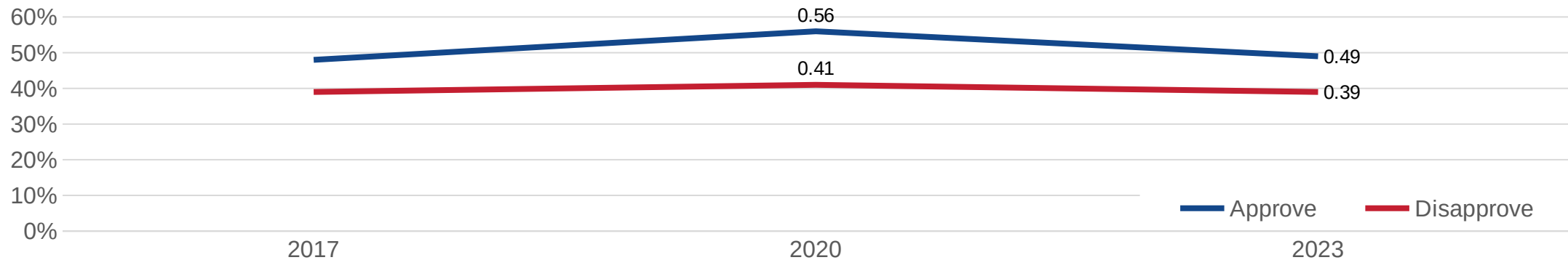
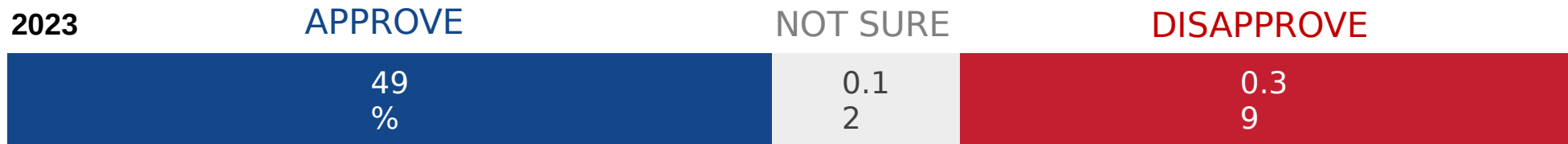


# Approval ratings for President Joe Biden continue to trend downward



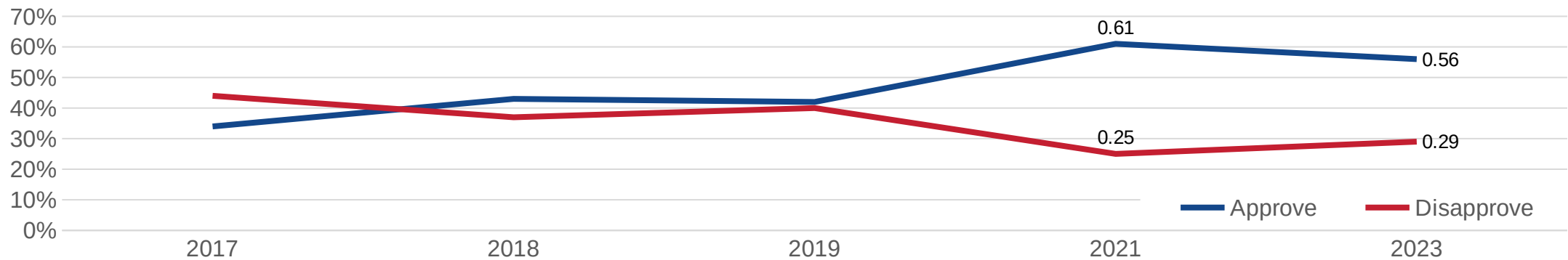


Approval ratings for Donald Trump as candidate for President in 2024 are lower than his job approval rating as President.





