



## **Incident Summary**

Synopsis - On Saturday, October 16, 2021, I assisted Officer Alsherdan Lopez with disorderly / disturbance call. Upon arrival to the residence, I met with Officer Lopez and learned he was going to have both the male and female separated for the night due to no evidence of a physical altercation. However, both the male (Federico R. Martinez) and female (Bridgette Bendiola) were extremely intoxicated. I entered the residence and assisted Bridgette with gathering her belonging; she was escorted from a back bedroom to the front of the residence. It was at this point she battered another male (Jeremy Sandoval - Landlord) with closed fist strike to his face. I then physically restrain her and moved her away from Jeremy. An on scene Sheriffs Deputy placed her into custody.

Almost immediately Martinez who was larger in stature than I and who was sitting on a chair had jumped to his feet and quickly moved in my direction as I was restraining Bridgette. The Deputy instructed Martinez several time to sit down. He did not comply. I then place my hands on him to create distance, he then pulled away from me and appeared tense up. It was at this time; Martinez was physically moved by to a nearby couch on to his back utilizing an empty hand takedown. While Martinez was on the couch, I controlled his right hand with my left hand by grasping his wrist. My right hand (w/ flashlight) was at his upper left chest, near his chin. He was no longer offering any physical residence. Martinez was instructed by another Deputy to rollover to his stomach. I maintained control of Martinez's right wrist as he was assisted to the floor where he was placed in handcuffs by the Deputy. Martinez did not offer any more resistance from this point and

was cooperative. He was helped to his feet.

Martinez was cleared medically for incarceration.

I arrived on scene and made contact with the male suspect who was identified as Johnny Santistevan. Immediately I heard Johnny yelling and stating he was going to shoot myself along with accompanying officers. I witnessed Johnny conceal his hands disobeying law enforcement orders to raise his hands in the air. I also witnessed Johnny point his finger at several officers stating he was going to kill them first. Johnny entered and exited multiple vehicles on the property while stating he was obtaining a weapon. I contacted Sgt. Dezjuan Shields of NMSP and advised him of the ongoing situation. At one point I witnessed Johnny to be carrying a sharp object consistent with a knife or a screw driver. Johnny appeared to be highly intoxicated. Johnny continued to refuse to obey commands given to him by NMSP. I along with Officer Matthew Bustos of NMSP as well as a Santa Fe county Sherriff's Deputy then approached Johnny from the rear. Johnny then entered his vehicle. Johnny exited his vehicle and I then deployed my department issued Electronic Control Device (ECD-Taser) resulting in the suspect falling to the ground, stopping his action. Johnny was immediately handcuffed without further incident and Dispatch was advised to send medical personal to our location where they treated to his injuries.





I attempted to grab his arms and he pulled away. At this point, I took him down with a defensive tactics arm take down technique. He landed on his chest facing down and he refused to give me both arms. I applied forced on his back with my right-side elbow and he gave up both arms. I was able to place both handcuffs on him. This incident was recorded with the booking camera.

# **Incident Summary**

On Sunday, November 14, 2021 at approximately 11:07 A.M., I was on duty wearing a New Mexico State Police Class A Uniform, and clearly displaying my badge of office (534). I was patrolling in a marked New Mexico State Police unit (NMSP507) in the, City of Carlsbad, in the, County of Eddy, in the State of New Mexico. On said date and time, I was traveling southbound on Fiesta St. at the intersection of San Jose Blvd. when I observed a bronze in color passenger vehicle bearing a Texas registration traveling northbound on Fiesta St. without a Texas registration plate displayed on the front of the vehicle.

I turned around and initiated my emergency equipment in order to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle continued driving and turned eastbound on San Jose Blvd. before coming to a stop behind the "La Tienda" supermarket.

The passenger of the vehicle later identified as Jonathon Garcia immediately opened the passenger side door and began to run, evading and not listening to commands to stop. I continued to pursue Mr. Garcia on foot and shouted for him to stop multiple times.

