The undersigned upon oath deposes and states as follows, to-wit:

I, Rachel Flores, the undersigned upon oath, deposes and states as follows, to wit:

I am a Special Agent for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI). I have been a certified police officer in the State of Oklahoma for over 14 years. I am currently assigned to investigate criminal investigations within the OSBI Southwest Region. Caddo County is one of the assigned counties within that region.

On January 10, 2023, A.A., a five-year-old child, was located wandering near her residence at 225 West Nebraska Avenue, Cyril, Oklahoma, by the mailperson, Maci Turner. Turner called the local police and Cyril Police Chief Garrett Raney responded. A.A. was forensically interviewed and disclosed she had been home alone and she is tired of being alone. Raney received a call from one of the caretakers of A.A., Alysia Adams, whom asked where A.A.'s 4-year-old sister, A.A.K.A was. At that moment, it was learned that A.A.K.A was missing. A.A. reported she called Alysia "mom" and "Aly" and called Alysia's husband, Ivon Adams, "Dad" and "Uncle Ivon." A.A. and A.A.K.A's biological mother, Jasmin Brownfield, left them in the care of Alysia and Ivon approximately two years earlier. Alysia and Ivon never took A. A. and A.A.K.A to the doctor for check-ups and did not enroll A.A. into school.

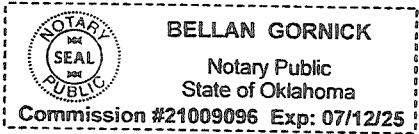
Alysia reported to Special Agent Rachel Flores that they have left the children home alone in the past. Due to these circumstances, we believe Alysia committed Child Neglect.

Adams was arrested for the charge of Child Neglect.

Duly sworn, upon oath deposes and says:

This Affiant, Lieutenant Brenna Alvarez, has been a law enforcement officer for over 16 years. Alvarez worked as a Detective with Lawton Police Department for almost 3 years, and has worked as a Special Agent with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation since February 2014. Alvarez has assisted in the preparation of hundreds of Affidavits for Search and Arrest Warrants. Since December 2010, Alvarez has been assigned and investigated well over 750 criminal cases and assisted other agents/detectives in numerous other investigations.

That probable cause exists to cause the arrest of Ivon Neil Adams For the public offense against

Said County and State, to wit: First Degree Murder, S21-701.7 And that probable cause of

the affiant believing such facts exist as follows, to wit:

On January 10, 2023, 5 year-old A.A., was located wandering near her residence at 225 West Nebraska Avenue, Cyril, Caddo County, Oklahoma, by the mailperson, Maci Turner. Turner called the local police and Cyril Police Chief Garrett Raney responded. A.A. was forensically interviewed and disclosed she had been home alone and she is tired of being alone. Raney received a call from one of the caretakers of A.A., Alysia Adams, whom asked where A.A.'s 4 year-old sister, A.A.K.A., was located. At that moment, it was learned that A.A.K.A. was missing. A.A. reported she called Alysia "mom" and "Aly" and called Alysia's husband, Ivon Adams, "Dad" and "Uncle Ivon." A.A.K.A. and A.A.'s biological mother, Jasmin Brownfield, left A.A. and A.A.K.A. in the care of Alysia and Ivon approximately 1.5-2 years earlier. Alysia and Ivon never took A.A. and A.A.K.A. to the doctor for check-ups and did not enroll A.A. into school.

Review of phone records for Alysia and Ivon did not match with what they reported to Flores. On December 26, 2022, between 0415-0530 hours, Ivon's phone records show his phone leaving 225 West Nebraska and traveling to near Rush Springs, Oklahoma. Alysia and Ivon had a previous residence located in the Rush Springs, Oklahoma area.

On January 12, 2023, Flores re-interviewed Alysia and read her the Miranda Warning, to which she waived. Alysia confessed that on December 25, 2022, around midnight that night, Ivon beat A.A.K.A. and held her up by her arms, A.A.K.A. was not moving and her eyes were barely open. He then laid her on the ground and punched her at least three more times in her chest. A.A.K.A. never moved after that. This occurred at their residence on 225 West Nebraska. Ivon then left around 0100 hours on December 26, 2022, with A.A.K.A. When he arrived back, he told Alysia that he buried her near a fence line that was next to their old residence in Rush Springs. He informed her he placed a large broken branch over the burial site.

Due to these circumstances, we believe Ivon Adams committed First Degree Murder.

Hicks, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Caddo and in the State of Oklahoma, IVON NEIL ADAMS III did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT 1: MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE – CHILD ABUSE ~ a FELONY, the defendant, Ivon Neil Adams, III did then and there in Caddo County, Oklahoma on, or about, the 25th day of December, 2022 cause the death of A.A., a child born (DOB 09/2018), to wit: the death of A.A. (DOB 09/2018) was caused by Defendant, Ivon Neil Adams, III as a result of the willful or malicious use of unreasonable force against A.A., said unreasonable force being that said defendant did then and there strike said A.A. multiple times on and about her body and specifically in her chest area.

This crime is punishable by death, imprisonment for life, or imprisonment for life without parole.

COUNT 2: CHILD NEGLECT ~ a FELONY, on or between the 6th day of January, 2023 and the 10th day of January, 2023, by willfully/maliciously neglecting A.A., (DOB 07/2017), 5 years old at that time, did leave the child, A.A. without supervision and medical care.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections not exceeding life imprisonment, or by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or both such fine and imprisonment.
