Dear Requester:

This is in response to your request dated March 16, 2023 under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), seeking access to consumer complaints re: TikTok. In accordance with the FOIA and agency policy, we have searched our records on March 16, 2023.

We have located 1301 responsive complaints that consumers have made to the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC"). We are providing a sample of the most recent 200 complaints. You should know that the enclosed complaints have not necessarily been verified by the FTC. Therefore, you should make your own judgment about relying on the information provided. I am denying access to consumers' names and addresses, and any other identifying information found in the complaints. This information is exempt from release under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), because individuals' right to privacy outweighs the general public's interest in seeing personal identifying information. *See The Lakin Law Firm v. FTC*, 352 F.3d 1122 (7th Cir. 2003).
