REAPPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND ELEVEN DOLLARS (\$486,011) FROM THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX FUND (206000), ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT, MOBILE CRISIS TEAM, ALL TO THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX FUND (206000), ANCHORAGE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, TO BE USED FOR A GRANT TO THE ANCHORAGE COALITION TO END HOMELESSNESS (ACEH).

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

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<u>Section 1.</u> That the sum of FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$471,215) of Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000) Fund Balance, is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000), Anchorage Health Department, to be used for a grant to the Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness.

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<u>Section 2.</u> That the sum of ONE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$192,774) of projected Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Revenues is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000), Anchorage Health Department, to be used for a grant to the Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness.

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<u>Section 3.</u> That the sum of FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND ELEVEN DOLLARS (\$486,011) is hereby reappropriated from the Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000), Anchorage Fire Department, Mobile Crisis Team, to the Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000), Anchorage Health Department, to be used for a grant to the Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness.

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Section 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$471,215) OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX FUND (206000) FUND BALANCE, ONE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN **SEVENTY-FOUR DOLLARS** HUNDRED (\$192,774) PROJECTED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX REVENUES. AND REAPPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND ELEVEN DOLLARS (\$486,011) FROM THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX FUND (206000), ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT, MOBILE CRISIS TEAM, ALL TO THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX FUND (206000), ANCHORAGE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, TO BE USED FOR A GRANT TO THE ANCHORAGE COALITION TO

END HOMELESSNESS (ACEH).

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The attached resolution appropriates a total of \$1,150,000 to the Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness (ACEH).

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Municipality of Anchorage currently has a \$700,000 grant in place with ACEH for street outreach services for the period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023, as approved by AM 79-2023. \$1,150,000 in funding is requested to supplement this grant as detailed below:

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Section 1: Housing Focused Outreach: increase the number of housing navigators in the community to work with street outreach teams to ensure people are housing ready and connect them to housing services.

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Section 2: Expanded Contact Driven Outreach: increase outreach personnel to increase current outreach efforts including: outreach pop ups, encampment outreach, and providing resources to meet basic needs.

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Section 3: Mobile Navigation Services: provide services through coordination with multiple providers to increase the number of individuals connected to social services and to provide for basic needs such as showering, clothing, healthcare, and food.

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Section 4: Services for Highly Vulnerable Individuals: provide services to address the significant medical needs of individuals with mobility and chronic health issues.
