**NARRATIVE**

On Saturday, September 9, 2017 at approximately 1937 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] for an Unknown Problem. Officer Crane was riding with me as a two man unit and was dispatched to this address prior to me starting my shift.

When I arrived, there was a female in front of the apartment building. Officer Crane explained to me that she was the original reporting party from the earlier incident. I stayed outside and spoke with her while Officer Crane went with Officer Wright and Sgt. Mikalik to make contact with the male half who was inside.

The female, [REDACTED], explained to me that her boyfriend, [REDACTED], had battered her earlier and he had since left. A short time later, [REDACTED] came back with his brother, took her keys, and locked her out of the apartment, with her son, [REDACTED], still inside.

After speaking with [REDACTED], I learned that [REDACTED] answered the door for Officers, but immediately slammed the door. Once I learned this information, I stayed outside and covered the windows in case [REDACTED] tried to exit through one of them. Eventually, Sgt. Mikalik, Officer Crane, and Officer Wright made contact with [REDACTED] and his brother. Sgt. Mikalik came outside and told me and [REDACTED] we could come inside.

From what I gathered from Officer Crane speaking with [REDACTED], [REDACTED] was willing to leave as long as he could gather all of his belongings. Officer Wright, Officer Crane, and I stood by in the apartment while [REDACTED] gathered his belongings.

While [REDACTED] was gathering his belongings, [REDACTED] got upset because [REDACTED] was throwing belongings all around their bedroom looking for his stuff.

Officer Wright made it clear to [REDACTED] that if he broke any of [REDACTED]

belongings, he would be going to jail. [REDACTED] replied to Officer Wright with "Shut the fuck up." For the next 30 minutes, Officer Wright, Officer Crane, and I waited patiently for [REDACTED] to gather his belongings. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] several times where his Xbox One gaming system was and she repeatedly told him she did not know.

At one point, [REDACTED] took a bag of his clothing out to his vehicle. When he came back in, he immediately walked towards [REDACTED], who was sitting on the living room couch, and demanded his Xbox One. I walked into the living room and noticed that [REDACTED] was literally standing over her. Officer Crane pushed [REDACTED] back and [REDACTED] stated, "Don't fucking touch me" and then stepped towards [REDACTED] again. I thought that [REDACTED] was going to strike [REDACTED] so I started towards him when Officer Wright grabbed [REDACTED] from behind by both arms. Officer Wright pulled [REDACTED] away from [REDACTED] and I grabbed his left arm. Officer Wright then put [REDACTED] in handcuffs.

Once [REDACTED] was in handcuffs, he started to pull away from Officer Wright and I. I grabbed the back of [REDACTED]'s neck and pushed his head down towards the couch cushions and [REDACTED] said "I'm cool, I'm cool." I let his head up and Officer Wright had to physically separate his feet for a search. [REDACTED] was searched and no items of contraband were found.

Again, [REDACTED] started to pull away from Officers more forcefully than the first time. I then wrapped my right arm around the back of [REDACTED]'s neck, put my right foot in front of his left foot, turned my body to the left, and forced his body to the ground using my body weight. [REDACTED] landed on his left side and I landed directly on my knees.

It should be noted; my grip was not around the front of [REDACTED]'s neck and did not keep him from breathing. Also, [REDACTED] three year old son, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was in the living room when this occurred.

Once [REDACTED] was on the ground, he was able to sit himself up. I pushed his head down again to keep him under control. Again, [REDACTED] said he would not resist and he was lifted to his feet. As Officer Wright and I were escorting [REDACTED] out to my squad car, he stiffened his legs and would not walk. Officer Wright and I had to physically drag [REDACTED] out to the stairs by the sidewalk and he let his legs go limp. He said he could not breathe and that he had asthma.



I laid [redacted] down on this left side and Officer Wright called an ambulance. [redacted] repeatedly said he did not want an ambulance and just wanted us to take him to jail. Officer Wright and I had [redacted] sit in the back seat of my squad car so he could be more comfortable. Once Fire and Medical staff arrived on scene, they evaluated [redacted].

