Incident Summary

On June 7, 2021 at approximately 1800 I was patrolling the city of Los Lunas, NM in Valencia County. I was around the area of El Cerro Mission and Manzano Expressway when I observed a red in color truck without a license plate. On this day I was wearing BD Uniform and driving a marked patrol unit with insignia on the sides. I turned around and attempted to do a traffic stop but the vehicle refused to stop even though I had my lights on and siren on.

Vehicle was going around 95 miles per hour in a 35 mile per hour residential zone. due to safety concerns I stayed back and just observed the vehicle from a very far distance and at a safe speed. I was able to observe the pickup go inside a residence. I took advantage of observing where the truck went to go arrest the individual. When I arrived at the residence (33 Priscilla) I was able to observe a young male step out of the truck. I was able to positively identify the male as the driver. The residents of the house locked the front gate not allowing me to go inside and get the male individual. I yelled at the male individual to come to the gate and walk outside the residence. The male was compliant with my remarks. The male jumped the gated fence and came towards my patrol unit.

I advised the male to turn around and put his hands behind his back. At this time a physical fight ensued. The male subject refused to comply and was actively resisting. I tackled the individual to my unit in order to control his movement. Due to the position of my hands and the male actively resisting, I closed my fist and struck the male on the face in order to counter his movements and aggressiveness.

After striking the male he decided not to fight anymore and out his hands behind his back. I was able to

place handcuffs on the male individual later identified as Joseph Smith. I was able to place him in the backseat of my unit.

I spoke with Mr. Smith and asked him why he ran and he said he was scared of his truck getting towed due to not having a license plate.

Mr. Smith calmed down and was able to reason and advised me he was not going to fight anymore and was going to cooperate.

I called an ambulance to Mr. Smith due to the punch to the face. Mr. Smith said he was fine and was medically released.

I took Mr. Smith to the New Mexico State Police Office where he had access to water and a restroom. Once I was done with my paperwork I transported Mr. Smith to Valencia County Detention Center where he was released to correction officers.

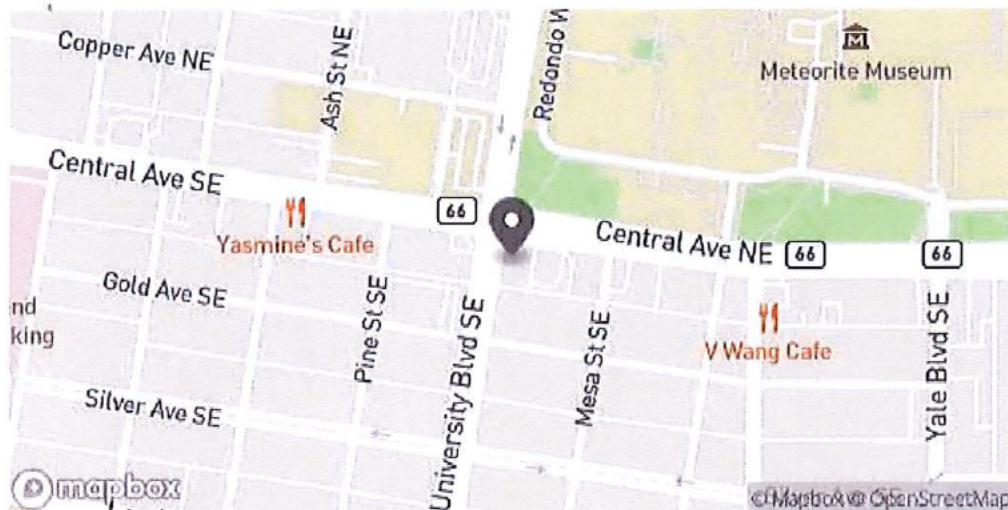
Incident Summary

Incident Summary

On June 20, 2021, at approximately 0200 hours, I was dispatched to assist New Mexico State Police Patrolman Miguel Ramirez with a traffic stop at the corner of El Paseo Rd and Wyatt Dr. in Las Cruces, NM. I was advised he was requesting another patrol unit and advised non-emergency. I also learned through radio traffic, one of the occupants of the vehicle had an active arrest warrant.

At 0207 I arrived on scene and observed Patrolman Ramirez talking with the two occupants of the motor vehicle on the passenger side. There was also Las Cruces Police Department (LCPD) Officer Guaderrama on the driver's side speaking with the driver, identified as Kegan Ryan Garrett. I could hear LCPD Officer Guaderrama requesting Mr. Garrett to exit the vehicle due to him having an arrest warrant. I could hear Mr. Garret arguing with LCPD Officer Guaderrama and refusing to exit.

I saw LCPD Officer Guaderrama grab Mr. Garrett commanding him several times to exit the vehicle. I could see Mr. Garrett was buckled in and uncooperative. At that time, I was standing on the passenger side near Patrolman Ramirez, and I saw the female passenger attempt to pull Mr. Garrett toward her. LCPD Officer Guaderrama told Mr. Garrett he was going to tase him if he did not exit the vehicle. I looked with my flashlight into the vehicle, and I could see a handgun tucked in between the driver's seat and the center console. I advise Patrolman Ramirez of my observation which he was aware of. The passenger was also not listening to Patrolman Ramirez' commands to not obstruct.