Once I was able to gain ground on Mr. Garcia, I was able to place Mr. Garcia on the ground and detain him. Mr. Garcia advised me that the occupants of the vehicle had a firearm and that he ran because he was scared. As I made my way back to my patrol unit, I was able to notice that the vehicle had fled and was no

longer at the place of the traffic stop.

I proceeded to ask Mr. Garcia questions and asked why he ran, Mr. Garcia stated that he had been kidnapped and he was scared. When asked what his name was, Mr. Garcia gave me a false name of "Nick Hernandez" with a date of birth as "03/11/1985". That name was run through NCIC by NMSP dispatch out of all 50 states and no return was made available. I proceeded to ask Mr. Garcia multiple times what his name was. Mr. Garcia failed to give me a correct name and date of birth and was given multiple opportunities.

Mr. Garcia was complaining of leg injuries, I asked for Carlsbad EMS to come and tend to Mr. Garcia. Mr. Garcia then stated that he wanted to go to the hospital for his injuries. I then transported Mr. Garcia to the Carlsbad Medical Center.

It was made known at this time by a Carlsbad Police Officer of Mr. Garcia's real name and date of birth. Mr. Garcia had multiple felony warrants.

I proceeded to place Mr. Garcia under arrest at 11:46 A.M.

Upon medical clearance by Carlsbad Medical Center, I transported Mr. Garcia to the State Police Office in Carlsbad for completion of booking paperwork.

When questioning Mr. Garcia he advised me that one of the occupants of the vehicle was Britney Williams.

On November 18, 2021 at approximately 2122 hours I initiated a traffic stop on a 2009 grey Subaru with no registration plate on Interstate 40 (I-40) at about 155 Mile Post (MP). The vehicle was verified to be traveling 85 Mile Per Hour (MPH) in a 65 MPH zone. The driver of the vehicle sped up and refused to pull over. I had all my emergency equipment turned on including my sirens and called out to dispatch I was in vehicle pursuit and to clear the radio traffic. The driver went from the #3 lane to the #2 lane of travel, then to the exit lanes of Unser Boulevard cutting off other vehicles traveling on the highway. The vehicle continued west at speeds of over 100 MPH. The driver exited 98th Street almost striking 2 vehicles. I requested permission from a supervisor to PIT if speeds allowed. The driver then went southbound on 98th Street, as we approached an intersection, I cleared it by looking left and right before crossing. The driver continued westbound on Arroyo Vista Boulevard at speeds up to 90 MPH. The driver turned right onto Deer Valley Trail NW, there was an iron gate into the community the driver stopped reversed towards my patrol vehicle as the driver tried to turn back to get on Arroyo Vista Boulevard, I performed a Pursuit Intervention Technique (PIT) making contact with the vehicles right rear quarter panel and it was successful has the vehicle got stuck on a rock. The driver fled on foot and I was unable to locate him.



# **Incident Summary**

#### ASSIGNMENT:

This incident documents the information pertaining to a Pursuit Intervention Technique that was performed during a pursuit.

On November 19th, 2021, I, Patrolman Sefie Winders (MTR-13), was on duty in full uniform, displaying my badge of office in a fully marked patrol vehicle within the County of Socorro State of New Mexico.

I was involved in a call for service in reference to 2 male subjects casing the Lemitar Truck Stop and individuals pulling a gun on a store employee.

While responding to this call, the suspects were spotted, and a vehicle pursuit was initiated.

To end the active pursuit on the suspect's vehicle (SV1) a P.I.T. maneuver was performed. A total of 3 attempted were made with the 3rd attempt being successful.

The location of where the P. I. T. was conducted on Interstate 25 northbound near milepost 143. SV1 was traveling at 35mph, and I also verified my speed at 35 MPH. I attempted to P.I.T. twice, both on the left-rear of SV1, but was unsuccessful. After the second attempt, I positioned my unit on the right rear of SV1, at which time the speed showed 15 MPH. I proceeded to contact SV1 with the left front of my bumper. Once I made contact, I proceeded to turn into SV1, rotating the vehicle 90 degrees, causing the car to be immobilized. SV1


was stationary, with the front of the car facing the east.





