Arson, Vandalism, and Other Destruction at Catholic Churches in the United States

Summary: At least 250 incidents have occurred across 42 states and the District of Columbia since May 2020. Incidents include arson, statues beheaded, limbs cut, smashed, and painted, gravestones defaced with swastikas and anti-Catholic language and American flags next to them burned, and other destruction and vandalism.