# Approval ratings for Jim Justice are slightly lower than in 2021.

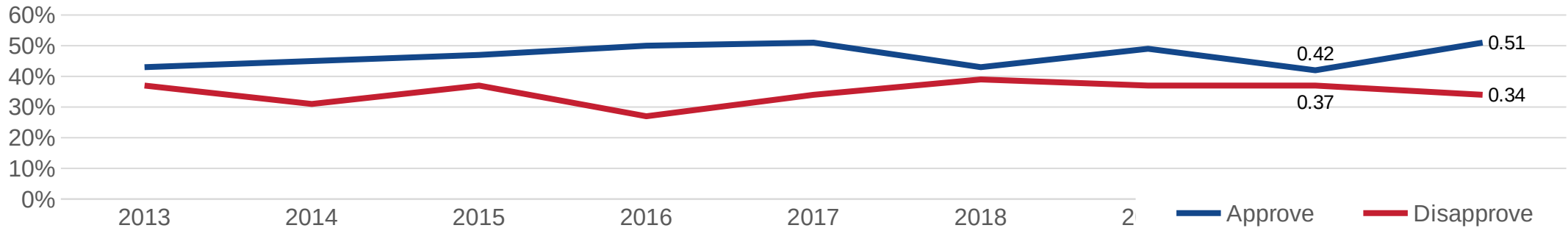

# Approval ratings for Joe Manchin have improved since 2021.

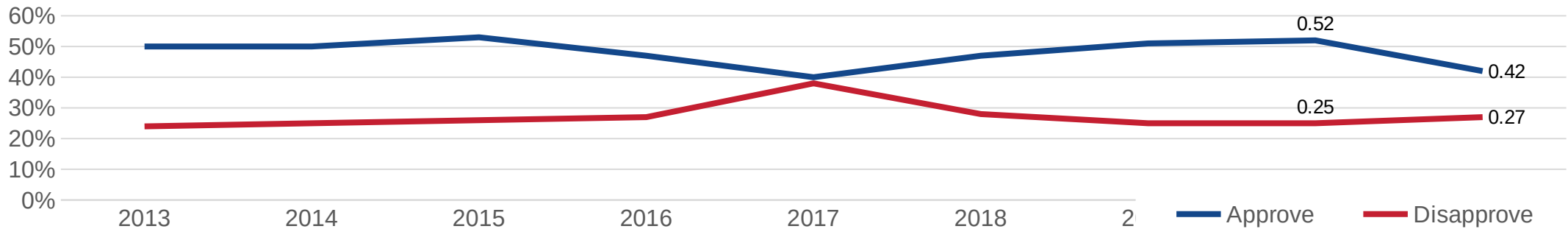
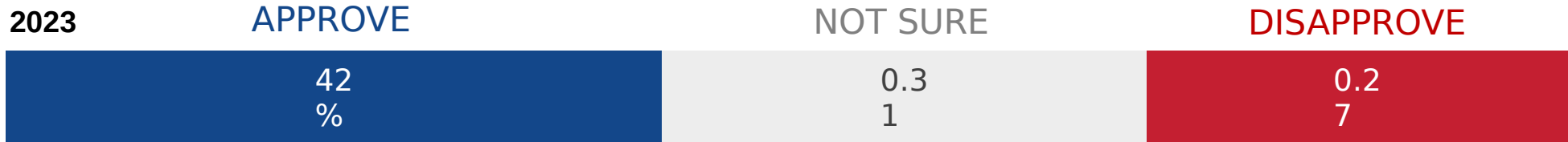

