Upon arrival, I met with Victim [REDACTED]. He stated he was working for Uber when two of his customers took his car at gun point. [REDACTED] received a notification to pick up a passenger named "Robert" somewhere in North County just off interstate 367. At the time [REDACTED] was driving a Gray Hyundai Santa Fe bearing Illinois license plate [REDACTED].

Victim [REDACTED] could not remember a street at the time or the general location of where he responded to pick up the customers. He could only remember the numeric of 9155.

Victim [REDACTED] arrived and texted "Robert"; advising him he had arrived at the location. "Robert" replied, stating he was walking up the street. Two unknown black males entered [REDACTED] vehicle. The first black male sat in the rear passenger's seat wearing a blue jump suit with a black book bag (Suspect 1). [REDACTED] could not give any further description of the second unidentified male only that he was a "black male with a black book bag" (Suspect 2).

Victim [REDACTED] began driving and conveyed Suspects 1 and 2, to 1231 Peggy Court. Upon arrival at the location, Suspect 1 told [REDACTED] to continue driving west on Peggy Court and drop them off. [REDACTED] did so and parked in front of 1247 Peggy Court. Suspect 2 exited the rear driver's seat. Suspect 1 remained seated in the rear passenger seat and began looking for something. Suspect 1 then stated, "I can't find my phone". [REDACTED] shut his vehicle off placed the keys in his pocket and exited the driver's seat. Suspect 1 exited the rear passenger seat. [REDACTED] walked around the vehicle and began moving the front passenger seat forward in an attempt to find Suspect 1's phone. Suspect 1 and 2 were both positioned behind [REDACTED] where he could not see them. Suspect 1 then stated, "Get away from the car." [REDACTED] looked back and observed Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 two holding black rifles (no further) in their hands. [REDACTED] complied and stepped to the side of the vehicle. [REDACTED] handed the keys over to Suspect 1. Suspect 2 then ordered Suspect 1 to search [REDACTED] person. Suspect 1 turned [REDACTED] pockets inside out, but did not take anything from them. [REDACTED] advised Suspects 1 and 2 that he did not have anything of value. Suspect 1 then demanded [REDACTED] to sit in the front passenger seat. [REDACTED] began to comply, but then stated, "Just take the car. I don't have anything else". Suspect 2 then entered the driver seat and Suspect 1 entered the passenger seat and stated to [REDACTED] "Get to walking". [REDACTED] complied and began walking east on Peggy Court. [REDACTED] observed Suspect 2 make a right turn on Peggy Court towards Gimblin out of sight. [REDACTED] then contacted this department.

An area canvas for cameras was conducted; however, none were located at the time.

[REDACTED] did not sustain any injuries during the incident.

The Real Time Crime Center was advised of the incident.

TRS Clerk Dear, DSN 2959, entered the vehicle as wanted per reference number [REDACTED].
