I am writing to request your consideration for the Chelan Forest Infrastructure Project Wood Innovations Grant application. The project will provide exceptional benefits in wood innovation, rural economic development and forest health in North Central Washington, an area of my Congressional District with significant wildfire risk, much-needed landscape restoration, and little to no forest products infrastructure.

The Chelan Forest Infrastructure Project will develop infrastructure to further manufacturing capacity for forest health projects and provide local family-wage jobs.