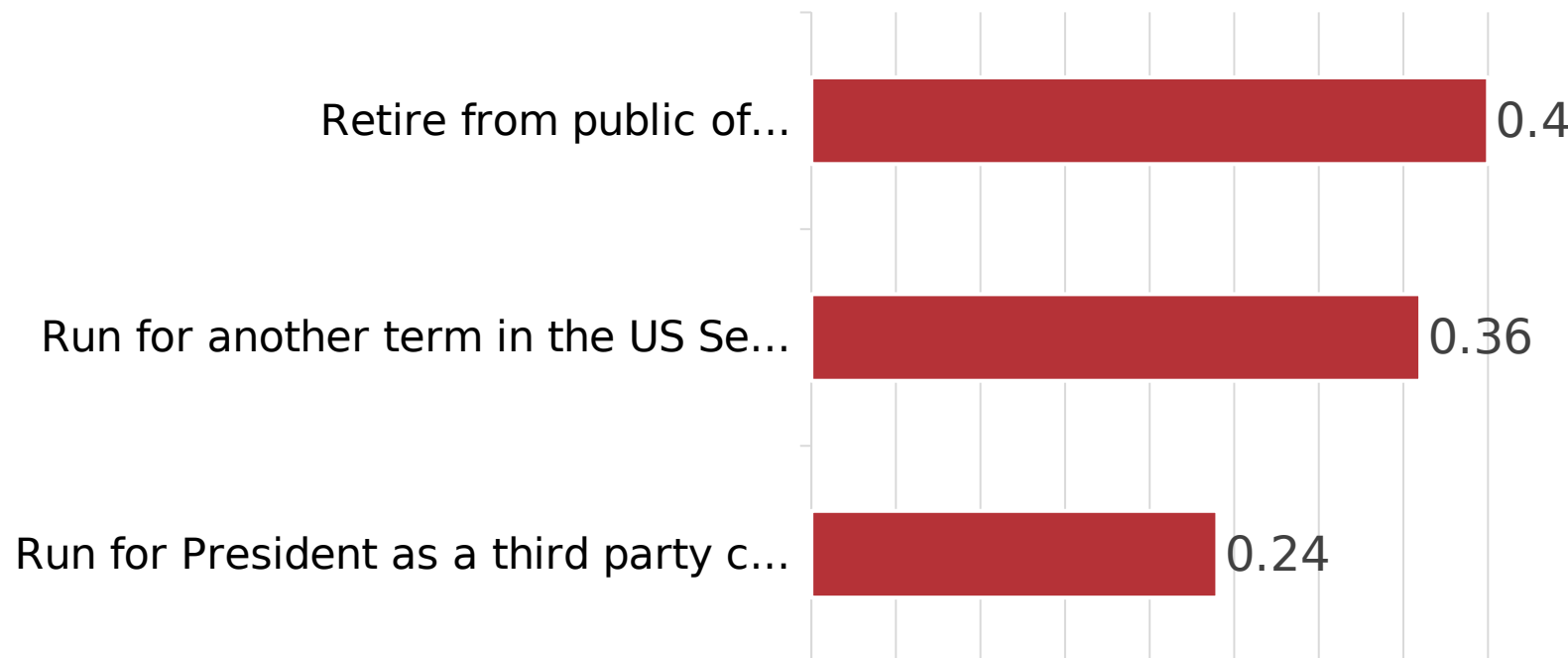


# Approval ratings for Shelley Moore-Capito have declined since 2011.



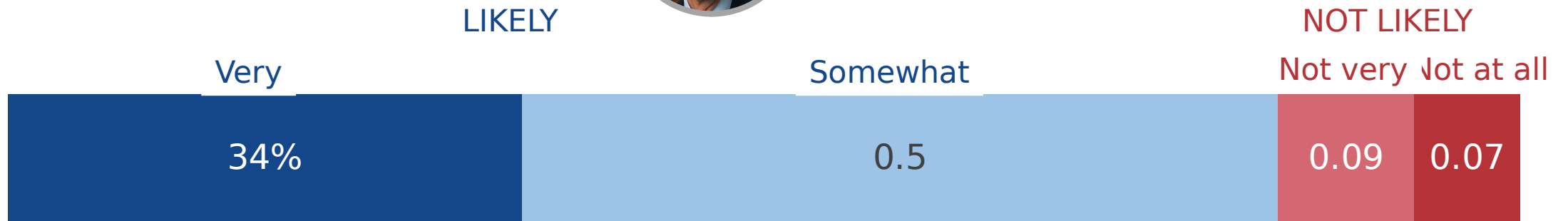


A plurality of West Virginians prefer that Joe Manchin retire from public office next year.

