On 09/19/22 at approximately 11:45 p.m., Sergeant McGladrie #4383 was contacted by Lieutenant Luckenbaugh of the Howard County Special Investigations Division in reference to a subject currently located in the Woodlawn Precinct. Lieutenant Luckenbaugh furnished Sergeant McGladrie with a Mount Airy Police Department police report in reference to a subject possibly attempting to manufacture a homemade explosive device. The Mount Airy police report stated that a female complainant, Kimberly [REDACTED], FW DOB [REDACTED], received a text message from her daughter, Kristen [REDACTED]. The text message stated, "And idk what psycho shit he is planning i saw him looking up how to mwke flash bang, bombs, he has a gun and a crossbow he just bought more." She further furnished cell phone photographs of the following:

- A large stainless steel pot on a portable electric hot plate. The pot contained a cloudy liquid with blue particles floating in it.
- A strainer in a bathtub containing blue granules.
- The subject (Joseph Vickery M/W [REDACTED]) carrying a plastic bucket in a hotel room.
- A bag of Scotts Turf builder Ultrafeed.

Kimberly [redacted] advised the Mount Airy Police that she believed she was Joseph Vickery's intended target of a homemade bomb due to a recent issue she had with him. Kimberly [redacted] advised the Mount Airy Police that her daughter and Joseph Vickery have no fixed address and have been staying at different hotels around Columbia, MD. The report information was forwarded to the FBI and the ATF and to the Howard County Police Department. During their investigation, Howard County was granted an emergency ping on Joseph Vickery's cell phone. The phone was currently showing at the Rodeway Inn located at 1654 Whitehead Court in Woodlawn.

Information obtained from the Mount Airy police report provided Joseph Vickery's vehicle information which is a [redacted]. Uniformed officers went to the Rodeway Inn and conducted surveillance on Joseph Vickery's vehicle. It was determined at that time, to not attempt to make contact by knocking on the door due to the late hour and the fact that Joseph Vickery was supposedly armed. Officers made contact with the front office at the Rodeway in and confirmed that Joseph Vickery was listed to room 207 and he is

due to check out on 09/21/22. Sergeant McGladrie forwarded all of the above information to the Woodlawn Precinct's Investigative Services Team for further investigation.
During the morning hours of 09/20/22, Detectives Davis #5219 and Kolb #5678, from the Woodlawn Precinct's Investigative Services Team, conducted surveillance on room 207 of the Rodeway Inn. Joseph Vickery's 2001 Ford F-150 was not observed parked in the area of the hotel. Around 8:56 a.m., a white female, positively identified by her MVA photo as Kristen Lee Vickery FW [redacted] exited room 207 and placed trash in the trash can on the sidewalk in front of room 209. Kristen Vickery returned to the room and obtained more trash. She then placed that trash in the trash can on the sidewalk in front of room 215 and returned to room 207 and shut the door. Around 9:11 a.m., Detective Temple #4789 recovered the trash from both trash cans. The trash was then picked up by Detectives Davis and Kolb and was transported to the Woodlawn Precinct to be searched. A search of the trash by Detectives Davis and Kolb revealed the following:

It should be noted that a credit/debit card ending in [redacted] was used to make the purchases documented on all four receipts. The Walmart receipt containing the propane tanks and stoves was in a white bag with the paperwork in the name of Kristen Vickery.
After examining the items recovered from the trash cans and reviewing the items purchased on the receipts, Detectives Davis and Kolb believed through their training, knowledge and experience that the items were precursors for manufacturing explosive devices. The Baltimore County Bomb Squad was requested to assist with this investigation.
Due to the serious risk to public safety, Sergeant Cougnet #4617, from the Woodlawn Precinct's Investigative Services Team, obtained an emergency ping through T-Mobile on Joseph Vickery's cell phone [redacted]. T-Mobile complied with the request and the phone was showing on the parking lot of Pine Grove Middle School located at 9200 Old Harford Road, Parkville, MD 21234. Investigative units were directed to the area to attempt to locate Joseph Vickery.

A large perimeter was set and evacuations were conducted around Pine Grove Middle School and the area around the Rodeway Inn.

The propane cylinders are often used as an additional heat source or container for an improvised explosive device. The hot plate and steel pot are often used for the manufacturing of improvised homemade explosives. The strainer is a common component used to filter precursors/energetic materials used in manufacturing of explosives. The coffee grinder is also used to grind ammonium nitrate pellets and other energetic materials to a fine powder used in the manufacturing of improvised homemade explosives. The Scotts Turf Builder is a common fertilizer containing urea which is a chemical commonly used in the production and manufacturing of improvised homemade explosives. Lastly, the components of the remote controlled car are commonly used in the manufacturing of improvised explosives devices as a form of initiation.

-Manganese nitrate
-Nitric acid
-Aluminum
