Re: WARN Notification for Ryder Integrated Logistics, Inc. ("Ryder")

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with the Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act (WARN) and the California Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("California WARN"), we are writing to inform you of an anticipated Ryder "mass layoff" (as defined in the above statutes) at a customer facility located at 16300 Fern Avenue, Chino, California 91708 due to the non-renewal of a contract.

Operations at the site will continue, and the customer and the new logistics provider have expressed interest in retaining as many employees as feasible at the site. Employees are encouraged to apply for positions with the customer and/or the new logistics provider. For further information regarding the continuing operations at the site, please contact the company continuing operations out of the facility.

The cessation of Ryder's operations at this site is expected to be permanent and will become effective on March 31, 2023. Ryder anticipates that, pursuant to 29 USC § 2021(a) and Cal. Lab. Code § 1400.5, 168, Ryder Employees will be terminated on March 31, 2023; no subsequent terminations are anticipated.

Additionally, Ryder remains committed to continuing to serve the needs of our customers in the Inland Empire area, where we continue to operate more than 200 sites. Ryder is working on redeployment efforts, as feasible, to retain as many employees as possible.

A listing of the job titles of the positions to be affected and the number of affected employees in each job classification is being maintained onsite and can be provided upon request. There are no bumping rights applicable to employees terminated as a result of this mass layoff.