# **Incident Summary**

On November 21, 2021 at approximately 0020 hours I was in the City of Las Vegas, County of San Miguel State of New Mexico patrolling on 7th Street southbound. in the distance I observed a vehicle traveling northbound on 7th Street speed verified by radar at 46 mph and continued to increases at a fast rate. When the vehicle passed me its top speed verified by radar was 84 mph. The vehicle was identified as a sliver Subaru bearing New Mexico license plate BBYY55. I observed a police vehicle turn on its emergency lights and make a U-turn about a quarter mile in front of me. I also activated my emergency lights made a U-turn to perform a traffic stop on the vehicle speeding.

I continued north bound on 7th Street to catch up with the Subaru. The driver made a right from 7th Street to Mountain View eastbound, took another right onto Collins Drive southbound, right onto Lutheran westbound, left onto 7th Street southbound. The Subaru continued southbound at approximately 90 mph. The Subaru then turned right onto Mills Avenue west bound and then turned left onto 10th Street. The Subaru parked in a driveway. The driver was given commands to get out of the vehicle. The driver got out of the vehicle with his hands up. I approached the driver and gave him commands to turn around so I could place handcuffs on him. The was resisting by trying to walk away and pulling his arms away. I advised the driver not to fight as I was placing a handcuff on his right wrist the driver pulled his arm forward and turned face to face with me. As I tried to push into the driver to try and gain control of him my right hand slid from the drivers chest up to his face hitting his nose. Officer Conner Russell was secondary on the pursuit and was on scene. Officer Russell and I were able to pull the driver down to the ground. The driver was resisting and had to be rolled from his back to his stomach. The driver held his arms under his body avoiding being placed in handcuffs.

Once the driver was placed into handcuffs he was placed into the backseat of my police unit with out further incident. The driver was bleeding from his nose ARM Ambulance was called to scene to treat the driver. The driver was later identified as Devin Montano who is a juvenile. Devin's mother Shirley Gallegos did arrive on scene. I spoke with ADA Don Anque and Judge Christian Montano both advised not to arrest and summons Devin into court. After being treated by AMR Ambulance Devin was released to his mother.







# **Incident Summary**

On November 21, 2021 at approximately 0023 hours I was patrolling on 7th street south bound in the city of Las Vegas, County of San Miguel, State of New Mexico. I observed a vehicle turn north onto 7th Street and verified the speed of the vehicle with my radar at 50 miles per hour in a 40 mile per hour zone. The vehicle continued to gain speed. When the vehicle passed my unit it was traveling at 70 miles per hour. The vehicle was identified as a sliver Subaru bearing New Mexico Registration Plate BBYY55. I proceeded to initiate my emergency equipment and turn around to stop the vehicle. Once I proceeded north bound on 7th Street I observed the vehicle appear to attempt to gain speed to avoid law enforcement. I observed another New Mexico State Police Officer make a U-turn and initiate his emergency equipment in front of me.

I continued north bound on 7th Street in order to catch up with the vehicle. The driver made a right turn from 7th Street onto Mountain View Dr eastbound. The vehicle then took another right onto Collins Drive southbound. The vehicle then took another right onto Lutheran westbound. The vehicle then took a left onto 7th Street southbound. I heard Officer Mares on the radio call out the pursuit. I advised dispatch the 10-3 the radio, the reason for the stop, and direction of travel. The vehicle continued southbound and reached a speed of approximately 92 miles per hour. The vehicle then turned right onto Mills Avenue west bound and then turned left onto 10th Street. The vehicle parked in a driveway on 10th Street. The driver was given commands to get out of the vehicle. The driver got out of the vehicle with his hands up. As NMSP Officer Mares was attempting to get the subject into hand cuffs, I cleared the vehicle to ensure no one else was inside. I observed the male subject turn to face Officer Mares in an aggressive manner. I grabbed the subject by his shoulders and advised him to get on the ground. The male subject did not listen to my command and I forced him to the ground. I rolled the male subject onto his stomach and proceeded to grab his hand so

Officer Mares could place handcuffs on him.

