Dear Andrew Free:

You appealed from the action of the Initial Request Staff (IR Staff) of the Office of Information Policy on your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for access to records concerning any document constituting an authorization by DOJ-OIP for agency FOIA Offices to apply unique, requestor-specific password document files containing non-exempt public records, focusing on any such authorization or advice provided to DHS. I note that your appeal concerns the adequacy of the IR Staff's search.

After carefully considering your appeal, I am affirming the IR Staff's action on your request. The IR Staff informed you that it could locate no responsive records subject to the FOIA in its files. I have determined that the IR Staffs action was correct and that it conducted an adequate, reasonable search for such records.

Please be advised that this Office's decision was made only after a full review of this matter. Your appeal was assigned to an attorney with this Office who thoroughly reviewed and analyzed your appeal, your underlying request, and the action of the IR Staff in response to your request.

If you are dissatisfied with my action on your appeal, the FOIA permits you to file a lawsuit in federal district court in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B).

For your information, the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) offers mediation services to resolve disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies as a non-exclusive alternative to litigation. Using OGIS services does not affect your right to pursue litigation.
