PRE-TRIAL DIVERSION AGREEMENT

Comes now the State of Indiana, by its Deputy Prosecuting Attorney and comes the Defendant Counsel, and hereby agree and stipulate pursuant to I.C. 33-39-1-8.

1. The Defendant herein is charged with a criminal offense that is eligible for diversion as charged in Count 3 of this cause of action.
2. The Defendant shall report, if and when as directed by the Prosecutor.
3. The Defendant shall pay to the Clay County Clerk a \$334.00 user's fee.
4. The Defendant will not violate any Municipal, State, or Federal laws.
5. Other terms of diversion agreement:

Upon execution of this Agreement, the Defendant shall delete any fake Facebook profiles he maintains, including but not limited to the following: [REDACTED]

6. That the Defendant shall notify the Prosecutor's Office of any change in address. The Defendant currently resides at:

7. That the Defendant must answer all reasonable inquiries by the Prosecuting Attorney and promptly notify the Prosecuting Attorney of any change of his/her address or employment.
8. The Defendant shall, if applicable, pay any and all

pauper attorney fees. Any bond posted by the Defendant in this cause of action will be used to pay the deferral fees herein and/or any remaining balance will be applied to any outstanding pauper attorney fees.

9. Upon the completion of this program, the Prosecutor will dismiss the charges filed against the Defendant. If the Defendant fails to comply with all the above terms and conditions during a six (6) month period, prosecution will resume against the Defendant. Termination from the Pre-Trial Diversion program is within the sole discretion of the Prosecutor's office.
10. The Defendant understands that what he/she is signing is a legal agreement and failure to meet ANY of the specified terms in said agreement will result in the prosecution of the criminal charging Informations filed herein.
11. The Defendant shall refrain from harassing, intimidating, threatening or having any direct or indirect contact with the victims, [REDACTED] Emily Clarke, and Josh Clarke.
