On December 13, 2022, the Union County Board of Education ("Board") voted in a special remote-held session to adopt an illegal school calendar for the 2023-24 School Year which will open schools on August 9, 2023 — three weeks earlier than allowed by state law under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d). The meeting lasted less than 15 minutes and was without opportunity for public comment, despite previously sharing two proposed calendars with parents just weeks before this vote which complied with the law.

The Board adopted this calendar in intentional violation of the law and in violation of their oath of office to uphold the laws of this State. The action of the Board's members could even constitute a criminal misdemeanor which may subject them to removal from office.

N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d) is no different than many other State statues which govern the State's educational system. Local boards of education are not free to pick and choose which laws they want to follow. For example, this same calendar statute requires every school district to

have a minimum of 1,025 hours or 185 days of calendar instruction every year -- a board of education cannot merely decide to only provide 950 hours or 150 days of instruction because they think that would be sufficient and would cost less. They must follow the law as written.

Plaintiffs in this action include parents in Union County with children in the Union County public school system, and a business which provides summer camps to students which will be significantly harmed by the illegal calendar if it is not stopped. Plaintiffs hereby seek a declaratory judgment that the Board's calendar adopted on December 13, 2022, violates state law, and preliminary and permanent injunctive relief enjoining the Board from using this illegal calendar.

## Parties, Jurisdiction, and Venue

Plaintiff Dominique Morrison is a citizen and resident of Union County, North
 Carolina. She is a parent of students attending Union County public school system.

2. Plaintiff Honeysuckle Riding Academy, LLC is a North Carolina Limited Liability Company operated and owned by Ms. Morrison. It offers horse riding lessons and camps. The summer camp class and riding season, including the first three weeks of August, is a critical time for her business to be able to earn enough revenue to feed its horses and stay operational to serve the community.

Plaintiff Francis Ward is a citizen and resident of Union County, North Carolina.
 He is a parent of students attending Union County public school system.

4. Defendant Union County Board of Education ("Board") is a government entity which governs the Union County public school system.

5. Defendants Rev. John J. Kirkpatrick IV, Matt Helms, Gary Sides, Sandra Greene, Joseph Morreale, Kathy Heintel, Rev. Jimmy H. Bention Sr., Todd Price, and Sarah May, are the

members of the Union County Board of Education, as listed on the Board's website (<u>https://www.ucps.k12.nc.us/Page/192</u>). The Board members are sued in their official capacities.

6. Venue is proper in Union County because Defendants are located in Union County, and the acts challenged in this action took place in Union County.

### FACTUAL BACKGROUND

7. Under state law, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d) ("School Calendar Law") mandates that the school year for North Carolina public schools must begin no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26. In 2023, that date will be Monday, August 28, 2023.

8. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2 is one of many statutes in Chapter 115C which prescribe rules for local boards of education to follow. These statutes are not discretionary. For example:

- N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-107.6 requires districts to provide for the education of children with disabilities.
- N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-47(10) requires local boards to meet class size requirements for kindergarten to third class set forth in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-301.
- N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-157 requires districts to offer career and technical education instruction to students.
- N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(a) requires every school district to have a minimum of 1,025 hours or 185 days of calendar instruction every year.
- 9. The School Calendar Law requires boards of education to consult with parents and

school personnel in the development of the school calendar. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(a).

10. In Union County, to comply with this consultation requirement, an email was sent to parents on November 15, 2022, with a link to two proposed calendars, asking parents to vote on their choice. Both of these calendars had start dates of August 28, 2023, in compliance with the law. A copy of that email and the two calendars proposed is attached as **Exhibit A**.

11. The email noted that the survey of parents would close on November 28, 2022, and the results would be shared with the Board of Education and district leadership. The email also stated that "the Board of Education will discuss the calendar in January and approval is expected in February 2023."

.

12. Instead of doing what it said it would do in this email, on December 6, 2022, the Board held a regularly scheduled public meeting, which included an item on its consent agenda for approval of its academic calendar for the 2023-24 school year. A copy of that agenda is attached as **Exhibit B** (see pages 7-8).

13. A PowerPoint presentation was attached to the December 6, 2022, meeting agenda which included a "Draft Calendar Proposal." Like the calendars shared with parents in the November 15 email, that calendar started the first day of classes on August 28, 2023, in compliance with the law. A copy of that PowerPoint is attached as **Exhibit C**.

14. The PowerPoint states that a District Calendar Committee was developed to review calendars, and that the public had an opportunity to vote on the calendar they wanted. (Exhibit C at page 2.)

15. The PowerPoint also directly noted the "statutory requirement" that the calendar must have a "start date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26." (Exhibit C at page 3). It is also that there are no "educational purpose waivers for exemption of the opening and/or closing dates."

16. However, when this item came up at the December 6, 2022 meeting, an "alternative motion" was suddenly made and passed--without advance notice -- to direct the Board's staff to prepare a calendar which starts on August 9 – three weeks earlier than allowed by law.

17. Board members at the meeting in fact acknowledged that such a calendar would violate the law. There was some discussion that "other districts" had recently adopted illegal calendars and "nothing happened" to them.

18. One board member also admitted this new calendar could adversely affect people with vacations already planned for August 2023.

19. It was also noted at the Board meeting the calendar could be adopted at a special remote meeting the following week.

20. Video of the December 6, 2022 Board discussion is available on YouTube at <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nnt02VwoaCM</u>, starting at approximately 1:14:45, where the entire discussion of the calendar is less than five minutes.

21. On December 13, 2022, the Board then held a special remote meeting which lasted less than 15 minutes. The Board voted unanimously to adopt a school calendar for 2023-24 which starts on August 9, 2023, acknowledging it would be in violation of State law.

