Order Granting Defendants’ Agreed
Motion to Extend Deadlines

This matter came before the Court on Defendants’ United States Department of Justice and the Drug Enforcement Administration’s (together, DEA) Agreed Motion to Extend Deadlines. The DEA’s Agreed Motion states that Plaintiff Human Rights Defense Center agrees to the requested relief. For the reasons stated in the DEA’s Agreed Motion, the Court finds good cause to extend the deadlines set by the Court’s Order on the parties’ cross-motions for summary judgment. ECF No. 33 at 33-34 (SJ Order). Accordingly the Court GRANTS the DEA’s Agreed Motion and extends those deadlines, as follows:

- 1 • The DEA shall produce responsive documents without redaction of certain
2 information, as directed by the SJ Order at 33, ¶ 4, by August 21, 2023;
- 3 • The DEA shall file further briefing and accompanying papers regarding sealed “files
4 18 and 19,” as directed by the SJ Order at 33-34, ¶ 6, by 5:00 p.m., August 7, 2023.
5 HRDC’s optional response shall be due by 5:00 p.m., August 21, 2023;
- 6 • The DEA shall produce all meaningful, reasonably segregable, non-exempt portions
7 of narrative descriptions of alleged wrongdoing, and a supplemental *Vaughn* index
8 and declaration, as directed by the SJ Order at 34, ¶ 7, by 5:00 p.m., August 14, 2023.
