AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE FOR WARRANTLESS ARREST

## PROBABLE CAUSE FOR THIS ARREST IS AS FOLLOWS:

"So now, you answer me this ... Between the hours of midnight yesterday, and right now, where they disappear to? ... Did you check your basement? How many boxes of the Moderna where there? ... Oh, you think this is funny? ... Yo! You're making me say way too much on this line already. ... Marculo's on the line here too. You best quit messing with me! ... You know what? I'm going to tell you, I know what you said the other day. ... You telling me, you didn't tell Vito; that you were going to try to move the three boxes of that AstraZeneca outside this family? ... You saying you ain't said that?! ... Oh, I'm getting so angry. ... You saying, you ain't said that?! ... Yau come here. Say it to my face. ... Yeah, yeah! I want you to say it to my face! .... Hahahahahaha! You've just been pranked by PrankDial.com."

I learned that the caller ID of the prank call had been set to appear as though it was coming from South Dakota Governor Kristi Noem's personal cell phone. D.L provided law enforcement with a screenshot of this call, which showed the Governor's personal cell phone number and contact information to be displayed.

I provided a subpoena to PrankDial Customer Support, and learned that the IP Address used to make the prank call was: 2605:4a80:a300:f1e0:7871:c904:35c5:3be2 on 1/22/23 at 20:27:59. A search of the American Registry for Internet Numbers (ARIN) shows that the IP Address used is registered to Midcontinent Communications.

I then obtained a subpoena for subscriber records related to the Midcontinent Communications IP Address from the Hughes County State Attorney's Office which was served to Midcontinent Communications. On March 30th, 2023, Midcontinent Communications provided me with their production of records in response to my subpoena. Upon reviewing these records, I observed the IP Address in question to have been utilized by the account of Austin Goss ( registered as living In Fort Pierre, I learned that Austin is a political ournalist for various news outlets. Upon viewing open-source information posted by Austin, it appears that he has had several personal and professional contacts with Governor Noem, and they have been featured in multiple pictures together, it would stand to reason that Austin may have come into possession of Governor Noem's personal phone number during one of these contacts. I then made telephonic contact with D.L. D.L explained that he did know Austin, as he has had to work with him professionally on several occasions. D.L advised that Austin definitely has his (D.U's) personal phone number, because Austin will occasionally text him (D.L) snide or rude remarks.D.L went on to explain to me that he was annoyed by the prank phone call and that the tone and tenor of the audio recording startled him and caused him concern for his safety. Upon interviewing Austin, I learned that he has lived approximately two years, has Midcontinent Communications provided internet service, and his home Wi-Fi is password protected. Meaning that the use of his home internet would be restricted to himself and those whom he has personally allowed access, such as his wife or twoyear-old child. I further determined that Austin's wife and two year old child would not be expected to have contact information for D.L or Governor Noem, nor was I able to determine any motive outside of Austin's own dislike for D.L. Based on the totality of the circumstances and the facts of this case; I determined that probable cause exists to believe that Austin Goss did contact D.L by telephone or other electronic device with the intent to harass and annoy him, and in doing do intentionally caused a fictitious and misleading caller identification or telephone number (that of Governor Kristi Noem) to be displayed. 24th day of April 2023 at Pierre, South Dakota Dated this Signed Charles 7.
