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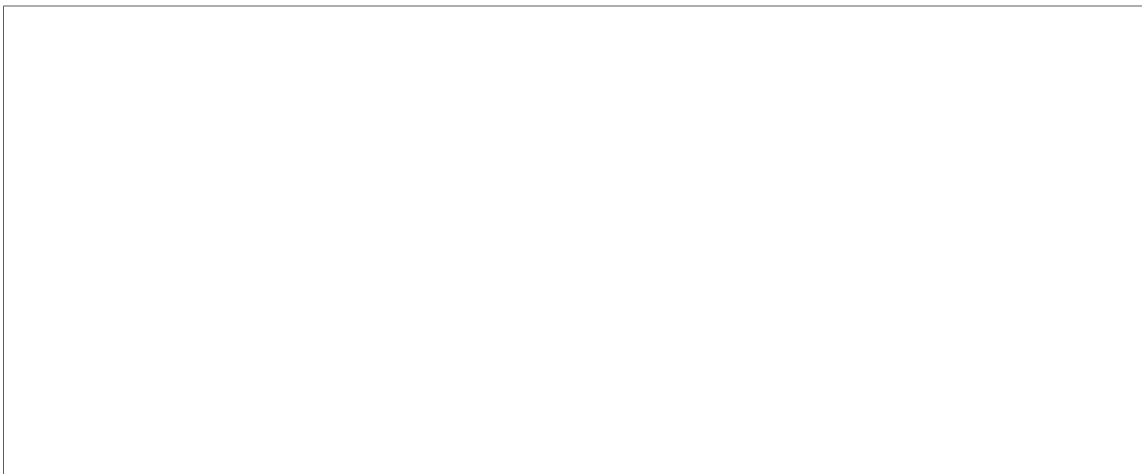

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Concurrence in Amendment No. 4 to Contracts Nos. SC-60 and SC-60 (R) with Lockheed Aircraft Corporation, RELATHING, Project [redacted]

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3. Fiscal Year 1962 funds in the amount of \$2,100.00 chargeable to Project [redacted] should be obligated to cover this requirement.