Once the driver was placed into handcuffs he was placed into the backseat of Officer Mares' unit without further incident. An ambulance was called due to the subject bleeding from his nose. The subject was later identified as Mr. Devin Montano, a juvenile. Devin's mother, Ms. Shirley Gallegos, arrived on scene shortly after. The subject was released to his mother as per the Assistant District Attorney.

# **Incident Summary**

On November 27, 2021 I was proceeding to a disturbance/disorderly call at 519 Old National road in Las Vegas, New Mexico. The caller advised the male subject was acting disorderly and yelling.

I arrived on scene at approximately 1540 hours and observed a male subject standing in the driveway with his pants around his ankles. The male subject was later identified as Mr. Herman Lucero. Herman proceeded to moon me and pull his pants back up. I exited my unit and proceeded to go talk to Herman. Herman flipped me off with both hands as I was walking up to him. Herman was sitting down when I asked him what was going on. Herman was aggravated and did not want to talk to me. I advised Herman I was there to help and asked him what he needed. Herman became instantly aggressive and stood up within a couple inches of my face. I lightly pressed on Herman's chest to push him back. Herman was yelling and acting erratic at this point. Herman attempted to reach inside his pocket and grab something. I grabbed Herman's hand and lightly pushed him back to ensure it was not a weapon. It was his wallet. Herman then through his wallet and began to pace back and forth. I walked back over to Herman and advised him we were here to help and attempted to calm him down. By this point his daughter and wife were outside as well. Herman again got within a couple inches of my face. I lightly pressed on Herman's chest again to push him back. Herman then got within a couple inches of my face again and grabbed my head. Due to Herman grabbing my head my only option was to take him off his center of gravity and drive him backwards. I drove him backwards and he fell onto the ground with me falling on top of him. It was at this time my bodycam was deactivated by Herman's knee. I proceeded to roll Herman over and place him in handcuffs. An ambulance was called and Herman was transported to the hospital and placed on a 7 day hold.



# **Incident Summary**

On Wednesday, December 1, 2021, at 9:59 AM, I was sent by NMSP dispatch to Interstate 40 westbound, milepost 260, in regard to a domestic violence incident. Dispatch said the victim advised the passenger reached over and choked her while driving but she managed to pull over on the side of the interstate and get out of the vehicle.

I arrived on scene and spoke with the reporting party, Ms. Michelle Pase, who was identified by her Texas driver's license. Ms. Pase told me her girlfriend, identified as Ms. Stacy Fluker, was sitting in the back seat. I requested Emergency Medical Services to check on Ms. Pase and observe any injuries. There were injuries matching what occurred on the right temple and forehead on Ms. Pase.

I approached the vehicle on the passenger side and told Ms. Fluker she would be placed under arrest for Battery on a Household Member based on the physical evidence on Ms. Pase and asked her to step out of the rear seat of the vehicle. Ms. Fluker told me she did not commit battery and refused to come out of the vehicle. I asked Ms. Fluker to step out of the vehicle repeatedly. Ms. Fluker moved to the driver side of the vehicle in the rear seats away from me. She then began to change her story and said Ms. Pase began to choke her first. When asked why she didn't mention this the first time, she said she didn't want to tell on Ms. Pase. At this time Ms. Fluker closed the passenger side back door and locked it. I went to driver's side rear door and opened it and told Ms. Fluker to come out of the vehicle. She refused and I drew my taser from my

