| <p>On Thursday March 26, 2020 at approximately 3:00 p.m. I K9 Officer S. McReynolds had my assigned canine Boris # 888-02-0460 at Southwest Veterinary Services for his first scheduled checkup as my assigned canine. Canine Boris was extremely aggressive towards Dr. Mister and myself. I had Dr. Mister to exit the exam room while I administered a mild correction to canine Boris. This brought canine Boris under control and I had Dr. Mister reenter the exam room to continue the examination. Boris was calm and allowed Dr. Mister to continue when Dr. Mister attempted to hold Boris' front leg to attempt to draw blood Boris again became aggressive and jumped off the exam table trying to bite myself trough the muzzle. I held Boris around the shoulders and head in the floor to protect Dr. Mister and myself from the possibility of being injured with Boris' muzzle. Boris fought to free himself from my hold but failed to do so. Dr. Mister decided to try to work with Boris on the floor to see if he responded with less aggression. Boris was still combative but more controllable on the floor, as Dr. Mister attempted to draw blood from Boris back leg; I maintained control of Boris' head. Dr. Mister noticed the blood was not flowing and that Boris had urinated in the floor. From my position, holding the head I could not see any of this my focus was on protecting the Doctor from injury. Dr. Mister notified myself the doctor checked for a heartbeat and located one, Boris breathing was irregular so Dr. Mister and I carried Boris to a table for oxygen. Oxygen was placed on Boris when suddenly his heart stopped beating. CPR was performed by Dr. Mister, Boris failed to respond to all efforts and was pronounced deceased at 3:25p.m. End of report.</p> |                               |  |                          |
