AGREED ORDER MODIFYING PRIOR ORDER

On June 16, 2023, the parties having reached an agreement as to all pending matters before the Court, intend that this Agreed Order shall resolve all claims and counterclaims. Plaintiff, Lunden Roberts, by and through her counsel, Clinton W. Lancaster and Jennifer Lancaster, have approved this Agreed Order. Defendant, Hunter Biden, by and through his counsel, Brent M. Langdon and Abbe Lowell, have approved this Agreed Order. The Court, being well and sufficiently advised, approves of the agreement of the parties set forth in this Agreed Order Modifying Prior Order and FINDS and ORDERS in the best interest of the child, the following relief:

1. That the essential terms of this Order are sealed pursuant to Ark. Sup. Ct. Admin. Order No. 19. All previously sealed documents filed or disclosed by the parties or marked as "confidential" or "to be sealed" shall remain sealed and confidential to the parties and their attorneys and experts pursuant to Ark. Sup. Ct. Admin. Order No. 19. The Clerk of the Court shall keep the unredacted version of this Order and all other sealed documents filed in the record of this case in a secure location inaccessible by the public and shall permit no one but the Court, essential members of the Clerk's staff, the parties, or the attorneys of record for the parties from accessing the unredacted copy of this Order. Such action is in the best interest of the child.

2. That the parties have each prepared and exchanged the requisite Affidavit of Means and Defendant's child support was calculated pursuant to Administrative Rule 10 to be

[REDACTED] monthly per the attached Child Support Worksheet. The parties have agreed to an upward deviation wherein Defendant shall pay to Plaintiff [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] monthly beginning July 1, 2023, and the same due on the first day of every month thereafter until the earliest occurrence of one of the following specified events:

a. The child reach the age of eighteen years, provided that, if the child is fully enrolled in an accredited secondary school in a program leading toward a high school diploma, the periodic payments shall continue to be due and paid until the end of month in which the child graduates;

b. the child marries;

c. the child dies;

d. the child's disabilities are otherwise removed for general purposes;

e. the child is otherwise emancipated; or

f. further order of the Court modifying this child support.

3. Defendant shall provide to Plaintiff his tax return each year upon completion.

4. Defendant shall continue to reimburse Plaintiff for the cost of health insurance for the child as previously ordered.

5. Defendant additionally agrees that he shall assign to the child [REDACTED] of his paintings over the next [REDACTED] which shall vary in size with a minimum size of 24x24. The child shall select the painting which shall either be sent to the child or sent to a gallery designated by Lunden Roberts. The net proceeds of any sales of paintings shall be wired to an account designated by Lunden Roberts.

7. Within the next five (5) years, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED], the parties shall discuss providing a college education fund for the child.

8. The Defendant shall pay to the Lancaster Law Firm the sum of [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] to an account designated by the plaintiff's law firm for her attorney's fees and costs payable in [REDACTED] beginning July 1, 2023 and a like payment on the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full.

9. The Plaintiff withdraws her counterclaim for name change of the child.

10. This Court retains jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this case for any further or additional orders that may be necessary or required in the future.


11. That this is a final order and all other claims or counterclaims are dismissed.
