To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), I hereby request the following:

Any and all Central American Joint Intelligence Team (CAJIT) documents regarding Salvadoran Government Military Operations which include in their titles "Working Aid" from January 01 1982 to 31 December 1992. For your convenience I have attached two examples of the type of document I am seeking (Attachment 1 and Attachment 2).

Our organization believes that the Defense Intelligence Agency is in possession of working Aid documents because, as demonstrated through the attached "Working Aid" documents, the DIA has released them to us in the past. We believe the DIA is in possession of many more "Working Aid" documents pertaining to El Salvador because the documents we have obtained are dated monthly and U.S. involvement in El Salvador lasted a decade.

As the FOIA requires, please release all reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of documents. To allow me to reach an intelligent and informed decision whether or not to file an administrative appeal of any denied material, please describe any withheld records or portions of records and explain the reasoning for exemption.

This request is made for scholarly and research purposes that are intended for publication and are not for commercial use.
