Defendant shall file a dispositive motion or, in the alternative, a report setting forth the schedule for the completion of its production of documents to plaintiff, on or before May 3, 2022." On May 3, 2022, the agency filed a timely response 14 informing the Court that it had already produced some materials and withheld others, and respectfully requesting an additional 30 days to inform the Court of its determination of whether it would file a dispositive motion or propose a schedule for the production of additional materials. This report was not inconsistent with the Court's order, and in light of the request for additional time, the agency is hereby ORDERED to file a status report on June 2, 2022 proposing either a schedule for the briefing of dispositive motions or a schedule for the completion of its document production.
