WHEREAS, on May 3, 2023, the Department of Information and Technology Services found it necessary to make emergency purchases with various vendors to maintain City operations and services because of a cyber-attack; and

WHEREAS, ratification of these purchases allows the City to pay its vendors for hardware, software, professional services, consultants and monitoring services.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to ratify \$8,578,629 to pay invoices due to various vendors for hardware, software, professional services, consultants and monitoring services performed to maintain continuity of City operations as the result of a cyber-attack which occurred on May 3, 2023, for a total amount not to exceed \$8,578,629, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds not to exceed \$3,000,000 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Revenue Code RTRF, to Information Technology Equipment Fund, Fund 0897, Department DSV, Unit 5400, Revenue Code 9229.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds not to exceed \$5,578,629 from General Fund Contingency Reserve Fund, Fund 0001, Department NBG, Unit 1000, Revenue Code RTRF to Information Technology Equipment Fund, Fund 0897, Department DSV, Unit 5400, Revenue Code 9229.

SECTION 4. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$8,578,629 in the Information and Technology Equipment Fund, Fund 0897, Department DSV, Unit 5400, various Object Codes to pay invoices due to various vendors because of the cyber-attack which occurred on May 3, 2023.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager and Chief Financial Officer are authorized to take all actions necessary to file insurance claims and deposit any reimbursement into the General Fund Contingency Reserve Fund, Fund 0001, Department, NBG, Unit 1000, Revenue Code 8519.

SECTION 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