side holster and conducted a show of force with the arc switch on the taser, however I did not apply it to Ms. Fluker's person. This was unsuccessful as Ms. Fluker kept insisting, she did not choke Ms. Pase, but Ms. Pase hit her first. I walked back around to the rear passenger side of the vehicle and opened the door. I grabbed Ms. Fluker's right wrist hand and attempted to place a cuff on her wrist. Ms. Fluker laid down on her back and kicked me with her right foot into my stomach twice. While still maintaining control on her right wrist, I drew my taser again, turned it on and pointed at Ms. Fluker and told her I would tase her if she continued to resist. I was able to place a handcuff on her right wrist at this time and attempted to use wrist control techniques to removed Ms. Fluker from the vehicle. Ms. Fluker used her left land to pull the opposite direction from me and continued disobeying commands to exit the vehicle. I drew my taser again, pointed it at Ms. Fluker and told her she would be tased if she refused to come out of the vehicle. Again, I used a show of force by arcing the taser but did not apply the taser to Ms. Fluker's person which was unsuccessful. I continued to issue commands for Ms. Fluker to exit the vehicle which she refused. As I placed the taser on Ms. Fluker's upper right thigh and told her I would drive stun her, Ms. Fluker attempted to grab my taser from me five separate times with her left hand. I then placed my taser on Ms. Fluker's lower right leg below the knee and drive stunned her once for approximately 1-2 seconds. Ms. Fluker began to say I broke her wrist and she needed to go to the doctor because I broke her wrist. I told Ms. Fluker if she gave me her left hand, I would take her to the doctor. Ms. Fluker calmed down and proceeded to give me her left hand and I placed the other handcuff on her left wrist. Ms. Fluker was cuffed in front due to the circumstances instead of behind the back. At this time, I requested an ambulance for Ms. Fluker and requested dispatch to notify a supervisor I had drive stunned Ms. Fluker.

The ambulance arrived on scene and said she did not have any broken bones, however there was burn mark from where I drive stunned her in the leg. Ms. Fluker did have a limp in her left foot when she walked to the stretcher.

She was transported to the Guadalupe County Hospital upon her request, via ambulance for medical clearing and evaluation.

Ms. Fluker was charged with Battery upon a Household Member, Resisting, Evading, or Obstructing a Peace Officer (Arrest), and Battery on a Peace Officer.

# **Incident Summary**

On December 2nd, 2021, at approximately 01:55 PM I, Officer Jerome Martinez was on duty in full uniform displaying my badge of office #628. I was patrolling in a marked unit (#722) in Espanola, New Mexico, County of Rio Arriba with New Mexico State Police. New Mexico State Police Dispatch advised a Ohkay Owingeh Police Officer is out with two subjects smoking narcotics. The Officer on scene is asking for assistance at the pinch a penny laundry mat located at 1811 N Riverside Dr.

Upon arrival I met with Lieutenant Roger Trujillo of Ohkay Owingeh Police Department. Lieutenant Trujillo stated he was called out to assist Espanola PD on a welfare check on a black in color Mazda at the pinch a penny laundry mat located at 1811 N Riverside Dr. Lieutenant Trujillo stated he arrived on scene and knock on the window for about 3-4 minutes before he received a response from the driver who was later identified as Jesse Rodriguez. Lieutenant Trujillo stated the male individual is not a tribal member and will not be able to further investigate.

On scene the medics were attempting to render aid to the infant in the back seat. In doing so the mother who was later identified as Rikkie Ortiz was interfering with the medics. I requested Rikkie to my unit to let medics conduct medical aid to the infant.

She agreed to stand by in front of my unit as I advised her to "hang tight", she then sat on the front of the

push guard. Rikkie was doing fine until she seen the medics get the infant out of the car seat and began to hold her. Rikkie stated she wanted to go hold her baby, she got up from sitting on the front push guard. I told Rikkie several times no that she could not go hold her baby while the medics were attending to her baby. The medics came over to ask Rikkie to ask a question while the baby was in his hands. Rikkie made her way towards the medic and attempted to get the baby from him.

