an imminent threat of bodily harm to anyone associated with the Event.
2. Force/Violence USED – when required – is ONLY to eliminate the immediate threat, or until Law Enforcement personnel arrive and take over the situation.
3. NEVER is Force/Violence to be used after the initial threat has been mitigated. Continuing with violence will subject those involved to potential arrest and/or criminal prosecution. THIS CANNOT HAPPEN!
4. NYPD will be on scene to provide preliminary security, and at all times the PB Scouts and Tactical Teams are to obey any instructions given by Law Enforcement. We are there as the first line of defense for all event attendees – it is the job of Law Enforcement officers present to protect the Peaceful Assembly and Protest taking place. We are ONLY there in a back-up role and to force them to do their jobs, as may be necessary.
5. If a threat is encountered, Security Team Officers will assess the threat and mobilize tactical teams by relaying the threat and location to the Team Leads. If only 1 or 2 or 3 Tactical Teams are required – all other Tactical Teams are Required to stay in place and NOT respond to the threat area. Doing so could jeopardize the Safety and Health of the other attendees – and open up our flanks to further threats. Team Members MUST follow their Team Lead AT ALL TIMES!
6. If a large gathering of Counter-Protestors approach the event at any time – a MAYDAY Call will go out to all Tactical Teams to report as quickly as possible to the perimeter closest to the threat. All PB Tactical Team Members will mobilize immediately to the threat location, while all available SCOUTS will slowly work to flanks of Attendees to provide look-out for any other threat from another direction.
7. In the case of individual scouts, photographers, or other personnel deemed to be a potential threat to the event or its attendees – the call will go out for the closest Tactical Team to respond to that threat directly. The intent here is to approach, identify, ask them to leave – and if they refuse – to get Law Enforcement involved. We are to remain between such persons and the event attendees until Law Enforcement successfully removes them from the venue – or until the MARCH has moved past the identified threat.
8. At no point are Normies or Females allowed to be within the ranks of our tactical teams. It will be the responsibility of each Team Lead to get them to stand back and get out of our ranks. Their presence will jeopardize the health and safety of all those involved with Security, and simply cannot be allowed to happen!

ADDENDUM 3. Intrusion Detection PLAN (IDP)

The foundation of the Intrusion Detection Plan are the Scouts we deploy around the vicinity, specifically to actively watch and surveil specific areas of the general location of events (POSTS). It is through this network of scouts that the rest of the team(s) will be notified and pinpoint people of interest, antagonists, and other mounting threats.

Scouts will be dressed in plain clothes so as not to draw attention to themselves. They will be trained and instructed to NOT engage with any counter-protestor, and to carry on without dialogue. Should they find themselves in a situation that has the threat of being or turning hostile – they will immediately evacuate to the center of the Event Attendees, alerting the VP of Scouts to their status and location as soon as reasonably safe to do so. When a Scout sends out a MAYDAY alert, the VP of Team Leads will immediately dispatch the closest Mobile Tactical Response team to the location of the threat.

SCOUT POST ASSIGNMENTS

Starting Time/Speaking Time – 10AM-11AM

All Scouts will need to be in their assigned place by 9:45AM and will leave those posts at 10:45AM and move to their "MARCH TIME" Post. All Scouts will immediately report any potential threat or problem area. We will have Mobile Tactical Teams that will move immediately to address any threat that may exist.

March Time – 11AM-1PM

Once the Front of the March reaches within a block of a Scout, they will immediately move to their "Tag" up Location. All Scouts will immediately report any potential threat or problem area. We will have Mobile Tactical Teams that will move immediately to address any threat that may exist.

ADDENDUM 4. BACK-UP & CONTINGENCY PLAN (BCP)

Prior to the start of the march, if our Scouts notify us of any gathering threats to the Primary Route of the march, we will immediately switch to the Secondary Route.

Prior to the start of the march, if our Scouts notify us of any gathering threats to the Primary AND Secondary Route, we will immediately divert to the Back-Up Route.

If all three routes are compromised, we will immediately stop/pause the march and ALL PBS will be asked to go immediately to the perimeter of the group – closest to where the threat is coming from. All available scouts will fall back and provide a supportive role on the perimeter of the crowd furthest away from the perceived threat to watch the rear and flanks.

Once the threat is eliminated, the scouts will immediately re-assume their posts along the march route, and upon sufficient report back – the march will resume as planned.

Throughout the entire march, NYPD and Law Enforcement are expected to provide Front, Side, and Rear escorts. At all times we are to immediately obey any and all lawful orders. Please remember, we are all involved to augment Local Law Enforcement, and step up and fill in the gaps when they fail to do their jobs.

ADDENDUM 5. Security Threat Levels (STLs)

CATEGORY I (MAXIMUM LEVEL SECURITY THREAT).

This level of security risk assessment is required for any area containing the highest-potential threat to event attendee security. Any compromise would have an immediate and disastrous effect on safety and well-being of those present.

