General Information:

The AJC-SPIA Poll was conducted January 9-20, 2023 and included a total of 860 registered voters in Georgia. The survey was administered by the School of Public and International Affairs Survey Research Center at the University of Georgia. Interviews were conducted in English. A dual-frame statewide random sample consisting of approximately 90% cell phone numbers and 10% landline numbers was obtained through L2 (L2 is a sampling vendor that maintains a database constructed from state voter registration lists. Through commercial sources, phone numbers have been appended to the individual records (registrants) that make up these lists). The survey results were weighted using iterative proportional raking in order to ensure the sample was representative of the registrant population in terms of education, race, sex, and age. The calculated margin of error for the total sample is +/-3.3 points at the 95% confidence level. This would mean that if 50% of respondents indicate a topline view on an issue, we can be 95% confident that the population's view on that issue is somewhere between 53.3% and 46.7%.

Other Notes:

Since Georgia instituted opt-out registration at the DMV in September of 2017, the total number of registrants has increased. As a result, the demographic profile of the registrant population is now much closer to the citizen voting age population.