I then got Rikkie's hand and advised her no she cannot hold the baby because she cannot hold herself. I then asked Rikkie if she wanted to go and sit in the back of my patrol unit, she stated "yes". As I was escorting her to my unit, she became irate. As I was reaching for my keys to place Rikkie in my patrol car, Rikkie turned around and pushed me. I then pushed her grabbed her hand and tried to conduct an arm bar but was unsuccessful. I then pushed her towards my unit, proceeded to her direction and assisted her to the ground with an armbar take down. I achieved rear mount and placed handcuff on her right hand. Espanola Fire Chief Ron Padilla and a paramedic assisted with her left hand. Rikkie was resisting with her left hand, I conducted a pain compliance technique on her right wrist which she then gave her left hand to place the handcuff with the double lock mechanism engaged. I advised Rikkie to get up so we can place her in the rear seat of my unit. Rikkie was being uncooperative where myself, the fire chief and the medic eventually assisted her up off the ground and placed her inside my unit. The seat belt was fastened. Rikkie was asked if she needed medical attention, she declined.







On Saturday, December 18, 2021, at approximately 0945 hours myself and three other officers went to execute an arrest warrant on Mr. Jacob Santillanes. Mar. Santillanes had an arrest warrant for 7 counts of larceny of a firearm and 6 other counts of larceny.

We arrived at Mr. Santillanes apartment and began knocking and announcing our presence as New Mexico State Police. After some time, Mr. Santillanes answered the door. He opened the door partially and began talking with me. He was standing in the doorway, while he was standing in the doorway, he had a cell phone in his right hand and his left hand was empty. I began giving him instructions to exit the residence. He was non-compliant, he remained passively resistant throughout our encounter. He was demonstrating his resistance by not following verbal instructions and remaining in the doorway. I continued to give him verbal instructions to exit the residence, a short time later his mother arrived on scene. When his mother arrived, he raised his left arm, giving his mother instructions. When he did that, I saw an opportunity to control Mr. Santillanes, by using less lethal/custody and control technique and take him into custody. I secured Mr. Santillanes with a c-clamp grip on his left wrist, I took a step back with my left foot and placed him into a prone handcuffing position. The control technique worked, and Mr. Santillanes was taken into custody without further incident.



# **Incident Summary**

On Saturday, December 11, 2021, I, Agent Majid Gayles, New Mexico State Police/Special Investigation Unit, was working security at the flea market at the NM State Fairgrounds located at 300 San Pedro Blvd in the city of Albuquerque, County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico. I was on duty wearing black tactical clothing and a Black and Gold New Mexico State Police Tactical vest with my badge, weapon, WatchGuard recording device displayed to the public. My commission card was concealed on my person.

At approximately 1:00 pm. I received a call on the Flea market radio requesting an NM State Officer due to a vendor (Mr. Mance Otis Moore) and customer arguing and possible fighting. I responded and spoke to the vendor Mr. Moore, an older African American male. He told me a Hispanic male customer wearing a blue shirt and yellow sweater argued over the price of a product and repeatedly called him a Nigger. The Hispanic male customer was later identified as Joseph David Ricard, NMID # 512096280.

Once I received information as to the whereabouts of Mr. Ricard, I went to speak with him. I identified myself as a New Mexico State Police officer and he immediately became agitated, animated with his body language, and verbally aggressive. I explained the situation to Mr. Ricard along with the Flea market staff and management. We told Mr. Ricard the Flea market is private property and asked Mr. Ricard to leave. Mr. Ricard emitted a strong order of an alcoholic beverage from his person, displayed slurred speech, and had red glossy eyes. These signs of intoxication were observed by Mr. Mark Mora (Expo Safe Team Security), Mr. Joe Fresquez (Expo NM Manager), and me.

Mr. Ricard explained his version of the incident with the vendor to Mr. Joe Fresquez. Mr. Fresquez told Mr.

Ricard he needs to leave. Mr. Ricard was not satisfied with that answer became argumentative and closed the distance between him and Mr. Fresquez. I observed this behavior, the animated body language, and the intensity of Mr. Ricard's tone. Sensing, this is more than a typical conversion I removed my gloves and unholstered my taser, and as a show of force, and displayed it in a position visible to the public at my chest level. This was my initial attempt to bring the situation and resistive subject under control. I then asked Mr. Ricard to leave approximately three times and told him we were being very nice to him.