CATEGORY II (ADVANCED LEVEL SECURITY THREAT).

This level of security is required for an area containing a significant security interest/defensive area threat potential during the event. The total security effort for these areas should provide a high probability of detection and assessment or prevention of unauthorized penetration or approach to perimeter of the event location/route.

CATEGORY III (INTERMEDIATE LEVEL SECURITY THREAT).

This level of security is required for an immediate and growing threat to the overall event. The total security effort for these areas should provide a reasonable probability of detection/assessment/prevention of unauthorized penetration, approach, and removal of unwanted or suspicious persons. In this case PBs will provide initial threat de-escalation until Law Enforcement can remove the threat completely.

CATEGORY IV (BASIC LEVEL SECURITY THREAT).

This level of security is established to protect the event location/route for the principal purpose of providing administrative control, safety, or a buffer area of security restriction for event attendees. The total security effort for these areas should provide a reasonable probability of detection/assessment/prevention of unauthorized penetration, approach, and removal of unwanted or suspicious persons. In this case PBs will provide initial threat de-escalation until Law Enforcement can remove the threat completely.

CATEGORY V (BASIC LEVEL SECURITY CONCERN).

This level of security is established to provide administrative control, safety, or a buffer area of security restriction for the event area/route area. The total security effort for these areas should provide a reasonable probability of detection/assessment/prevention of unauthorized penetration, approach, and the removal of unwanted or suspicious persons. In this case PBs will provide initial threat de-escalation until Law Enforcement can remove the threat completely.

ADDENDUM 6. VULNERABLE AREAS (VAs)

There are several areas that pose a greater threat to the safety of the event attendees. Recognizing these vulnerable areas will enable us to be on heightened alert and better prepared for potential threats.

COLUMBUS CIRCLE

As this is the area where all the event attendees will gather and remain stationary while listening to the Speakers, this is absolutely one of the Key Vulnerable Areas. Here we must ALWAYS remain diligent, have our Scouts pre-positioned, and all work together to identify anything suspicious, anyone taking pictures and scouting for the opposition, or anyone or anything else that looks out of place.

CENTRAL PARK

As the march begins, and heads towards the Southeast corner of Central Park, there is a lot of open area where potential threats could present themselves. We will have Scouts pre-positioned along the entire way, reporting any threat to the Security Officers. The Mobile Tactical Teams will need to be agile, attentive, and ready to move at a moment's notice!

TRUMP TOWER

Any Counter-Protestor that decides to turn out against this event that day will undoubtedly expect our march to pass by Trump Tower – specifically because this is a MAGA March, and that spot is understood in a very public way to hold special meaning for us. WE WILL NOT DISAPPOINT!

However, please keep in mind that Secret Service and the NYPD heavily patrol this area. While this is designated as a Vulnerable Area, there will be a very large Law Enforcement presence here. Therefore, it will be our primary job to be in our place, be alert and attentive, and identify any potential threat as quickly as possible. A huge part of this will be our Scouts that will constantly be on the move – positioned to scout down blocks on either side of the March Route, and identify any large gatherings or groups of people that may pose a threat.

ST. PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL

On New Year's Day there was a large gathering of BLM and Antifa protestors outside of St. Patrick's Cathedral. These protestors engaged and was very violent with police, carried out a great deal of vandalism and graffiti to the outside of this place of worship. As such, we will need to be very mindful of this clash with police, and what they may try to do to jeopardize or end this march.

Rockefeller Center

Just past St. Patrick's Cathedral on the other side off 5th Avenue is Rockefeller Center. This is a large area where potential counter-protestors could gather, so we will need to be very vigilant. Anything out of the ordinary that is seen must be reported up the chain immediately so that it can be dealt with appropriately.

BRYANT PARK

The side of Bryant Park that we will be crossing has a large building separating the actual open park area from where we will be marching. We will use this to our favor, and will have scouts well placed around the entire venue.