Sgt. Mikalik arrived on back on scene a short time later. I informed Sgt. Mikalik that my knees were starting to hurt from the take down. He instructed me to go to Carle Hospital and get them looked at.

While at Carle, I had x-ray's taken of my right knee, which was bruised and slightly swelled. Sgt. Mikalik photographed both of my knees, the left had a slight abrasion on it. The right knee was bruised and slightly swelled. The Doctor then signed a release form for me.

I then learned that the Jail refused [redacted] and that a doctor needed to sign a release form. [redacted] was also taken to Carle so I met with Officer Crane when I was discharged. A doctor signed a medical release for [redacted] and he was discharged. Officer Crane and I then transported [redacted] to CCSO where booking paper work was completed. He was left in the care of Correctional Staff.

**NARRATIVE**

On 09/09/2017 at approximately 1934 hours I responded to back Officer Wright at [REDACTED] for a report of a female crying hysterically and asking for the police. While en route I spoke with Officer Cassidy, who told me that he and Officer Crane were at this address earlier for a report of a domestic battery between [REDACTED] and her boyfriend [REDACTED]. Officer Cassidy advised that [REDACTED] had claimed that [REDACTED] had battered her but there were no apparent injuries and [REDACTED] was not located at the time of their initial contact.

At about 1936 hours Officer Wright and I arrived on scene. [REDACTED] advised that shortly after officers left [REDACTED] had returned with his brother, [REDACTED], and they had locked her out of the apartment. [REDACTED] said that her three-year-old son, [REDACTED] was inside the apartment. [REDACTED] told us that [REDACTED] is [REDACTED] putative father. [REDACTED] eventually opened the door for Officer Wright and we spoke with him while Officer Franquemont and Officer Crane joined us at the apartment. After officers spoke with everyone involved, [REDACTED] stated that he was leaving the apartment for good and wanted to gather up all of his belongings. I cleared the scene but Officer Wright, Officer Franquemont, and Officer Crane stayed on scene to ensure that there was no further dispute between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

At around 2019 hours Officer Wright requested that I return to the apartment. I arrived a few minutes later and he advised that shortly after I left [REDACTED] became verbally aggressive towards [REDACTED], and confronted her about a gaming system that he believed she'd stolen. Officer Wright said that at one point [REDACTED] stepped towards [REDACTED] in a threatening manner and

Officer Crane had to step in between them. Officer Wright and Officer Crane both told me that they believed that had they not intervened [REDACTED] would have battered [REDACTED]. Officer Wright said that [REDACTED] ignored Officer Crane, and refused to cease his advance towards [REDACTED]. Officer Wright said that he grabbed both of [REDACTED]'s arms from behind and he and the other officers placed [REDACTED] under arrest. Officer Franquemont told me that after [REDACTED] was handcuffed he attempted to pull away so he (Officer Franquemont) put his hand on the back of [REDACTED]'s neck to push his head forward, bending [REDACTED] over, and ordered him to stop resisting. Officer Franquemont said that [REDACTED] continued to resist by trying to pull away from him so he (Officer Franquemont) grabbed [REDACTED]'s left arm with his left hand and wrapped his right arm around the back of [REDACTED]'s neck/shoulder and threw him to the ground. Officer Franquemont said that once [REDACTED] was on the ground he stopped trying to fight them and claimed that he had asthma and was having difficulty breathing. Officer Wright immediately called for an ambulance. While I was speaking with the officers on scene [REDACTED] was being attended to by the paramedics and eventually refused treatment.

