L. The Magyar Szabadságharcos Szövetseg, an organization of Communist pertisens in Hungary, has recently received an invitation from the Hungarian Minister of War to submit a list of arms requirements to his Ministry. The following has been requested:

75,000 rifles

25,000 automatic pistols

100,000 revolvers


6,000 small motorcycles

1,500 sub-machine guns

1,200 transmitting and receiving radios (Type 3)

In December 1950, this group was designated to take charge of all partisan arms depots.

- 2. This materiel will be sent to the partisan groups during the months of June, July, and August 1951. Under present orders, it will be distributed to the centers of various districts in Hungary and guarded in depots belonging to the partisans.
- 3. One such deposit point has been set up in an old mine at Kisgyon in the Bakony district north of Szekesfeherver, and is to be used in the event that partisan activity is undertaken in Hungary.