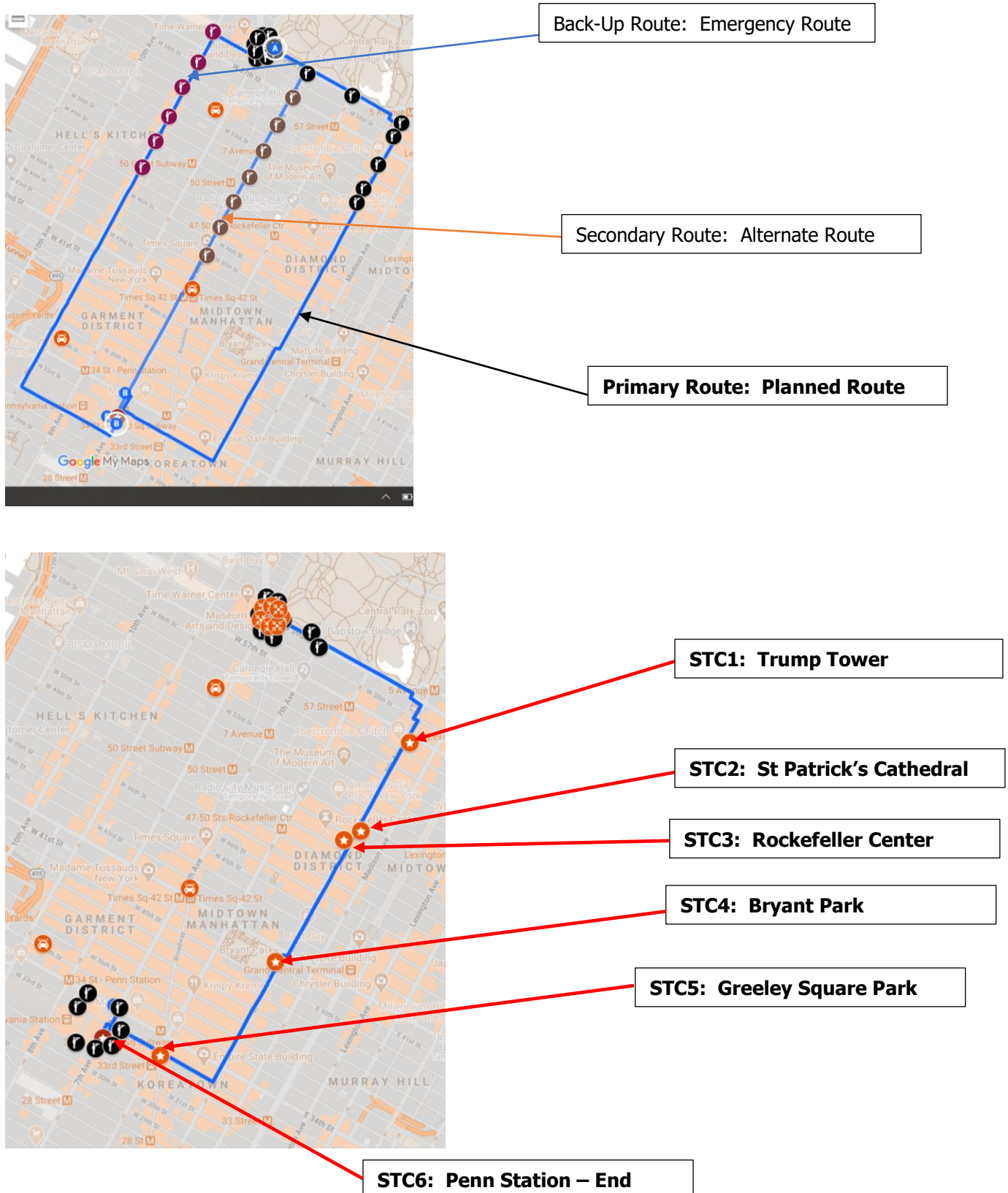
GREELEY SQUARE PARK

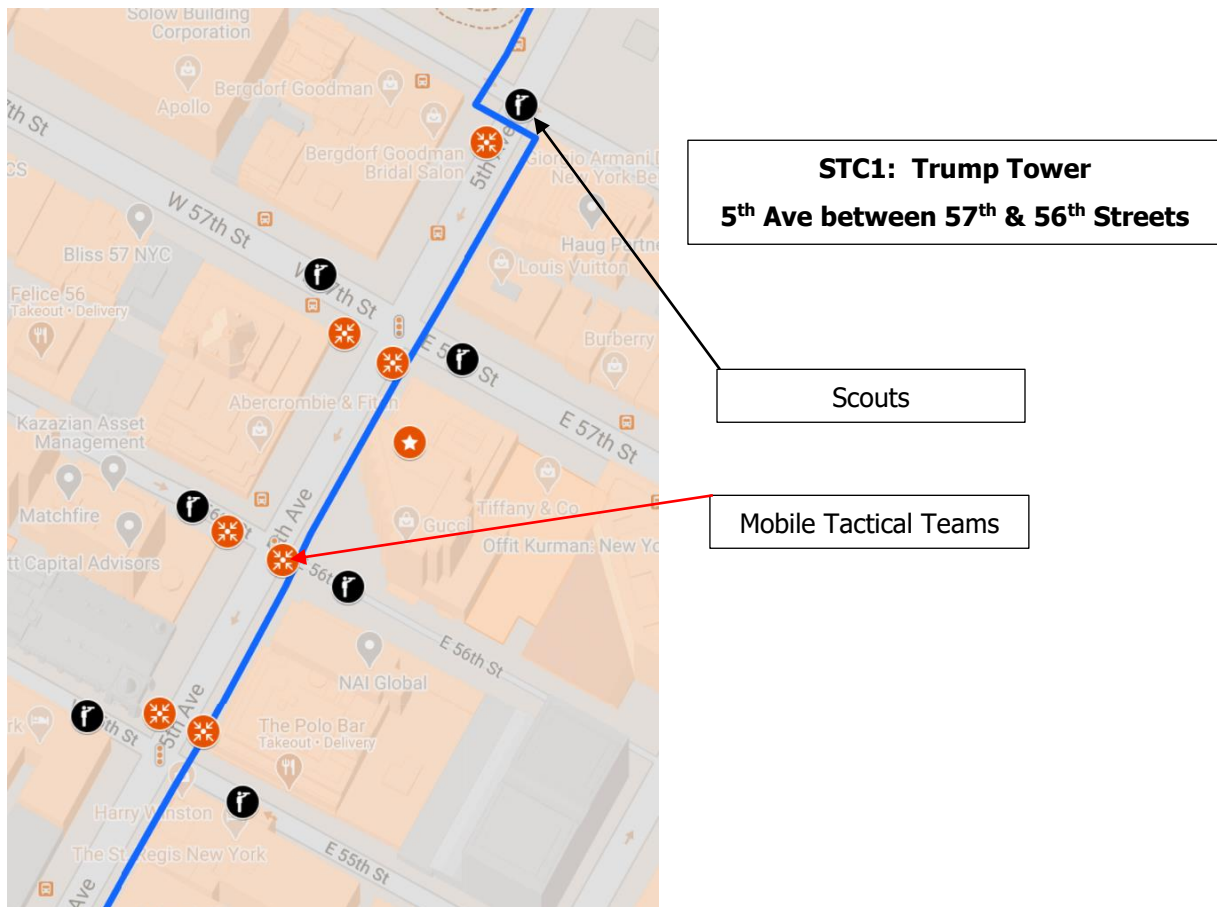
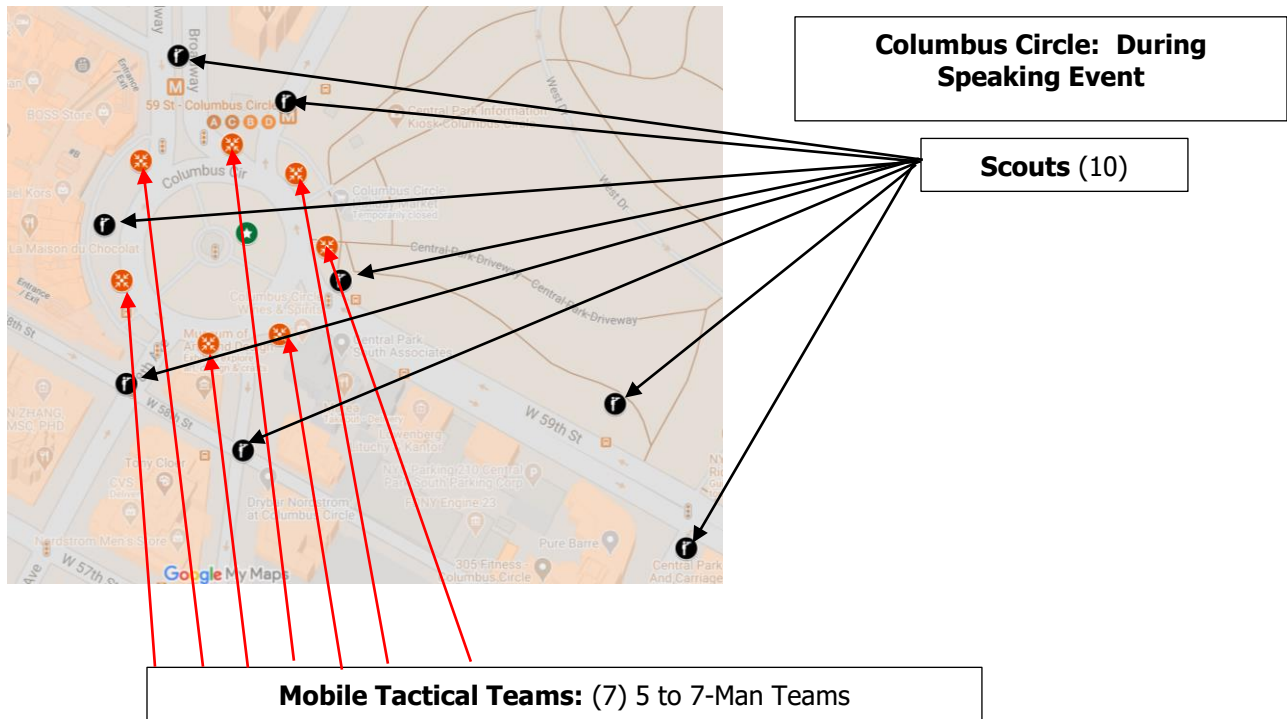
While smaller than Bryant Park, Greeley Square Park poses a slightly different threat – as there are often larger groups of people in this area, and much of the time are a bit more hostile to Patriots than other Vulnerable Areas that have been identified above. Add to this the proximity to Times Square, we will need to pay special attention to any growing Counter Protests groups amassing at this location. As at Bryant Park, we will have Scouts pre-positioned and monitoring the situation before the march even reaches this area.