Next, I spoke with [REDACTED], who was sitting on the steps next to the west end of the apartment building. I asked him if he'd been inside the apartment when [REDACTED] was arrested. He said: "Yes." I asked him to explain to me what happened from his perspective. [REDACTED] was obviously still upset and told me that "they (the police officers) didn't have to do that." [REDACTED] went on to say that when he came into the apartment [REDACTED] was already in handcuffs and he observed an officer grab [REDACTED] "by the neck" in a "headlock" and throw him to the ground. I asked [REDACTED] if he heard the officers tell [REDACTED] to stop resisting. He said: "No." I asked [REDACTED] if he saw [REDACTED] resisting the officers. He said: "No." I asked [REDACTED] what happened after [REDACTED] was taken to the ground. He told me that they picked [REDACTED] up because he was complaining about not being able to breathe. I asked [REDACTED] if he heard the officers call for an ambulance for [REDACTED]. He said something to the effect of: "Yes, but it took them a minute." I asked [REDACTED] if he thought the force the officers used was necessary. He said: "No."


Next, I spoke with [REDACTED] inside her apartment. I asked her if she'd witnessed [REDACTED]'s arrest. She said: "Yes." I asked her to tell me what she'd seen from her perspective. [REDACTED] told me that while [REDACTED] was packing his things up he was constantly "talking shit." [REDACTED] said that

█████ became upset because he claimed that she'd stolen his Microsoft Xbox One game system. █████ told me that she and █████ were sitting on the couch in the living room when █████ "came" at her. I asked █████ what she meant by this. █████ said that █████ quickly walked towards her with his fists balled. █████ told me that she "jumped back" because she was afraid that he was going to batter her if the officer had not stepped in between them. █████ told me that she could see the officers place █████ in handcuffs while he was being "very disrespectful" the entire time and at one point he tried to "move away" from the officers. █████ said that she did not see how █████ was taken to the ground but she assumed that officers "tripped" him. I asked █████ if she saw any of the officers put █████ in a headlock or wrap their arms/hands around his neck. She said: "No." I asked █████ if she thought the force that the officers used was excessive. She said: "No."

Finally, I went to speak with █████. I asked █████ to tell me what happened from his point of view. █████ asked me if the officers were wearing bodycams. I told him they were not. █████ told me that there was no point it talking about it then. I asked █████ if he was injured. He said: "Yes," and told me that his right shoulder and left wrist hurt, but he did not elaborate. █████ was eventually transported to the Carle Hospital where he was seen and released. I went to the hospital and met with Officer Franquemont, who was being treated for injuries he received during the arrest. Officer Franquemont told me that when he took █████ to the ground his knees struck the floor and were hurt. I examined his knees and saw a small contusion on the inside of his right knee, a small "blood blister" on the outside of his left knee and some redness on the inside that same knee. I saw that the blood blister had already bled some, leaving a small blood stain that soaked through his pant leg. I asked Officer Franquemont if he was injured anywhere else. He said: "No." I took digital photographs of the listed injuries and email them to Evidence Technician Carr.

At approximately 2132 hours I cleared the call with this supplemental report.

On 09/09/2017 at 07:36 PM, I responded to [REDACTED] for a domestic. While in route, I was informed there was a previous domestic at this location approximately 1 hour earlier where a battery was supposedly took place.

Upon arrival, I met [REDACTED] on the west side of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that her boyfriend, [REDACTED] Waller, locked her out of her apartment ([REDACTED]). Inside the apartment was [REDACTED]'s brother, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] son, [REDACTED]. Lyle did not have permission from [REDACTED] to care for her [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] is not [REDACTED]'s child.

Sgt. Mikalik arrived on scene, I briefed him on the situation and we walked to apartment [REDACTED] to speak with [REDACTED]. There was no probable cause to arrest [REDACTED] from the earlier domestic, but he needed to be interviewed. I knocked on the door and [REDACTED] soon after opened it. [REDACTED] asked me what I wanted, so I advised why I was there. [REDACTED] stated that he did not want to talk to me and immediately slammed the door and locked it. I was unable to prevent [REDACTED] from closing the door. I knew there was no probable cause to arrest [REDACTED], nor were there any exigent circumstances, therefore I had no reason to force entry in the apartment.