I was then requested by LCPD Officer Guaderrama to assist him with Mr. Garrett who was still un-cooperative with the commands from LCPD Officer Guaderrama. I walked around to the driver side where LCPD Officer Guaderrama was holding Mr. Garrett by his right wrist. For our safety and to not let Mr. Garrett access to the firearm I grabbed his right wrist while LCPD Officer Guaderrama removed Mr. Garrett's seatbelt. From there LCPD Officer Guaderrama stayed holding Mr. Garrett's right wrist while I asked him to exit the vehicle which he refused. I then grabbed Mr. Garrett again from his right wrist and asked him to get out of the vehicle. Mr. Garrett resisted by attempting to use the B-pillar to prevent any extraction.

I kept my grip with both hands on Mr. Garrett's right wrist and used a leverage extraction to remove him from the vehicle while LCPD Officer Guaderrama pulled him out from his bottom half. Momentum from the extraction caused Mr. Garrett to land on is stomach on the roadway where I grabbed his left arm and LCPD Officer Guaderrama grabbed his right arm. During the extraction Mr. Garrett's glasses had fallen off his face and he complained of his shoulder. I then hand cuffed Mr. Garrett behind his back.

While Mr. Garrett was being secured, I noticed my watchguard had disconnected from its power source (approximately 12 seconds). I immediately plugged it back in and continued with the arrest. Mr. Garrett was then escorted by LCPD Officer Guaderamma to Patrolman Ramirez' patrol unit where he was placed in the rear passenger side. I then secured the firearm and secured the keys to the vehicle. Emergency Medical Services arrived at the scene and due to Mr. Garrett's uncooperative nature he was unable to be checked there. Patrolman Ramirez transported him to the Dona Ana Detention Center where he was checked by EMS. I learned later Mr. Garrett had sustained minor scrapes to his right elbow, right knee and complained of left shoulder pain. The injuries were photographed by Patrolman Ramirez.

Incident Summary

On June 21, 2021 I, was attempting to conduct a registration inquiry on a vehicle related to an investigation into locating a wanted male, Jerome Naranjo. While traveling behind the vehicle, it began traveling in a manner as if it were attempting to elude me. While following behind the vehicle, an occupant threw an unknown object out the passenger side window. I activated my emergency equipment and the vehicle failed to stop and continued fleeing from.

While fleeing northbound on North McCurdy Road, the vehicle failed to stop at three posted stop signs at the in section of North McCurdy Road and Valley Drive, Mountain View Street and State Road 291. As the vehicle approached N. McCurdy Road and State Road 68, it traveled in the wrong lanes of travel before making a left turn onto State Road 68. The vehicle continued fleeing southbound on State Road 68 and at the intersection of Lowdermilk, the vehicle began traveling southbound in the northbound lanes of travel, forcing a vehicle off the roadway at the intersection of Thornton Lane. As the vehicle approached Calle Ramon, it corrected itself and continued fleeing southbound in the correct lane of travel.

As the vehicle approached the intersection of US 84/285 and State Road 106 it made a left turn failing to yield for oncoming traffic. While the vehicle was maneuvering the turn, I attempted a PIT but did not make contact with the vehicle and was unsuccessful. The vehicle continued fleeing on State Road 106 towards State Road 76. At the intersection of State Road 106 and State Road 76 the vehicle failed to stop at a red light and made a left turn onto State Road 76. The vehicle continued fleeing westbound on State Road 76, as we approached the Santa Cruz Post Office the vehicle decreased its speed to approximately 34 miles per hour at which point I successfully initiated a PIT forcing the vehicle to a stop.

After the vehicle came to a stop, I approached the vehicle and gained control of the driver's right arm through the right rear window which was ajar. The driver was given commands to exit the vehicle through the door window which was rolled down, to which he complied. After the driver removed himself from the vehicle he was placed in handcuffs.

The male identified as Mathew Chavez did not sustain any injuries.

On Saturday, June 26, 2021 at approximately 5:30PM dispatched put out a BOLO for a black SUV with a single female driver with two kids appeared to be intoxicated. I was on El Llano heading south towards SR 76. I turned left onto South McCurdy off of El Llano. As I proceeded south approaching the intersection of SR 76 I observed a black vehicle being driven by a female driver traveling north on South McCurdy. The female crossed over into my lane of travel and almost caused a crash. I conducted a u-turn to make a traffic stop and I observed the vehicle to increase in speed and made a left turn onto Holy Cross Street off of South McCurdy. I was able to turn around a proceeded to stop the vehicle. I was able to catch up to the vehicle on SR 76 heading west. The vehicle came to rest in front of house 264. I order the driver to exit the vehicle and meet me at the front of my unit. As soon as the driver stepped out she began to argue with my commands and at one point told me no when I told her to place her hands on the hood. The female was identified as Marylou Montoya. Marylou kept disobeying my commands to leave her hands on the hood of my unit. At one point she raised her right hand and turned her body towards me. I then attempted to detain her in handcuffs (investigative detention). As soon as I went hands on with her, I felt her body tense up, her fist clinched and she pushed back from my unit against me. I had to physically place her back towards the front of my unit as I attempted controlled both hands. I reached back and retrieved my steel handcuffs. I advised her she was detaining since she tried to flee from me. I was able to place one handcuff on her left wrist. As soon as it went on, Marylou tensed up again and pulled away from me. I was then able to under hook both of her arms all the while keeping control of the handcuff and her momentum. I placed her on the ground on her stomach. While she was on her stomach she was given multiple commands to give me her hands. She did not comply. Ofc. Herrera arrived and we were he was able to assist with securing both of her

hands behind her back. Marylou was transported to Presbyterian Emergency Department for medical clearance. She sustained no injuries from the take down. She was medically cleared for incarceration.