Net Likely = 84%\*

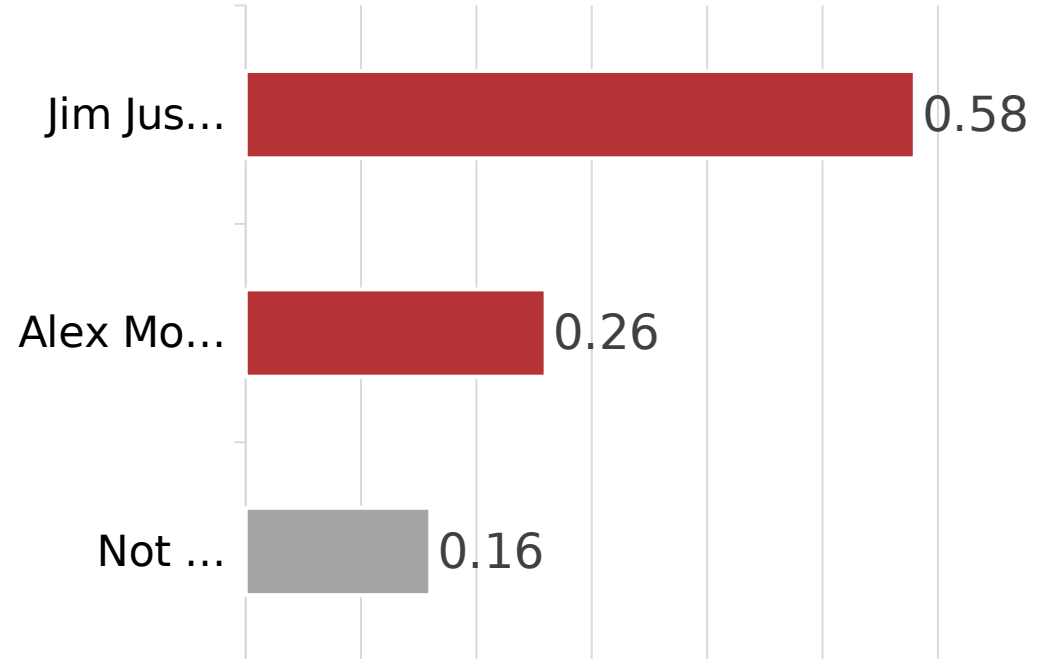
Net Not Likely = 16%

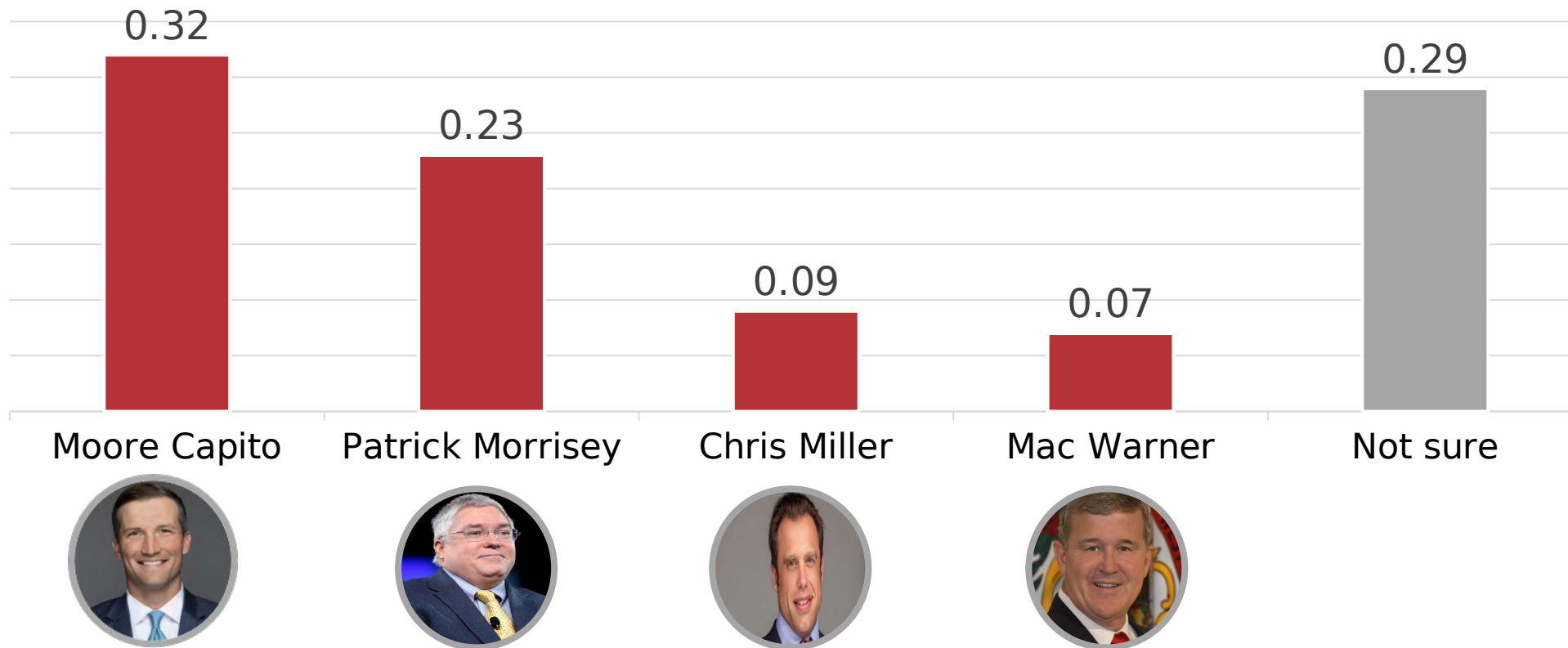


At this early date, Jim Justice has a substantial lead over Alex Mooney for the