While I spoke with Sgt. Mikalik about what we should do next, Officer Crane came to our location, (Officer Crane was the primary unit on the earlier domestic). Sgt. Mikalik stepped outside the entryway to the complex, then several seconds later [REDACTED] came back to the door. I told

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█████ to step outside and he complied. Because of █████'s earlier actions, I wanted to be sure he was not armed before I began interviewing him. For my personal safety, I conducted a safety pat-down of █████. █████ admitted to me that he had a "roach" in his pocket. "Roach" is a common term for a cannabis cigarette. Officer crane found the cannabis in one of █████'s pockets, (see Officer Crane's supplemental report for further details). I instructed █████ to sit on a chair that was outside of the apartment, and that our main concern at this point as getting █████ back to █████. █████'s brother █████ came out of the apartment, along with █████.

Sgt. Mikalik walked back to our location with █████ and she retrieved █████. Lyle advised he was leaving for the night but needed to retrieve his personal belongings from inside the apartment. To prevent further problems, I, along with Sgt. Mikalik, Officer Franquemont and Officer Crane, stood by in the apartment while █████ began to gather his belongings. Sgt. Mikalik left the scene after several minutes as the situation seemed to be under control.

While █████ gathered his items, he became more and more agitated. █████ felt that █████ hid his Xbox game console somewhere, but she denied the allegation. █████ began to take items out of the closet and drawers and throw them about the bedroom while he gathered several trash bags full of clothes. I warned █████ that if he broke or damaged any of █████ personal items, that I would take him to jail. █████'s response consisted of several remarks about me being white, and several times █████ told me to "shut the fuck up". Although while was being extremely disrespectful to me, I had no reason to arrest him. Because I knew that █████ leaving the residence would be the best case scenario, I waited patiently for █████ to gather his belongings for approximately 30 minutes.

█████ made several trips outside with trash bags full of belongings. After one of █████'s trips outside, he returned to the apartment and walked straight towards █████ who was sitting on the couch. I saw █████ walk up to █████ with his arms out. █████'s approach was forceful and aggressive. He was obviously upset and I feared he may harm █████. Officer Crane stepped in between █████ and █████ and told him he needed to step back while placing a hand on his upper body. █████ stepped back and stated something similar to, "don't fucking touch me". █████ then immediately



stepped forward again with a forceful and aggressive step towards [REDACTED]. By this time I was directly behind [REDACTED]. I decided to arrest [REDACTED] for assault as I was in fear for [REDACTED] safety.

I grabbed [REDACTED]'s arms from behind and told him he was under arrest. I placed handcuffs on [REDACTED]'s wrists and double locked them. [REDACTED] began to jerk away from Officer Franquemont and I by swinging his body back and forth. Officer Franquemont forced [REDACTED]'s head downward to deter his resistance. [REDACTED] stated that he was "cool" and began to comply by not jerking away from us. [REDACTED] would not separate his feet for a search so I had to separate them with my own feet. After searching [REDACTED] he began to jerk away from us again in a very aggressive manner. Officer Franquemont was able to complete a takedown on [REDACTED] onto the floor to prevent him from injuring us. Officer Franquemont is completing a supplemental report which will describe in further detail the force used against [REDACTED].

The incident that occurred inside the apartment took place with [REDACTED] present. [REDACTED]'s actions placed [REDACTED] in harm's way and could have resulted in [REDACTED] being injured.

Officer Franquemont and I began to escort [REDACTED] to the outside of the building. [REDACTED] did not want to walk cooperatively as he extended his legs and made them stiff. Officer Franquemont and I were forced to drag [REDACTED] from the apartment to the outside of the building by his arms while we held his body upright. Once outside, [REDACTED]'s body went limp and he began to advise that he could not breathe. Officer Franquemont and I had [REDACTED] sit on the sidewalk and used no further force against him. Officer Franquemont helped [REDACTED] lay on his left side to help him breathe. [REDACTED] was in no way gasping for breath or acting as if he was having a medical emergency, but he did say he had asthma. For precautionary reasons, I asked METCAD to send us an ambulance for him to be evaluated. Shortly after I called for an ambulance, [REDACTED] began to say that he was ok and that we should just take him to jail. I allowed the ambulance to continue to evaluate [REDACTED] anyways.