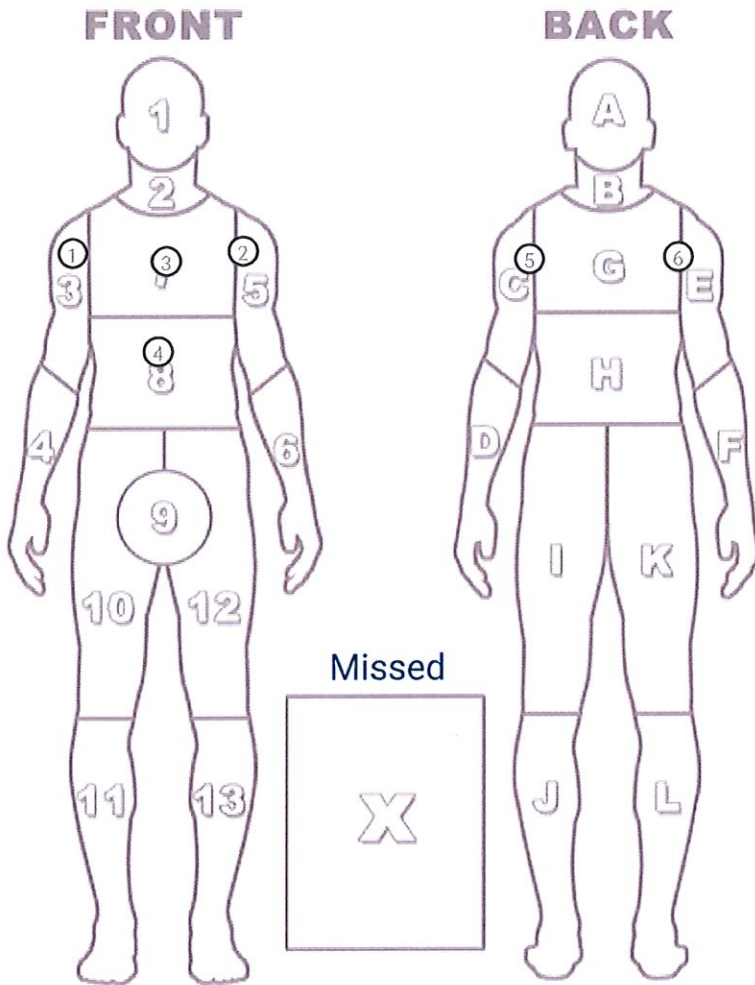

Officer James Jeantet with NMSP conducted a traffic stop as I assisted. Luke Velasquez the driver and the passenger were directed to exit the vehicle. As Luke exited the driver side, Luke was directed to walk to the front of my patrol unit. I advised the Luke to place his hands on my patrol unit's bumper for officer safety. I advised Luke I was going to pat and search him for weapons. I asked the Luke if he had anything that could cut me or poke me; Luke did not respond. As I was patting down Luke for any weapons. In Luke's left pocket, I felt what was consistent with a knife in his left pocket. Luke removed his hand from my patrol unit's bumper. I advised Luke to hold on that he had a knife in his pocket; Luke responded " no I don't". Luke again removed his left hand from my units bumper and attempted to reach in his pocket where he was concealing the knife.

I took control of the Luke's left hand and placed it behind his back. Luke continued to actively resist by clinching his body. Luke was attempting to pull his arm free from my control by pulling it away from me in a forward motion. At this time, I took Luke to the ground to regain control. While we were on the ground. I was able to place one handcuff on Luke's left wrist.

Luke continued to resist and would not allow officers to place the other handcuff on his right wrist, Luke had his right arm tucked underneath his chest and was given several commands to release his arm but to no avail. Officer Jeantet placed his department issued taser to the Luke's back in efforts to retrieve his hand.

The Luke complied with commands and both hands were secured into handcuffs safely.

I continued my pat and search. I retrieved the red pocketknife from the Luke's right pocket. In Luke's left pocket where I observed the knife in his pocket during the initial pat and search. I located a silver Gerber knife. As I was taking out the knife from his left pocket. I located a clear plastic baggy. The clear plastic baggy contained a black in color tar substance as well as a white powdery substance.