22. During the meeting, a few comments on the YouTube stream asked why the new calendar had not been presented to the community, and that the "lack of transparency among the Board is a bit troubling." See screenshot at **Exhibit D**.

23. It is not clear what public notice was given for the December 13, 2022 meeting; Plaintiffs reserve their right to amend this Complaint should it be discovered that proper notice of an open meeting was not given.

24. Video of this December 13, 2022 meeting can be found at: https://www.youtube.com/@UCPSBOE/streams.

25. A copy of the calendar adopted at this meeting is attached to the Complaint as **Exhibit E**. The calendar states on its face "Approved by the Board of Education on December 13<sup>th</sup> 2022". It is on the school system's website as the official calendar for 2023-24 as found at: <u>https://www.ucps.k12.nc.us/page/2#calendar1/20221219/month</u>.

26. The calendar adopted by the Board has a start date for students of Wednesday August 9, 2023. The calendar adopted is not either of the legal calendars shared with parents just weeks before that they had been asked to vote on.

27. Dominique Morrison found out about the vote of the Board on December 13 to adopt an illegal calendar, and was immediately troubled.

28. Ms. Morrison attempted to reach out to school board members she knew to explain her concerns. This change to the calendar will severely impact her ability to hold summer horseriding camps for as many weeks as she normally holds them. The loss of those August weeks will cause her to lose critical revenue which she depends on as part of her annual operations. Even in future summers (should this calendar stay in place), she would be harmed, due to holidays such as Memorial Day which adversely impact the ability to hold camps.

29. Morrison and her business have relied on the School Calendar Law in developing a successful business, and the violation of the law will cause her and her company harm.

30. Francis Ward found out about the illegal vote on December 13, and was immediately concerned, as he knew it was in violation of the law.

31. Morrison and Ward will also be harmed because they have children who are students in the Union County school district. Despite being illegal, the Board is now telling students and parents that they must report for school on August 9, 2023, three weeks earlier than allowed by State law. The new calendar is already on the school system's website.

32. The parents of Union County students including Morrison and Ward rely on the Board following state law in planning their summers, both for work and other family activities.

33. The Board has asserted that it believes this calendar is "better" for students because it allegedly syncs with the local college community calendar – although that applies to only those high school students who take community college classes. However, the Board does not have the ability or power to violate state law at its own choosing – it is required to follow the educational laws of this state.

34. Even if the Board disagrees with the law, and even if the Board advocates for changes in the law, it must follow the law as written while it is effective. Indeed, under the criminal laws of this State, the willful failure of a "school board member" to follow the law is a criminal Class 1 misdemeanor under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 14-230, which can be punishable by removal from office by order of the Court.

## COUNT I – CLAIM FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT

35. The allegations contained in the prior and subsequent paragraphs of this Complaint are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference as if set forth verbatim herein.

36. Plaintiffs seek a declaration under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 1-253 *et seq.* that the School Calendar adopted by the Board on December 13, 2022 violates N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d) and is therefore invalid.

37. The Board has already admitted in public meetings that this calendar violates the law.

38. The Board is required to follow N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d) by law. The Board cannot pick and choose which mandatory duties under Chapter 115C it will decide to follow.

39. There are no disputed issues of fact or questions on law, and a prompt declaration by this Court is requested.

# **COUNT II – PRELIMINARY AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

40. The allegations contained in the prior and subsequent paragraphs of this Complaint are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference as if set forth verbatim herein.

41. Preliminary seek a preliminary and permanent injunction that enjoins the Board from enforcing the illegal school calendar adopted on December 13, 2022, or adopting any other calendar which violates the school calendar law.

42. Immediate action is required to prevent further disruption and damage to Plaintiffs.

43. There is a high likelihood of success on the merits of this claim, and Plaintiffs will be irreparably harmed if Defendants are not enjoined.

44. Plaintiff Morrison and her business are being prevented from scheduling and planning camps in August due to the Board's adoption of the illegal calendar.

45. Without a preliminary injunction the parents and businesses of Union County will be adversely affected trying to plan to accommodate a calendar in planning their summer which violates the law.

46. In addition, and in the alternative, Plaintiffs ask that a permanent injunction be immediately entered in this matter, since there are no genuine issues of fact or law in dispute.

47. The injunctive relief requested is in the public interest.

## COUNT III - ATTORNEYS' FEES

48. The allegations contained in the prior and subsequent paragraphs of this Complaint are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference as if set forth verbatim herein.

49. There is no valid legal defense to the school calendar adopted in Union County on December 13, 2022.

50. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d) sets forth an unambiguous limit on the authority of Defendants to adopt a school calendar, which was willfully violated.

51. There is a complete absence of a justiciable issue of either law or fact to be raised by the Defendants in this case.

52. Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 6-21.7 and/or § 6-21.5, Plaintiffs are entitled to a full award of all reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred in bringing this matter.

53. An award of attorneys' fees is also required in the interest of justice to discourage continued violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d).

### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully pray unto the Court that they receive the following relief:

1. That a declaratory judgment be entered in favor of Plaintiffs declaring that the Board's school calendar adopted on December 13, 2022, is illegal and invalid and violates N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-84.2(d).

2. That a preliminary and permanent and injunction be entered in favor of Plaintiffs enjoining the Board from enforcing the school calendar adopted on December 13, 2022, or adopting any calendar which violates § 115C-84.2(d).

3. Award Plaintiffs their costs, including without limitation reasonable and necessary attorneys' fees as allowed by law pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 6-21.7 and/or § 6-21.5 or other applicable law; and

4. Such other and further relief as provided by law or as the Court deems just and

proper.




