Dear Requester Center,

Mr. John Christian Wilson is a client of our office. He made his request for records on September 6, 2022. The Department of State acknowledged his request and assigned it F-2022-12609.

Your email of September 14, 2022 stated, "If you have any questions regarding your request, would like to narrow the scope or arrange an alternative time frame to speed its processing, or would like an estimated date of completion, please contact our FOIA Requester Service Center or our FOIA Public Liaison by email at FOIAstatus@state.gov or telephone at 202-261-8484."

The Department of State has not supplied an estimated completion date regarding the request.

Title 5 United States Code § 552 (a)(7)(B)(ii) states that each agency shall provide the person making a request for records an estimated date on which the agency will complete action on the request. The law states:

"Each agency shall -- . . . (B) establish a telephone line or Internet service that provides information about the status of a request to the person making the request using the assigned tracking number, including -- . . . (ii) an estimated date on which the agency will complete action on the request."

This provision was enacted by Congress in 2007. According to the Office of Government Information Services Freedom of Information Act Ombudsman "[t]his requirement helps the requester better understand the agency's FOIA process and gives the requester a more accurate picture of when he/she will receive a response."

In this instance, the agency has not provided my client with an Estimated Completion Date. Demand is formally made upon you to provide an Estimated Completion Date. This Estimated Completion Date may be provided to me via email at peter@sorensonfoialaw.com.