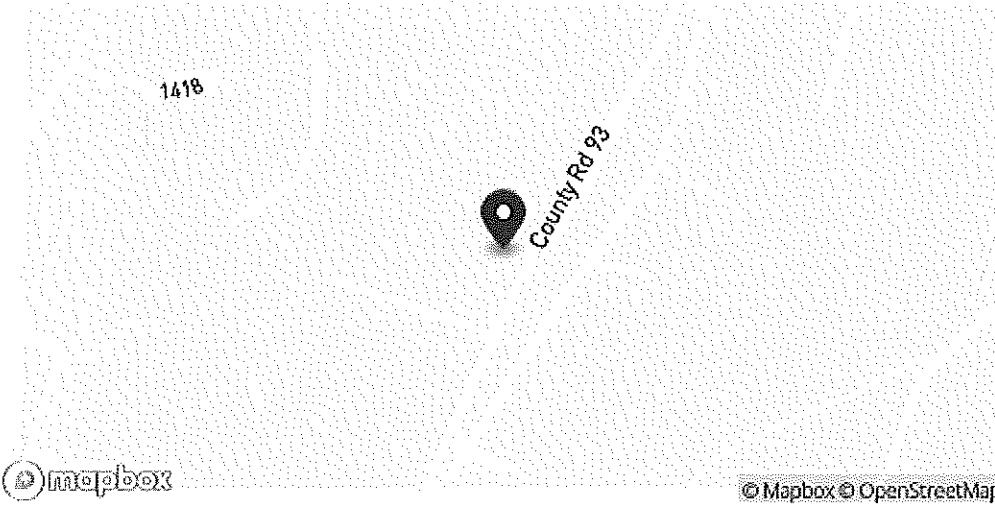

On Monday, July 5, 2021, at approximately 5:20 p.m., I overheard Officer Isiah Taylor relay information about vehicle pursuit involving "PD" I later learned it was the Ohkay Owingeh Tribal Police that initiated the pursuit. The pursuit was heading south on McCurdy Road (city of Espanola) I was on patrol at the intersection Riverside Drive and Fairview Road.

I immediately proceeded to the intersection of McCurdy Road and Fairview to assist with stop stick deployment (emergency equipment activated). Upon my arrival, I witnessed an Espanola Police officer out of his unit with stop sticks set up on the roadway. I then stopped and exited my unit and retrieved my stop sticks. I witnessed the offender vehicle (Tan in-color Nissan SUV) heading south and I also heard the acceleration of the engine as he passed by me through the intersection at high rate of speed. I attempted to throw the stop sticks in the path of the vehicle and back away but was not successful. While at the intersection, I witnessed both Espanola Police and Ohkay Owingeh Tribal Police. in pursuit.

I retrieved my stop sticks and returned them to my police unit, I then entered my unit and proceeded east on Fairview Lane to El Llano Road. I did this due to the number of police units that were engaged in the pursuit, and I also knew most pursuits either go the way of State Road 76 or loop back round north to El Llano Road.

I continued east on Fairview Lane and then turned south on El Llano Road, I maintained radio contact with

Officer Taylor who was assisting the pursuing officers, he later indicated he was several units back from the primary and secondary units. Officer Taylor advised the offender vehicle was successfully "stop sticked" and was going about 20-25 mph southbound on McCurdy Road. Officer Taylor did request authorization to "PIT" the vehicle when possible, I denied his request. I continued south on El Llano to attempt an intercept.

Officer Taylor then advised via radio, the offender vehicle turned on to El Llano road and was heading in my direction. I continued south on El Llano road and stopped briefly near Los Lujan Road. I exited my unit to retrieve my stop sticks again. It was at this point I realized I was not in a safe position to deploy. I then returned to my police unit and continued south on El Llano road.

UOF: Vehicle to vehicle contact

I continued south on El Llano road where I then witnessed the tan Nissan SUV coming towards me. I estimated his speed to 15-20 mph or less. This portion of El Llano road is extremely narrow (brick wall and stumps on either side) which did not allow me to completely avoid a possible head on collision. The narrowing of the roadway appeared to cause me to go head on with the vehicle, but I continued and steered slightly right and allowed the offender vehicle to travel down my left side. It was at this point; I turned the steering wheel hard left and contacted the driver side rear door of the offender vehicle. This contact resulted in the vehicle spinning counterclockwise behind my police unit and striking a brick wall where it came to rest. I immediately accelerated through the vehicle to vehicle contact and drove into a small clearing. I then turned around and observed foot pursuit with several officer engaged.

Note: The offender, Raymond Ortega was "tased" by Española Police during this incident. He was treated and relapsed at the scene and taken into police custody.