Republican nomination for the US Senate



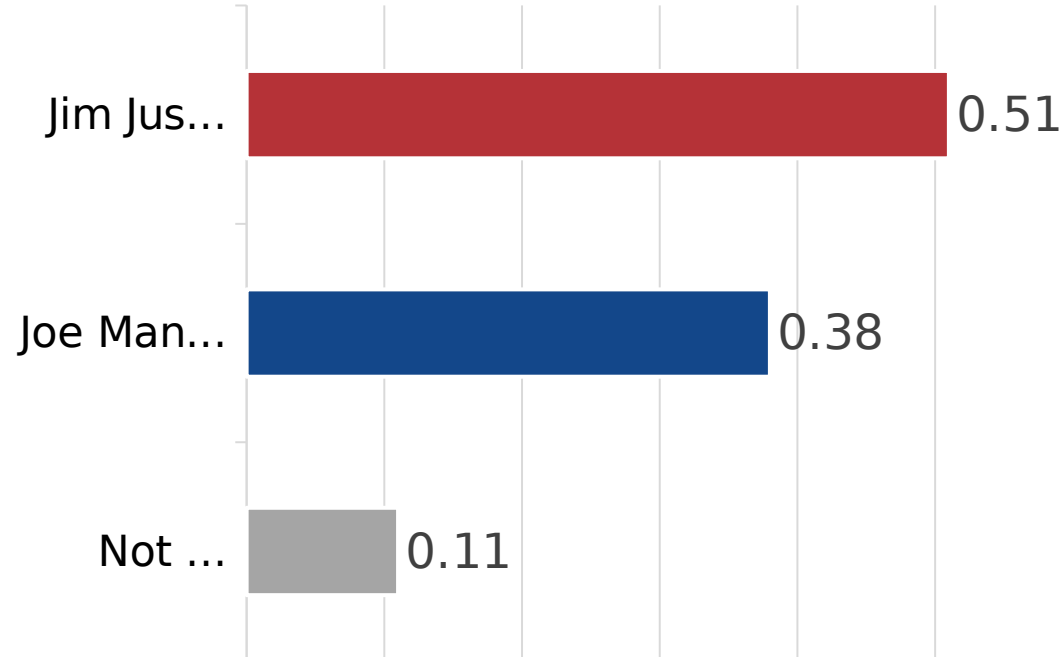


Trial heat for the Republican nomination for Governor shows a nine-point lead for Moore Capito, though 29 percent are undecided.
