Dear Meredith Stevenson:

This letter concerns the above-referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, submitted to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on 06/21/2022, in which you requested:

"Any and all documents related to the data on which EPA based its decision to issue an Interim Registration Review Decision (IRRD) for difenoconazole."

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §2.104(e), an extension of time to respond to your request is necessary. Given the scope of the request, EPA anticipates that the response will require a significant amount of EPA's resources and time to search for and collect the requested records from multiple EPA offices that are separate from the office processing the request.

At this time, EPA estimates the Agency will be able to complete this request by February 24, 2023.
