

## OVERVIEW

The study was conducted for CNN by SSRS utilizing a hybrid sampling methodology. SSRS is an independent research company. Surveys were obtained via web ( $n=698$ ) and phone ( $n=207$ ) from October 13-17, 2022 with a representative sample of $n=905$ registered voters who live in Wisconsin. The margin of sampling error for total registered voters is +/- 4.2 at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The design effect is 1.64. For results among the $\mathrm{n}=\mathbf{7 1 4}$ likely voters, the margin of sampling error is $+/-4.5$. More information about SSRS can be obtained by visiting www.ssrs.com.

## NOTE ABOUT RESULTS

Unless otherwise noted, results beginning with the August 3-6, 2017 survey and ending with the April 21-26, 2021 survey are from polls conducted by SSRS via telephone only. For more information about other trend data included in this topline, please see the "More on Methodology" section at the end of this document.

Results beginning with the March 31-April 2, 2006 survey and ending with the April 22-25, 2017 survey are from telephone surveys conducted by ORC International. Results before March 31, 2006 are from telephone surveys conducted by Gallup.

## NOTE ABOUT CROSSTABS

Surveys were conducted among a representative sample of the adult registered voters, age 18 or older, of Wisconsin. Members of demographic groups not shown in the published crosstabs are represented in the results for each question in the poll. Crosstabs on the pages that follow only include results for subgroups with a minimum $\mathrm{N}=125$ unweighted cases. Results for subgroups with fewer than $\mathrm{N}=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "SN" because samples of that size carry larger margins of sampling error and can be too small to be projectable with confidence to their true values in the population.

## MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of $\mathrm{n}=905$ registered voters who live in Wisconsin were surveyed by web and telephone nationwide using a hybrid sample methodology, including the SSRS Opinion Panel, a nationally representative panel of U.S. adults ages 18 or older recruited using probability-based sampling techniques, and registration-based sample containing either a telephone number or an email address. All adults living in Wisconsin who were contacted via the SSRS Opinion Panel were invited to participate. All potential respondents were then screened for age, state of residence, and voter registration prior to administering the survey. Surveys were conducted in English and Spanish.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $+/-4.2$ percentage points. Results for the sample of 714 likely voters have a margin of sampling error of $+/-4.5$ percentage points.

Among the entire sample, $30 \%$ described themselves as Democrats, $31 \%$ described themselves as Republicans, and $38 \%$ described themselves as independents or members of another party.

All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect Census figures for the state's registered voters for gender, age, education, and race/ethnicity. The sample was also weighted for National Election Poll (NEP) region. The sample was weighted among self-reported 2020 voters for recalled 2020 vote within NEP regions. The benchmark for recalled 2020 vote was taken from countylevel National Election Pool (NEP) presidential election results provided by CNN. Finally, the full sample was calibrated to self-reported party ID using a benchmark extracted from the RBS sample, after independently weighting the RBS sample on demographics and recalled vote.