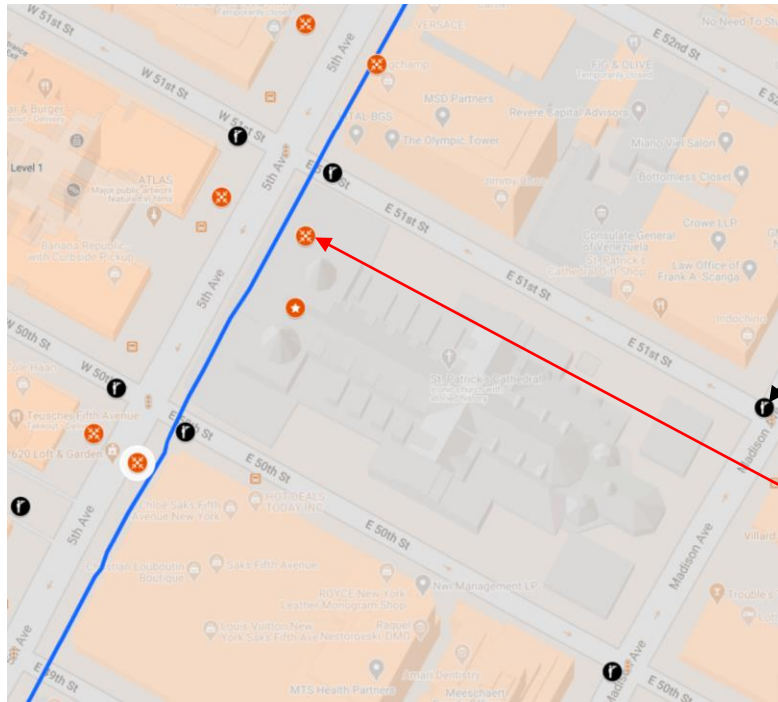
PENN STATION

The last of the Vulnerable Areas will be Penn Station – the FINAL DESTINATION of our march. This is an area always buzzing with a lot of people, especially around Madison Square Garden. However, we do expect to have a relatively large NYPD and Law Enforcement presence here to help mitigate any threat. Our biggest objective at this location is to get people on their way back to their homes quickly and safely. Scouts will be pre-positioned on the perimeter and will be keeping a watchful eye for any threats or numbers that may amass.

