#### LETTER FOR APPLICATION TO THE ANCHORAGE LIBRARY COMMISSION

The majority of my children's lives have been spent growing up in Anchorage over the past ten years. As homeschoolers, we utilize the library often, especially throughout my kids' younger years. There is a Muldoon favorite librarian who would always compassionately speak to them when they lost a book or had to pay overdue fines. My young daughter would routinely walk out with so many books, one would wonder who weighed more, the books or herself! When the pandemic hit and the libraries were closed, I offered to get her books without going inside, but she didn't just want the books— she wanted the library. She cried huge tears when she realized it would be closed for an indefinite period of time. Delight returned when she could go again and get lost in the isles of books.

Libraries help the next generation develop a relationship with books and with knowledge. In an increasingly digital world, libraries help us focus on what is valuable and help us slow down enough to enjoy learning. Local libraries are where diverse communities can come together and share diverse viewpoints regardless of externals such as income level, age, or education level. They should be preserved and maintained as a safe place for all Anchorage residents, particularly our young ones. Over the past few years, the safety and welcoming atmosphere at the library has diminished, particularly for families. I am concerned about this and would like to help restore the people's feeling of trust and joint ownership of our libraries so that we can enjoy them for many years to come.
