The records consist of Salvadoran Army interrogation reports, reports of atrocities, a history of the FMLN and each of its five factions, biographical data on insurgent leaders, and a tactical intelligence support package (including aerial reconnaissance photographs). A majority of the records are documents captured from the FMLN; including correspondence and messages between FMLN factions, communication manuals, organizational charts, journals, weapons statistics, target data, and military strategy.
