Dear Ms. Brown:

Thank you for your letter requesting that your suspension of visits be overturned to participate in the visiting program with Anthony Clemons, DOC 755828.

We understand and appreciate the positive influence that family and friends have on those who are incarcerated. The visiting program is an important part of our commitment to maintaining familial ties.

Prison visits fall under DOC policy 450.300, Visits for Incarcerated Individuals. Violations of policy, guidelines, and/or expectations do not require a warning, if a visitor is out of compliance with rules, a suspension or termination may be imposed. When you submitted your application to visit, and when you scheduled your visit, you agreed to read and abide by policy, rules, and video visit expectations.

Due to the nature of the violation being a safety concern, a 90 day suspension is appropriate and remains in place. Your suspension is scheduled to end at midnight on November 11, 2022.

Please ensure you adhere to the visit policy and guidelines. Should additional violations occur, video visit and regular visit privileges could be terminated. Additionally, your incarcerated loved-one could be infraacted if they are involved in behavior that violates policy.
