



Greetings. This is a request for an estimated date of completion, sent on May 3, for an update regarding FOIA appeal DOC-OS-2022-001632, which I submitted on May 11, 2022. As the statutory deadline for a final determination was on or around June 8, 2022, I would greatly appreciate an estimated date of completion for this appeal. While it is true that agencies are not required to provide an estimated date of completion for appellate matters, the Department of Justice Office of Information Policy (OIP) has urged agencies to maintain open lines of communication with requesters.