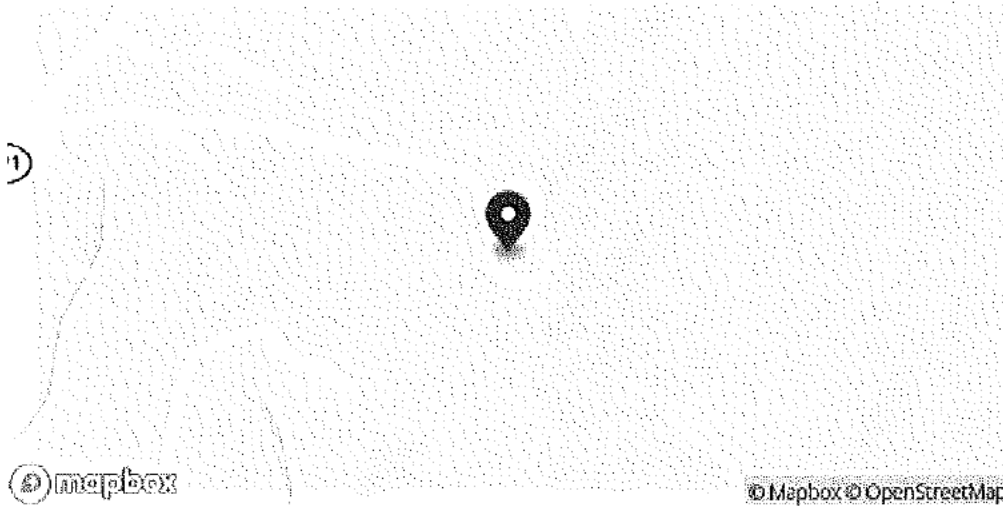

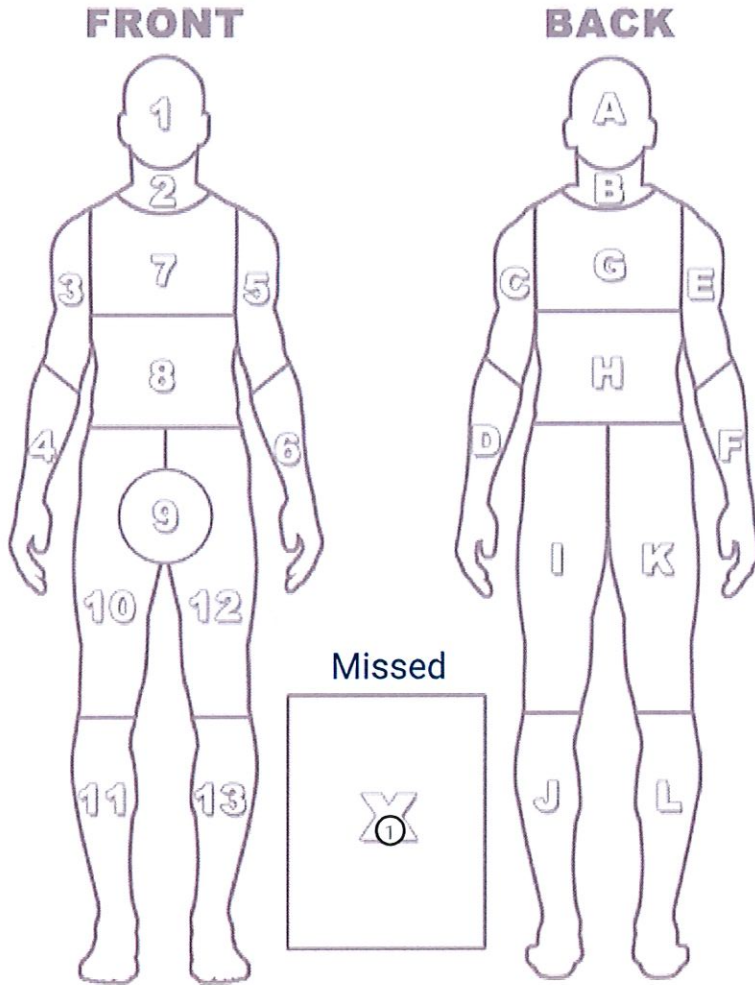

Incident Summary

On Tuesday, July 6, 2021, I, Officer Diaz Amaya, was on duty, in full uniform and clearly displaying my badge of office within the county of Sandoval, NM. At approximately 19:44 hours, I was dispatched to assist Sandoval County Sheriff's Office deputies with a domestic violence disturbance in progress at 32 Victor Road in San Luis, NM.

While traveling to the location, the CAD notes showed one of the parties involved, Bryan Dominguez, had an outstanding felony warrant and was considered armed and dangerous. I also learned Dominguez had tried to set fire to the home, and that the Sandoval Sheriff's Office had responded there prior, and that male had been extremely combative. I met with Sandoval County Deputy Daisy Gomez near the residence and responded to the home.

Upon arrival, the reporting person, Dominguez's father, met with us in the driveway and stated that Dominguez had tried starting fire to the home, had been smoking meth, had caused extensive property damage and was in possession of a blade which he described as a machete. He pointed to a brown Chevrolet sports utility vehicle and stated that was his son in the vehicle. While approaching, I observed the male in the vehicle exit the driver side, open the rear door and fumble around with something there before returning to the driver seat and closing the door.

Deputy Gomez and I approached the male to speak to him. I motioned with my hands for him to show me his hands. He did not and I could not see his hands. I asked him to come outside, which he refused to do. With prior knowledge of the subject being considered armed and dangerous, possibly under the influence of meth, and the information his father gave about the machete, I drew my department issued sidearm and ordered Dominguez out of the vehicle. He did not and could be seen fumbling with something in front of him out of my sight. I moved to the passenger side and observed that he held a smoking pipe in his hand, which he proceeded to smoke marijuana out of while ignoring lawful commands to exit.

I opened the passenger side door and removed items that were obstructing my view. At that point, I observed Dominguez was holding only the aforementioned smoking pipe and observed no weapons matching what his father described. I transitioned to my Taser and holstered my sidearm, while continuing to give commands to Dominguez. Commands were ignored and Dominguez continued smoking Marijuana out of his pipe. He was advised multiple times that he would be tased. I deployed my Taser striking Dominguez's right side and observed a reaction. He was ordered to open the driver side door, which he did and was given commands to get on the ground. He did not follow commands and continued saying he had not done anything and that he was being held against his will by his father. He was advised he would be tased again if he did not get on the ground. I followed up with two manual Taser discharges which appeared to not affect Dominguez due to disconnection.

Dominguez failed to get on the ground as lawfully ordered and started removing the taser prongs by pulling on the wires, at which point he was tased a second time and he moved out of my field of view. Due to the Taser still connected to the prongs, I moved through the inside of the vehicle to the other side, where Deputy Gomez was already giving commands to Dominguez to get on the ground. I holstered my Taser and closed distance with Dominguez, who was already partially on the ground. I took his back and ordered multiple times to place his hands behind his back. He continued to say he had not done anything and tensed his arms. He also said "I'm trying to" in response to being told to place his hands behind his back but continued to actively resist and tense his arms. Deputy Gomez hand cuffed Dominguez behind his back and his handcuffs were double locked by me. He was compliant the remainder of the encounter.