ADDENDUM 9. Route MAP & Security Threat Concerns



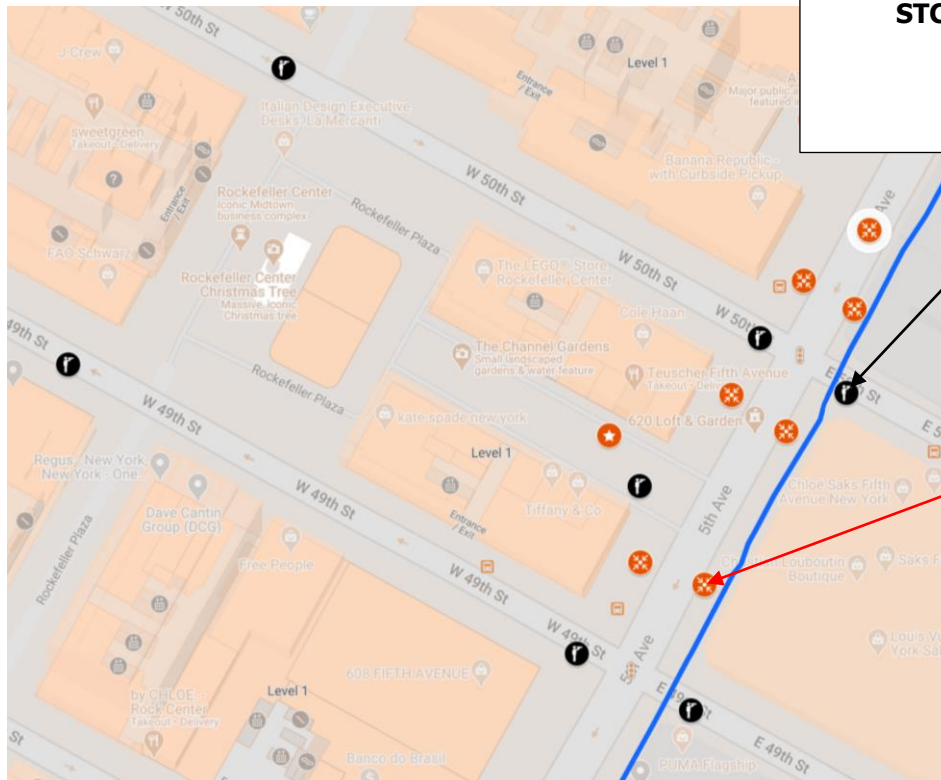




**STC2: St Patrick's Cathedral

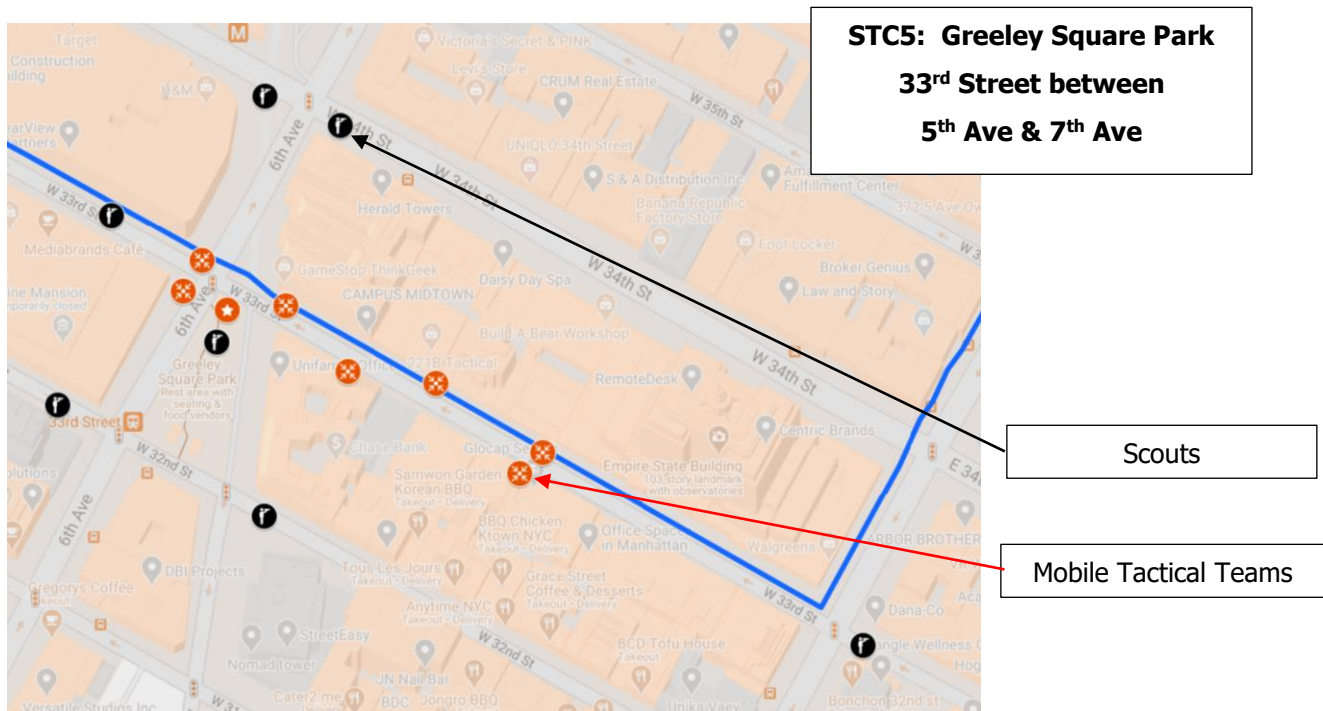
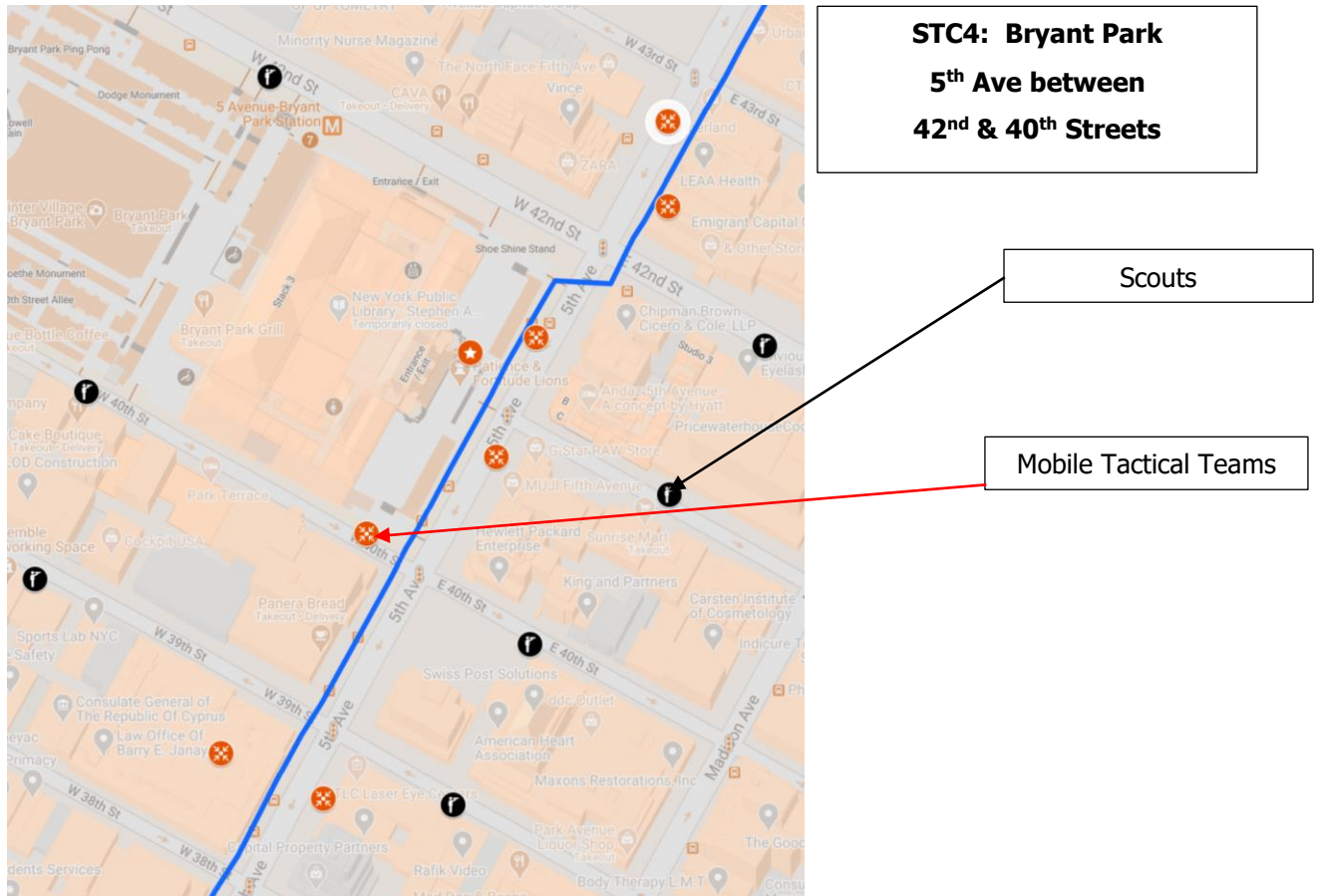