Mr. Ricard told Mr. Fresquez "You can't make me leave your premises". I interjected and Mr. Ricard asks if I'm security. I reidentified myself and tolled Mr. Ricard I am State Police of which Mr. Ricard acknowledges. Mr. Ricard's girlfriend can be heard saying to Mr. Ricard "let's go I don't want anything from here". I asked Mr. Ricard to please walk to the front. Mr. Ricard said he is "trying to buy his girl something". His girlfriend said, "I don't want anything from here". I asked Mr. Ricard to please walk again at least three times. He paused, then walked away and periodically would turn toward our direction and continued to verbally argue.

While walking away, Mr. Ricard made a comment to Mr. Moore who was off-camera to the left. Mr. Mora told Mr. Ricard three times to just keep on going and Mr. Ricard became further agitated and stopped walking. I told Mr. Ricard to keep on walking four times. He would pause for a few seconds then continued to walk. Mr. Ricard walked a few feet, stopped, and repeated the process of arguing with Mr. Mora. Mr. Mora told Mr. Ricard he a nuisance and it was time for him to leave. Mr. Ricard's girlfriend was also trying to get him to leave. Mr. Ricard started to walk away and after several feet stopped, turned around and argued with Mr. Mora. Mr. Mora and I both told Mr. Ricard to leave. Mr. Ricard grabbed his phone and stated he was going to call his lawyer. We told him he can contact his lawyer after he left. Mr. Ricard was closing the distance to Mr. Mora and Mr. Ricard's girlfriend pulled and held him back. I told Mr. Ricard to please leave and asked if he wanted to be arrested. I continued to politely tell Mr. Ricard to leave and to keep walking six more times. Mr. Mora advised Mr. Ricard he would either be escorted off the property or leave in cuffs. Mr. Ricard walked in closer proximity to Mr. Mora. I then warn Mr. Ricard three times he was going to get tased.

I told Mr. Ricard his actions are perceived as violent. I said to Mr. Ricard again, "please let's walk", and told him I was being very nice, and he should just leave. Mr. Ricard then attempted to close distance on me, and I took several angled steps back. Both Mr. Mora and I told Mr. Ricard to leave, and also advised Mr. Ricard he was being recorded. Mr. Ricard continued to get close to the flea market staff with excitable, argumentative, heavily animated with aggressive angry body language and behavior. Mr. Mora got in between Mr. Ricard and Mr. Fresquez and told Mr. Fresquez to step back and walk away.

Mr. Ricard is very upset at this point and stated he did not call anyone a "Nigger". Mr. Ricard's girlfriend was trying to calm him down and get him to leave. She told him, "it's not worth it", and Mr. Ricard agreed. Mr. Ricard said, he was upset because he wanted the vendor (Mr. Moore) off the property. Mr. Mora told Mr. Ricard, "We can't do anything to the vendor until you leave". Mr. Ricard acknowledged and said, "I didn't know that". Simultaneously, I told Mr. Ricard to leave and advise him we were being very nice to him and to just leave. Mr. Ricard started to walk away again. Mr. Ricard then referred to and called Mr. Moore a Nigger.

Mr. Moore was coincidently visiting with another African American vendor and heard Mr. Ricard's statement. Mr. Moore said, "I didn't use a stick and I don't have a stick now mother fucker" and went toward Mr. Ricard.

The security staff immediately halted Mr. Moore from preceding any further off camera. Mr. Mora tried to keep Mr. Ricard moving forward toward the exit but Mr. Ricard was displaying violent behavior and was trying to fight.