Dispatch was advised of the Taser deployment and EMS was dispatched to remove the prongs from Dominguez. He was able to stand up on his own and walk. He was escorted to Deputy Gomez's patrol unit, where he was searched for weapons and placed in her unit. I had no further interaction with Dominguez. He was checked by EMS and Deputy Gomez took custody of the subject and handled the investigation. Deputy Gomez took pictures of subject to make sure no injuries were sustained. They will be included in the ATTACHMENTS portion of this report.

The prongs and cartridges were recovered and submitted to the NMSP Cuba evidence vault for destruction. This concludes my investigation in the matter. Should additional information arise, it will be submitted in the form of a supplemental report.

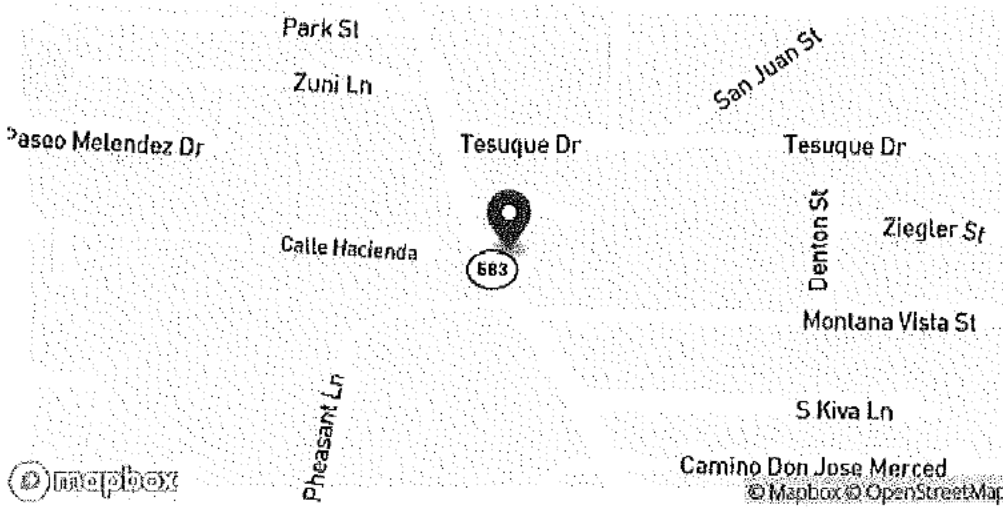
Incident Summary

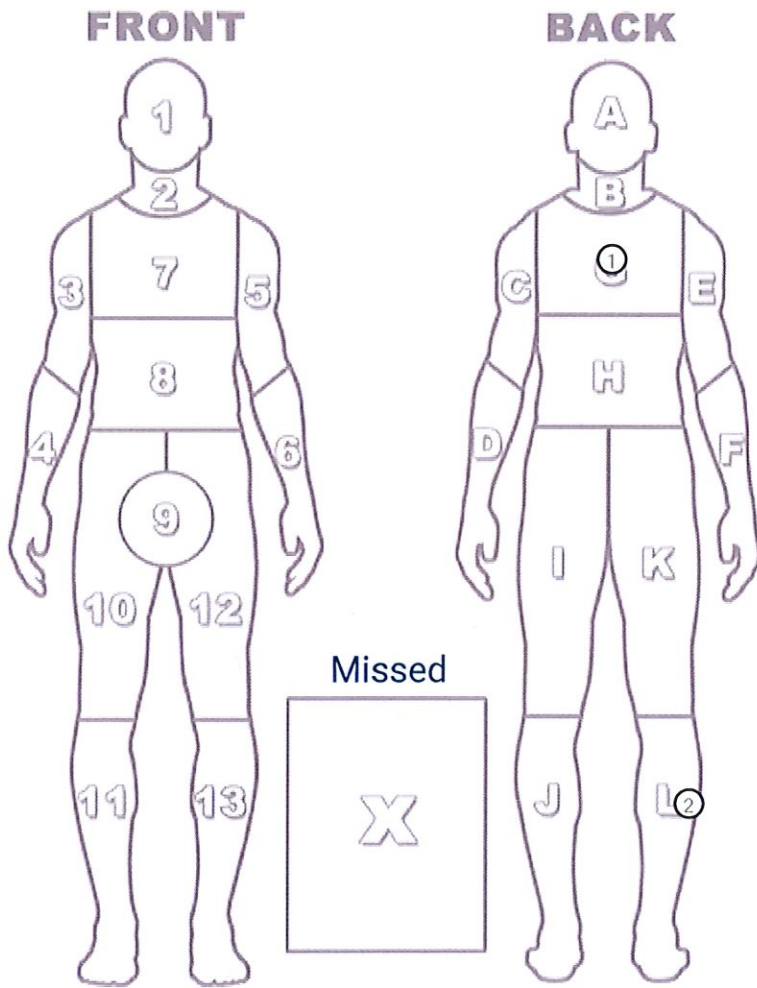

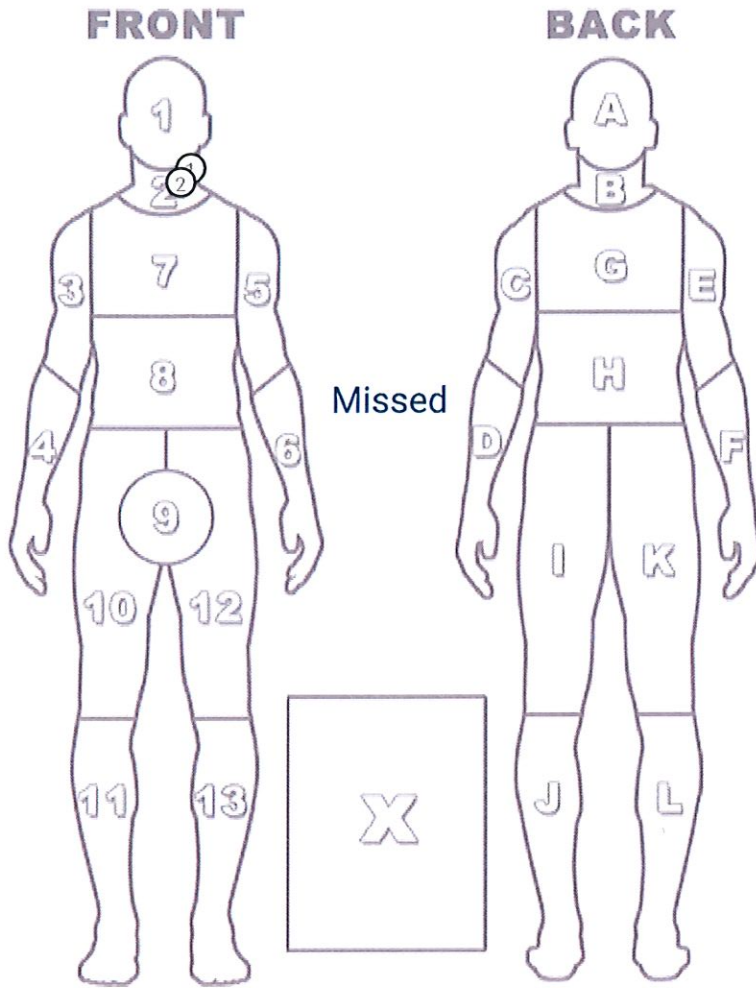

Incident Summary

On July 18th, 2021 at approximately 17:52 hours, I was dispatched to White Sands National Park to assist Officers Justin Maese and Justin Cobb of the New Mexico State Police, with a possible intoxicated driver call, call #NMSP21153190.

Officer Maese completed his investigation and the driver was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence (DUI). Officer Maese transported the driver and requested Officer Cobb and I to complete the towing paperwork for the vehicle. The passenger of the vehicle, Ms. Deandra Largo (D.O.B. 10/29/1993) was sitting in the front passenger seat and it was apparent she was highly intoxicated. She was instructed to exit the vehicle so it could be towed from the scene because she was too intoxicated to drive the vehicle. Officer Cobb asked Ms. Largo to exit the vehicle several times and she several times to exit and became verbally argumentative and was using foul language.

The keys to the vehicle were on top of the roof, for safety reasons, I took the keys from the roof and placed them on the hood of my unit. I walked back to Ms. Largo's vehicle and she was still arguing with Officer Cobb and refusing to exit the vehicle. Officer Cobb was able to have Ms. Largo exit the vehicle so we can attempt to complete a vehicle inventory.

Once Ms. Largo was outside of the vehicle, we attempted several times to have her contact a friend or family

