AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS THE FRANCHISE TO ERECT, CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE PIERS, MASTS, POLES AND OTHER SUPERSTRUCTURES UPON OR FROM WHICH TO SUSPEND, AFFIX AND HANG WIRES, CABLES OR OTHER APPLIANCES FOR TRANSMITTING ELECTRICITY, AND TO LAY MAINTAIN AND OPERATE WIRES, CABLES AND OTHER APPLIANCES FOR TRANSMITTING AND CONDUCTING ELECTRICITY UNDER, OVER, ACROSS, ALONG AND UPON THE COUNTY ROADS, HIGHWAYS, PUBLIC WAYS, STREETS, LANES AND PUBLIC GROUNDS OF AND IN THE COUNTY OF ORANGE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, WHICH COUNTY ROADS, HIGHWAYS, PUBLIC WAYS, STREETS, LANES AND PUBLIC GROUNDS ARE HEREINAFTER IN THIS ORDINANCE SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED.

ORDINANCE NO. 83.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A HEALTH OFFICER AND COUNTY PHYSICIAN TO PROTECT AND PRESERVE THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND DEFINING HIS DUTIES AS SUCH HEALTH OFFICER AND COUNTY PHYSICIAN AND OF OTHER PERSONS.

ORDINANCE NO. 84.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO C. S. S. FORNEY TO MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A SYSTEM OF GAS PIPES IN A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Orange do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The right, privilege and franchise is hereby granted to C. S. S. Forney to lay down and for a period of thirty-five (35) years to maintain a system of gas pipes and pipe lines under and along the following portions of highways within the County of Orange, State of California, to-wit:

situated in Range 9 West, Townships 3, 4, and 5 South; Range

Ordinance No. 82-

An Ordinance to Prohibit the Carrying of Concealed Weapons).

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Orange, State of California do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, except a police officer or other peace officer, to carry upon his person any revolver, pistol, dagger, dirk, slung shot, billy or other instrument of ~~or~~ ^{Weapon} commonly known as a concealed weapon without first having obtained a written permit from the Sheriff of Orange County; provided that this ordinance shall not apply to persons carrying such concealed weapons in any incorporated town or city in said County, nor to any person who carries such weapons on his own property and premises.

Sec. 2. The Sheriff of said County may in his discretion issue permits to responsible parties to carry concealed weapons for a term not exceeding one year; and ^{any} the deputy Sheriff may issue permits to responsible parties to carry concealed weapons for a period not to exceed 10 days, and such permission shall immediately be reported to the Sheriff of said County by such deputy.

Every person applying for and procuring a permit as herein provided shall give to the Sheriff of said County his name and resident address, which information shall be by the Sheriff entered in a book kept for that purpose, and provided by said County, together with a statement

of the date of issuance and number of the permit issued to such person, and a description of such person by age, height, race and color of the eyes and hair.

All such permits shall be in writing signed by the proper officers and shall be furnished at the County expense and a record of all permits so issued shall be kept in the office of the Sheriff of said County.

Sec. 3. - Every person having a permit as provided herein, and who refuses to exhibit such permit upon demand of any peace officer of the County shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 4. Every person ^{found} guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the County jail of Orange County for not less than ten, nor more than one hundred days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect on the 6th day of July, 1910 and prior to the expiration of 15 days from the passage hereof and shall be published for at least one week in the Evening Blade, a newspaper printed and published in the County of Orange, State of California, together with the names of of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same.
