Your Affiant obtained the following information by personal observations, interviews, witnesses, discussions with fellow officers and by reviewing official police reports of the Denver Police Department.

On February 24, 2023, at 8:15 p.m., the Denver Police Combined Communication Center received a 911 call from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that his mother was just shot at the residence of 47 [REDACTED] N. Durham Court. The address of 47 [REDACTED] N. Durham Court is in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] provided the following information to the 911 operator for the Denver Police Combined Communication Center:

Mr. [REDACTED] stated he was following the person who killed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] was in a red Mustang and was following the suspect who was driving a Silver Nissan Altima with Colorado plate# [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] followed the Silver Nissan Altima southbound on N. Chambers Road to Eastbound I-70. Mr. [REDACTED] stated his son, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED], was in the Silver Nissan Altima with the suspect. Mr. [REDACTED] stated the suspect that shot his mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED], was [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and it was later corrected to Clemente Flores-Hernandez. Mr. [REDACTED] continued to follow Mr. Flores-Hernandez on Eastbound I-70 towards Strasburg, CO. Near Mile Marker 312, Adams County Sheriff Deputies deployed stop sticks which disabled Mr. Flores-Hernandez's Silver Nissan Altima. Mr. Flores-Hernandez exited the Silver Nissan Altima with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in his arms and was eventually taken into custody.

Officer Michael Renkosiak 22049 contacted Mr. [REDACTED] who was on scene at the location of where Flores-Hernandez was taken into custody. Officer Renkosiak read Mr. [REDACTED] the photo line-up advisement card and Mr. [REDACTED] positively identified Flores-Hernandez as the person who shot his mother [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This identification occurred at approximately 8:49 p.m.

When the above events were occurring Officer Louis Machorro-Cortez 19108 and Officer Lauren Flores 22033 arrived at 47 N. Durham Court at 8:19 p.m. Officers reported that the victim was suffering from what appeared to be at least one gunshot wound to the head. Officers reported was in the living room area of the residence and reported observing three (3) spent cartridge casings near body.

Denver Health Medical Center Ambulance #69 arrived on scene and pronounced the victim deceased at 8:29 p.m. by Doctor Moriguchi with Denver Health Medical Center.

Your Affiant interviewed Mr. at Denver Police Headquarters after he and were treated and released from the hospital. Mr. said that he and his son were in the basement of the residence, 47 N. Durham Ct. Mr. said that his mother, called them upstairs for dinner but only went upstairs, and Mr. stayed in the basement. Mr. said several minutes later he heard numerous gunshots. Mr. said he went upstairs after hearing the gunshots and while he was still going upstairs, he observed the defendant, Mr. Flores-Hernandez approaching him with a gun pointed at him. Mr. said that he began struggling with the defendant over the gun and during this struggle the gun discharged. Mr. described the gun as being empty, and out of ammunition, and this is when he said the defendant threw the gun. Mr. said the defendant then began to physically assault Mr. by placing his hand around Mr. throat and pushing him up against a wall. Mr. reported he was unable to breathe, was dizzy and felt he was going to lose consciousness.

Mr. said he was eventually able to get away from the suspect and tried to run away but was unable to because he was having trouble breathing. Mr. said the defendant went over to the couch where was, grabbed, left the residence, and got into a car with and began driving away. Mr. said he retrieved his car keys and began following the defendant until the defendant was eventually stopped by the police and he was reunited with his son.

Mr. said the defendant and his mother have been in a relationship for several years and have also lived together for several years. Neither Mr. nor suffered serious bodily injury during this incident.]