member to pick her up since she was intoxicated. Ms. Largo refused to call any family or friends, she did provided us a phone number to call a friend of hers named "Brandon". As Officer Cobb and I were talking to Ms. Largo she remained argumentative and stepped up close to me and yelled in my face. We requested Dispatched to call the number Ms. Largo provided and they were unable contact anyone.

Ms. Largo started walking around and was going to close to the road. I asked her to return back to the passenger side of her vehicle so she did not get struck by a passing vehicle. Ms. Largo went to the passenger side of her vehicle and the window was rolled all the way down. Ms. Largo leaned inside the vehicle and started reaching around inside the glove compartment. I instructed Ms. Largo to stop reaching inside the the glove compartment and to step away from the vehicle. She refused to listen to my instructions and attempted to reach into the compartment of the passenger door. I did not know if she was reaching for a possible weapon and for safety reasons and grabbed her hand and told her to stop reaching around inside the vehicle. Ms. Largo became aggressive, she yanked her arm out of my hand, took a step back and pushed me in the chest with both of her hands.

I used a leverage take down and escorted Ms. Largo to the ground so I could have better control of Ms. Largo. She was placed in handcuffs and escorted to my patrol unit. Officer Cobb and I stood up Ms. Largo and I did not see any injury to her. I ensured her hands were handcuffed behind her back and the handcuffs were double-locked. Ms. Largo refused to enter the patrol unit by locking her body and using her feet to push herself away from my unit. I had to go to the other side of my patrol unit and help pull Ms. Largo into my unit, once inside, she was seat belted. Ms. Largo managed to unclick the seatbelt and attempted to slip the handcuffs from the back to the front of her person. Officer Cobb and I had to remove Ms. Largo from the back of my patrol unit so I could use a different set of handcuffs. We attempted to place Ms. Largo back into my patrol unit and she again locked her body and used her legs to push herself away from the unit to prevent us from putting her inside the vehicle. Officer Cobb and I were able to place Ms. Largo into the vehicle and put her in a seatbelt.

