All records of grant agreements, cooperative agreements, other agreements for assistance covered in § 200.40 Federal financial assistance of the OMB Uniform Grant Guidance, for proposals relating to Countering dis and misinformation; 5. All records of Reporting received from Recipients during the post award phase, including closeout, for proposals relating to Countering dis and misinformation; and 6. All records of Audits conducted during the post award phase, for proposals relating to Countering dis and misinformation. B. All records relating to or regarding the processing of the above items".
