Stated that during the time Admiral Hillenkoetter was Director of CIA an agreement had been reached with the old McCarren Committee to furnish that Committee with information on various aliens and a quarterly report showing the number of Section 8 cases approved by the DCI. Mr. Kirkpatrick said that this information furnished by CIA to the Committee on aliens had always been a source of contention between the Agency and the FBI and he therefore recommended that these reports be discontinued.
