2 **TO MAKE A SEARCH:** of storage unit [REDACTED] located at Derrels Mini Storage, 800 N. Ben Maddox Way,
3 Visalia, California, to be further referenced as Subject Premises. This location is Derrels Mini Storage.
4 It is a storage unit facility with outside access storage units that can be rented monthly. The storage
5 units are individually secured with locks, all located behind a gate and fence surrounding the entire
6 property. Julia's [REDACTED] located on the fifth row from the south end. [REDACTED] is light brown with
7 dark brown trim. The storage unit has two doors that swing open, and the number [REDACTED] is on the left
8 door in black stickers.

10 The search is to include all rooms, attics, basements, and all other parts therein as well as the
11 surrounding grounds or curtilage, storage rooms, or outbuildings of any kind located on the premises.
12 The search will include all persons that may be contacted and are present at the time of the search
13 warrant. The search will also include all vehicles in the immediate vicinity of the Subject Premises that
14 can be connected to the property by one of more of the following: paperwork, registration, keys and/or
15 verbal claim of ownership by residents at the involved location. Detective Tyler Haener and/or those
16 under their direction are authorized during the execution of this search warrant to video tape,
17 photograph, take digital images such as 3-D mapping images, and collect any measurements of
18 physical items within the location at the discretion of the searching officers both inside and outside of
19 the location. These images or recordings may include any and all items, vehicles at the location, and all
20 persons present at the location during the period of execution of this search warrant.

24 and control of the location, premises, automobiles, or items to be seized. These items may include

32 or unidentified. These items may also include answering machines, tape recorders, or any other
33 recording devices believed to contain an audio recording of the person(s) residing at or responsible
34 for unit [REDACTED], at 800 N. Ben Maddox Way in the city of Visalia, and any examples of handwriting
35 including letters, address books, business records, canceled checks, notes, and/or lists.