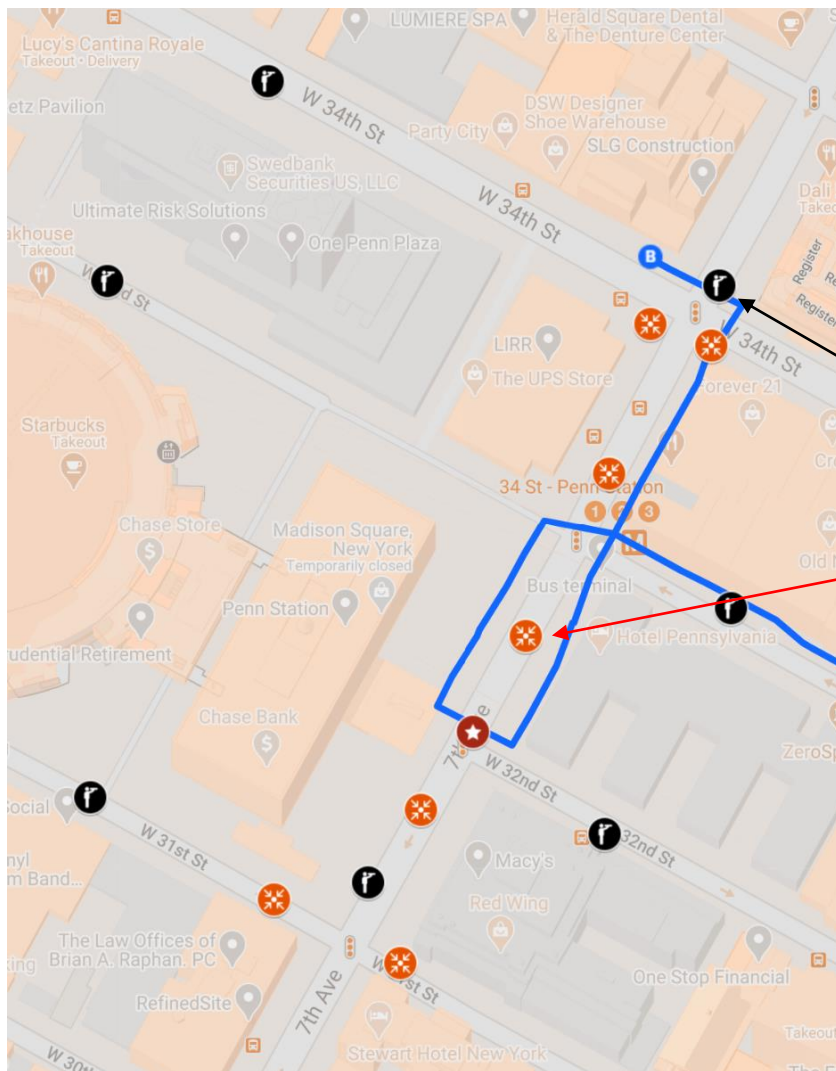


**STC3: Rockefeller Center

ADDENDUM 10 – Logistics and Lodgings

HOTEL RECOMMENDATIONS

There are many hotels around NYC. The recommended areas to stay would be Madison Square area, Times Square area, Bryant Park area. The most cost-effective options are generally in the Wall Street district area. Priceline, Orbitz, Travelocity are all good options for seeing what is available for deals.