The ambulance arrived on scene and [REDACTED] refused medical treatment. Officer Mikalik interviewed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] about the incident. [REDACTED] complained of shoulder pain in his right shoulder. The paramedics on scene called a doctor at Presence Medical Center and got the OK for [REDACTED] to be

transported to jail without going to the hospital first. I advised [REDACTED] of his Miranda Rights at 08:40 PM, but he had nothing to say about the incident.

Officer Crane and I transported [REDACTED] to the Champaign County Satellite Jail. The sergeant on duty advised [REDACTED] still needed to be cleared at the hospital before he could be accepted. Officer Crane and I drove [REDACTED] to Carle where Officer Franquemont already was due to a knee injury he sustained during the struggle with [REDACTED]. Once Officer Franquemont was cleared, he relieved me from my duties of staying with [REDACTED]. I had no further involvement with this call.

On 9/9/17 at 1821 hrs, I (along with Officer Cassidy acting as a two man unit) responded to [REDACTED] for a domestic battery. METCAD advised that a female sounded distressed and called/hung up multiple times.

When I arrived I spoke with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she and her boyfriend ([REDACTED]) had been dating for about two years. She informed me that [REDACTED]'s brother ([REDACTED]) had been staying/living with [REDACTED] and her at the apartment for a couple of weeks. She stated that she found a condom in [REDACTED]'s wallet and confronted [REDACTED] about it. [REDACTED] said she got upset and wanted to leave the apartment. She said the argument continued to build and while confronting [REDACTED], he put his hand around her neck and squeezed, while pushing her up against the wall. [REDACTED] had no visible injuries or marks on her person, and she stated that she did not need medical treatment/attention. She said that as she called the police, Lyle and [REDACTED] left the apartment in [REDACTED]' gold Chrysler (IL-[REDACTED]). I notified METCAD of the vehicle description. [REDACTED] son ([REDACTED]) was present in the apartment during the incident. I informed [REDACTED] that if [REDACTED] shows back up to their apartment to notify police. After I spoke with [REDACTED], I traveled to an area (Philo Rd/Florida Ave) where [REDACTED] thought [REDACTED] might be located. I was unable to locate a vehicle matching the description. I cleared the call at 1839 hrs.

At 1931 hrs, I (along with Officer Franquemont acting as a two man unit) responded back to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was standing outside the building. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] had returned and had locked her out of the apartment. She stated that her son [REDACTED] was still inside. SGT Mikalik stated that [REDACTED] was not being cooperative. [REDACTED] could be seen inside through the windows. Officer Wright and I attempted to make contact with [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] opened the door and stepped out of the apartment. Officer Wright and I performed a Terry Pat down on him. When

asked if he had anything in his pockets, [REDACTED] stated that he had a blunt/roach in his right pocket. I searched his right side; Officer Wright searched his left side. In [REDACTED]'s front right pocket was a small baggie of a green leafy substance with the strong odor of cannabis. I seized the small baggie/substance and asked SGT Mikalik what he wanted me to do with it. He informed me to stomp it out and disperse it on the ground since it was such a small amount. I placed the baggie in my pocket for later disposal.

I interviewed [REDACTED] and asked him to tell me what happened, meanwhile [REDACTED] was returned to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] found a condom in his wallet and confronted him. He said that she started yelling and badgering him persistently. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] tried to "pepper spray" and "taze" him. He also stated that she tried to bite him. [REDACTED] had no visible injuries or marks on his person. He said that he did not need medical treatment/attention. [REDACTED] stated that since [REDACTED] was acting irrational, he and [REDACTED] decided to leave in his vehicle.

