For the reasons 21 stated in the Defendants' motion, there is good cause to grant the requested stay. 22 Accordingly, the Court hereby stays its "Order Re: Cross-Motions for Summary 23 Judgment" [ECF No. 33] (SJ Order), only insofar as the SJ Order requires the DEA to disclose 24 25 the names of alleged tortfeasors/wrongdoers who are DEA employees. This stay shall remain in 26 effect through the conclusion of any appeal or until the deadline to file a notice of appeal lapses 27 without an appeal being taken. 28