Mr. Mora and I continued to tell Mr. Ricard to leave however, Mr. Ricard was not trying to exit or leave the area. Instead, he was trying to go the opposite way, around and/or through Mr. Mora. Mr. Ricard then conducted a battery on Mr. Mora by pushing him hard with his left hand in an unlawful, intentional touching or application of force to the person of another, in a rude insolent, or angry manner. Mr. Ricard then pushed Mr. Mora angrily with his left hand and squared off in a boxer's defensive stance and advanced toward me. At this time, Mr. Ricard displayed dangerous and violent tendencies and posed an immediate threat to my safety and the safety of others. I deployed my Taser and yelled "Taser, Taser, Taser" at Mr. Ricard.

The first taser deployment did not yield neuromuscular incapacitation (NMI) due to one of the prongs striking the suspect's saggy baggy pants. Upon the taser strike, Mr. Ricard laughed, walked, and turned his back to me as he walked away. I adjusted my aim as I was firing the taser towards Mr. Ricard's back, Mr. Ricard had moved and turned around again in the time it took for me to aim and pull the trigger. Due to Mr. Ricard turning toward me again as I was firing the taser, one prong struck Mr. Ricard in the upper left arm/shoulder area and the second prong struck him in the lower left abdomen causing Mr. Ricard to fall to the ground.

I gave him commands to put his hands behind his back however, the suspect would not comply as he was actively resisting by bracing and tensing his arms. I placed my taser on the middle to upper left portion of his back and told him to put his hands behind his back. Mr. Ricard continued to actively resist my commands at which time I conducted a drive stun to gain his compliance.

Mr. Ricard continued to actively resist at which time I told him five times to place his hands behind his back. Due to Mr. Ricard continuing to actively resist and refusing to obey my commands to place his hand behind his back, I placed my taser on the upper right portion of his back and conducted a drive stun. At this time, we were able to handcuff Mr. Ricard and take him into custody.

I notified the New Mexico State Police Central Command Dispatch and requested backup unit and medical personnel for Mr. Ricard due to him being tased. He was then transported to the flea market's main office in a motorized cart. While at the flea market's main office, Mr. Ricard began to actively resist by continuously trying to stand up, refusing to sit down, pulling away, and trying to walk away from me. I held on to the handcuffs to prevent Mr. Ricard from getting up and from walking away. Less than lethal force was utilized on MR. Ricard due to him actively resisting and taking him into custody.

Mr. Ricard received medical attention from Albuquerque Fire and Rescue Dept (AFR). AFR arrived and removed and recovered three (3) barbed probes from Mr. Ricard's person. I then searched Mr. Ricard incident to an arrest prior to him being placed in a marked NMSP uniform officers' vehicle. Mr. Ricard was then transported to the D5/NMSP office.

Once Mr. Ricard was at the D5/NMSP office, I was advised Mr. Ricard requested medical attention and was taken to the Presbyterian Hospital where he was examined by medical staff and released. While at the hospital, I advised the uniform officers of Mr. Ricard's initial charges, and Mr. Ricard was advised of the initial

charges against him.

Mr. Ricard engaged in violent, abusive, profane boisterous, unreasonably loud, or otherwise disorderly conduct disturbing the peace. Mr. Ricard knowingly opposed, resisted, and obstructed me from performing my law enforcement duties. He used active resistance movements to defeat an officer's attempt to control, by tensing, pulling away, and physically displaying an intent to avoid being taken into custody.

While Mr. Ricard was in the holding cell, he conducted an assault upon a peace officer by threatening me with menacing gesturing conduct. He used his hand like a pistol saying something to the effect me and my people will come and see you which I took as a threat to me and my safety. While at the D5 NMSP office, I read Mr. Ricard his Maranda Warning from a department-issued Maranda Warning card and asked if he understood. Mr. Ricard said "Yes".

Upon retrieval, there were (2) taser cartridges with wires, (3) probes, and (5) anti felon identification (AFID). Witness statements corroborate Mr. Ricard's disorderly, aggressive, combative, and resistant behavior. Pictures were taken of Mr. Ricard's wrist because he was complaining his wrist hurt. Mr. Ricard complained I was hurting his wrist even when I was not holding or touching him. (Refer to Watchguard video for further information)


