

Circumstances and/or other facts:

On 09/18/2022 I, [REDACTED], was contacted by [REDACTED] and requested to respond to northern Foster county for a fatality hit and run accident. I responded from my residence north of Jamestown. According the State Radio logs, the reporting party identified as Shannon Brandt, stated he struck the pedestrian because the pedestrian was threatening him. Brandt stated that the pedestrian called some people and Brandt was afraid they were coming to get him. Brandt admitted to State Radio that he hit the pedestrian and that the pedestrian was part of a Republican extremist group. Once on scene, I met with [REDACTED] and was shown the area of the incident. Limited evidence was observed in the night time. A first responder who was first on scene was interviewed and showed where the male pedestrian's body was approximately located. This responder, identified as [REDACTED], stated that family of the pedestrian showed up along with the family of Brandt shortly after his arrival.

I declare, under penalty of perjury under the law of North Dakota, that the foregoing is true and correct.

Circumstances and/or other facts (continued):

§ responded to Brandt's parents house in rural McHenry and then to Brandt's house in Glenfield. There, Brandt was interviewed by § outside his residence and admitted to consuming alcohol prior to the incident. Brandt admitted to striking the pedestrian with his car because he had a political argument with the pedestrian and believed the pedestrian was calling people to come get him. Brandt admitted to leaving the scene of the incident and returning shortly after where he called 911. Brandt did not remain on scene till law enforcement arrived and ultimately returned to his residence. Brandt was placed under arrest for DUI (NDCC 39-08-01) § and transported to the Stutsman County jail. Brandt was advised of his Miranda rights and the Implied Consent Advisory. Brandt consented to a chemical breath test. The results of the chemical breath test were above the legal limit of 0.08.

The pedestrian was identified at the Carrington Hospital as C. E. I met with E's parents in Grace City. There I asked what time C contacted them to which C's mother informed me C called her at approximately 0241 hours. There, she stated C asked if they knew Brandt to which she stated the parents did but did not believe C did. C's mother stated she told C she was on her way to get him from McHenry. A short time later, C called again stated that "he" or "they" were chasing him and after this, she could not reach C.

Brandt's phone call to State Radio was logged at approximately 0255 hours.

C was pronounced deceased at the Carrington Hospital.
