- It must at minimum 500 words.
- It must avoid the "Top 10 Usage Errors."
- It must follow the four principles of essay organization.
- It must have an Intro that begins with a hook and concludes with a clear thesis.
- It must incorporate at least two quotations from at least one of two sources: my lecture on racial justice and/or the reading from Jemar Tisby's *The Color of Compromise*.
- It must follow MLA guidelines.
 - **o** For one quote, place the signal phrase at the beginning of the sentence.
 - For the second quote, place the signal phrase at the end of the sentence.
 - Be sure that your quotation marks, punctuation marks, page numbers, parentheses, and (if relevant) page numbers are all in the correct place.
 - Don't forget your Works Cited page.

Write a persuasive in which you argue why you believe racism has been prevalent in Christianity and in the Christian church.
