Homicide: 2700 block of Langston Place, Southeast

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Homicide Branch are investigating a homicide that occurred on Sunday, June 18, 2023, in the 2700 block of Langston Place, Southeast

At approximately 8:43 p.m., Seventh District officers responded to the listed location for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a juvenile male victim and an adult male shooting victim. DC Fire and Emergency Medical Services responded to the scene and transported the victims to area hospitals for treatment, where they succumbed to their injuries.

The decedents have been identified as **15-year-old Demarcos Pinkney**, of Southeast, DC and **18-year-old Kevin Mason**, of Southeast, DC.

The Metropolitan Police Department currently offers a reward of up to **\$25,000** for each homicide, bringing the total reward amount in this case up to **\$50,000** to anyone that provides information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for each homicide committed in the District of Columbia.