After talking with both parties, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] agreed that it would be best if [REDACTED] went with [REDACTED] and stayed somewhere else for a while until both individuals cooled off. Officers conducted a standby while [REDACTED] gathered his belongings/property. During this time [REDACTED] kept asking [REDACTED] what she did with his Xbox since he could not find it in the bedroom. This became a heated topic of discussion between the two. During one of his trips to/from his vehicle, [REDACTED] charged in the front door at an aggressive pace/manner directly towards [REDACTED] (sitting on the living room couch with [REDACTED]). From my perspective (standing in the living room), it appeared that [REDACTED] was going to make contact with [REDACTED], or place his hands on her in an aggressive manner. I stepped between the two before [REDACTED] got to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] continued to push me towards [REDACTED] saying, "give me my damn Xbox." I was able push [REDACTED] back away from [REDACTED] a little, and then he continued to push me towards [REDACTED] a second time.

[REDACTED] got within approximately 6 inches of [REDACTED] face when Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont grabbed [REDACTED] and placed his hands behind his back. (See Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont's supplemental reports) Officer Wright informed [REDACTED] that he was under arrest for assault. Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont placed handcuffs on [REDACTED] and double locked them. [REDACTED] began to actively resist and push back

against Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont. Officer Franquemont pushed the back of [REDACTED]'s head forward/downward, forcing him onto some pillows that were stacked on the couch. [REDACTED] stated that he was "cool" and that he no longer wanted to resist. [REDACTED] stood back up and began to resist again. [REDACTED] attempted to force Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont back while pushing away from the couch. Officer Franquemont attempted to take [REDACTED] to the ground to control him. He placed his arm around the back of [REDACTED]'s neck, and they both went down to the ground simultaneously. Once on the ground, Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont were able to get [REDACTED] in an upright seated position. [REDACTED] was continuing to resist by actively moving his legs. I placed my shins over [REDACTED]'s legs and used my body weight to control his movement. He stated that he was "cool" again and became cooperative.

[REDACTED] was searched and Officers found no additional contraband or weapons. He was escorted to the squad car outside of the apartment complex. While Officer Wright and Officer Franquemont were escorting him to the squad car he began to complain that he was having a hard time breathing and that he has asthma. Officers let [REDACTED] lay down on the ground on his side/back. Officers asked him if he needed medical attention. [REDACTED] stated "no." Officer Wright advised METCAD to send an ambulance to our location check [REDACTED]'s condition. Pro Ambulance arrived on scene and paramedics cleared [REDACTED] for transport to the county jail. [REDACTED] was placed in the back of the squad car. Officer Wright read him his Miranda Rights at approximately 2040 hrs. [REDACTED] stated that he understood his rights.

Officer Franquemont was complaining of minor knee pain from taking [REDACTED] down to the ground in the apartment. SGT Mikalik informed him to get it checked out at the hospital. Officer Franquemont cleared the scene to get medical treatment at Carle.

I transported [REDACTED] to the county jail at 2048 hrs. I arrived at the jail at 2054 hrs. While in booking, a Jail staff supervisor stated that [REDACTED] needed to be cleared at a hospital by a medical doctor. At 2111 hrs I transported [REDACTED] to Carle Hospital. I arrived at Carle at 2116 hrs. While at the hospital I disposed of the baggie and green leafy substance. I poured the contents down a storm drain and disposed of the baggie in a trash can. A medical doctor cleared [REDACTED] at 2220 hrs. I transported him to the county jail at 2212 hrs. I arrived at the county jail at 2216 hrs.



[REDACTED] was booked and processed into the county jail and left in the care of the jail staff. I cleared the call at 2228 hrs.

On 9/10/17 at approximately 0045 hrs, I called and notified DCFS of the incident/arrest and the juvenile involved. DCFS said they would notify Officer Franquemont before the end of his shift (0700 hrs).