As Penn Station will be the focal point for leaving the city, we would highly recommend the Madison Square or Times Square areas for hotel options. These areas generally have a larger public/tourist presence and would be safer to walk around than other areas.

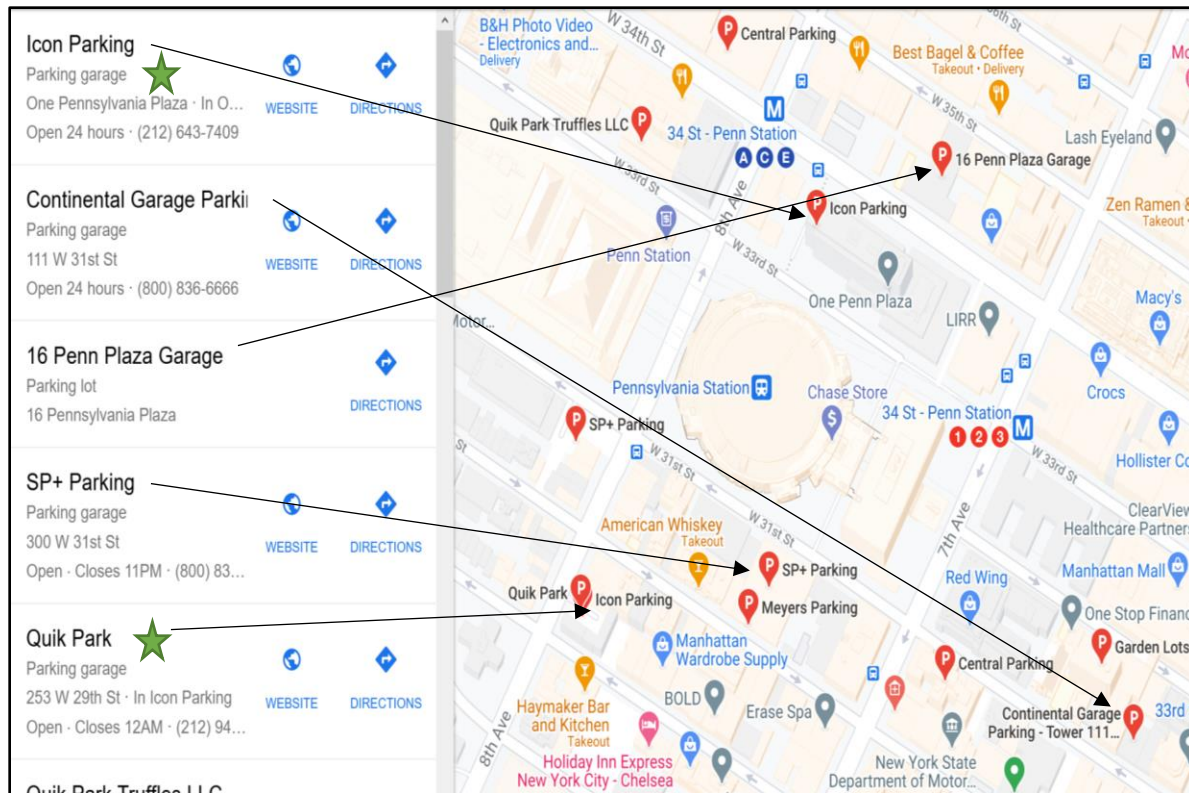
CAR PARKING

LEAVING THE CITY

As there is no NYC in-door dining at this time, the consensus is to take the LIRR to a location in Long Island closest to the City. We will have reservations, and this will be communicated at the Security Briefings. The easiest way to make this happen would be for us to travel in large groups to the destination (30-40 min Train Ride) and returning from the destination. We will make every attempt to travel in large groups to accommodate times when the various groups will need to leave the city to head home.

OVERALL RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Travel in Groups as much as possible!***
- 2. Stay as close to Penn Station as possible, if getting hotel accommodations.***
- 3. Take UBER and/or Lyft and/or Taxis whenever possible – safest mode!***
- 4. Do NOT wear colors coming to and from, unless in large enough groups to ensure your own safety! Cover it or bring it in a backpack.***
- 5. ALWAYS be aware of your surroundings, and always have a plan should a threat be encountered.***
