OVERVIEW

The study was conducted for CNN by SSRS utilizing a hybrid sampling methodology. SSRS is an independent research company. Surveys were obtained via web (n=1,751) and phone (n=135) from November 25-29, 2022 with a representative sample of n=1,886 registered voters who live in Georgia. The margin of sampling error for total registered voters is +/- 3.0 at the 95% confidence level. The design effect is 1.83. For results among the n=1,184 likely voters, the margin of sampling error is +/- 3.8. More information about SSRS can be obtained by visiting www.ssrs.com.

MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of n=1,886 registered voters who live in Georgia were surveyed by web and telephone using a hybrid sample methodology, including the SSRS Opinion Panel, a nationally representative panel of U.S. adults ages 18 or older recruited using probability-based sampling techniques, and registration-based sample containing a telephone number, an email address, or mailing address. All adults living in Georgia who were contacted via the SSRS Opinion Panel were invited to participate. All potential respondents were then screened for age, state of residence, and voter registration prior to administering the survey. Surveys were conducted in English and Spanish.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of +/- 3.0 percentage points. Results for the sample of 1,184 likely voters have a margin of sampling error of +/- 3.8 percentage points.

Among the entire sample, 38% described themselves as Democrats, 39% described themselves as Republicans, and 23% described themselves as Independents or members of another party.

All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect Census figures for the state's registered voters for gender, age, education, and race/ethnicity. The sample was also weighted for National Election Poll (NEP) region. The sample was weighted among self-reported 2020 voters for recalled 2020 vote within NEP regions. The benchmark for recalled 2020 vote was taken from county-level National Election Pool (NEP) presidential election results provided by CNN.

Surveys were conducted among a representative sample of the adult registered voters, age 18 or older, of Georgia. Members of demographic groups not shown in the published crosstabs are represented in the results for each question in the poll. Crosstabs on the pages that precede only include results for subgroups with a minimum N=125 unweighted cases. Results for subgroups with fewer than N=125 unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "SN" because samples of that size carry larger margins of sampling error and can be too small to be projectable with confidence to their true values in the population.
