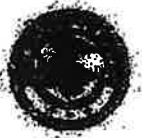

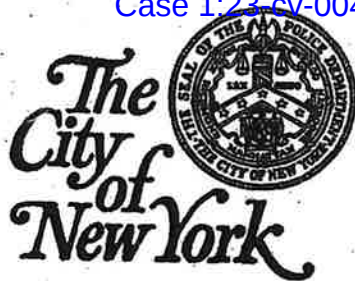

Pursuant to the subpoenas, signed on July 29, 2020 and August 11, 2020, respectively, please see the attached documents which are true and accurate representations of the originals. After an exhaustive search by the NYPD we cannot currently locate any reports, records, receipts or authorizations for travel on the case involving Alexander Williams, date of birth February 8, 1981, for the period of June 2018 to August 2018, concerning the death of George Lee in the 79th Precinct. There are fourteen additional arrest photos that are connected to sealed arrests and those photos were destroyed in accordance with CPL Article 160. Also, there are multiple arrests that are included in this packet that do not contain arrest photos. Finally, there are four arrest reports for arrests that occurred while the Defendant was a minor. We advise the Court that if these records are to be turned over that they should only be turned over to the Defendant or his legal representative(s) in accordance with the Raise the Age Law.



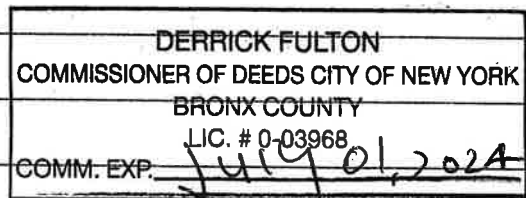