As I was leaving the scene, Ms. Largo again, removed her seatbelt. I transported Ms. Largo to the Alamogordo State Police Office and notified Sergeant Jonathan Reyes, who was the on-duty Sergeant, of the incident. Once I arrived at the State Police Office, I called an ambulance to have Ms. Largo checked for any injuries. Ms. Largo did not have complaint of injuries and refused any medical treatment.

Ms. Largo was processed and booked into the Otero County Detention Center for Battery and Peace Officer and Resisting, evading or obstructing an officer.

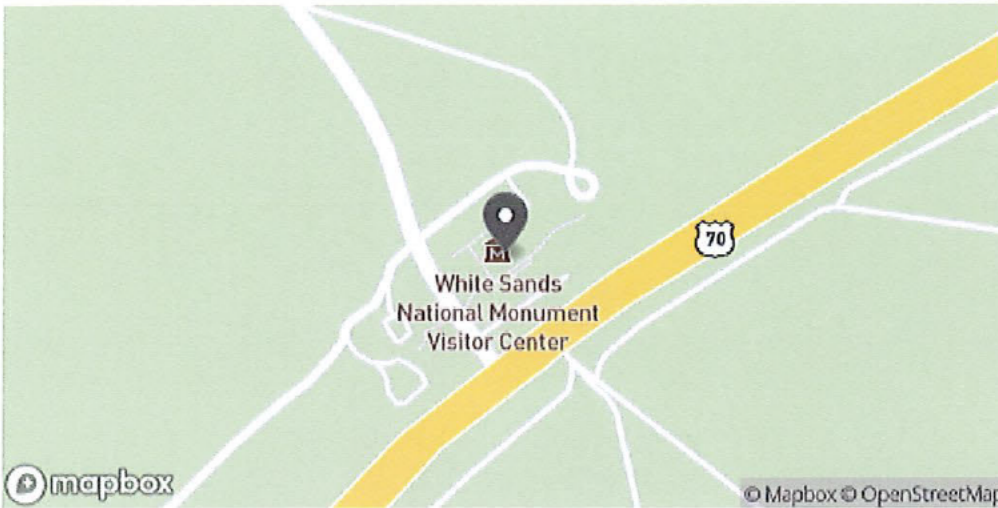

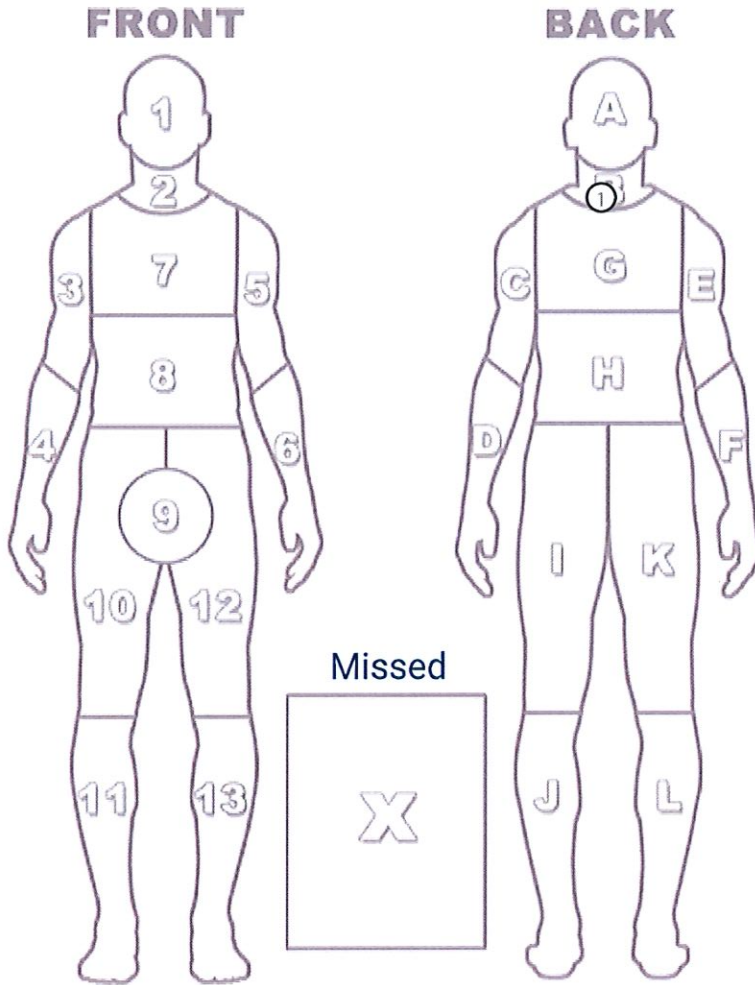

Incident Summary

On Monday, July 26, 2021, at approximately 11:00 A.M. I was notified by New Mexico State Police Dispatch of a male individual in the area of US Highway 84/285 and Boneyard running in and out of traffic naked. While I was in route, Officer Guillen advised me via radio of the male individual who was naked was running away from them on the concrete barrier which separated US Highway 84/285 from the frontage road. As I arrived on scene, I observed a Santa Fe County Deputy on scene with Officer Guillen. I observed a male individual who appeared to be wearing no clothing (naked) walking down the frontage road running parallel with US Highway 84/285, in the middle of the traffic lane, not listening to the on-scene officers commands and appeared to be irate. As I approached the male wearing no clothing, he continued to be irate, yelling continuously. Due to the male standing in the middle of the road, with traffic starting to accumulate and a major highway running parallel with our location, not listening to commands, I attempted to apply handcuffs to the male individual to detain him for his own safety until medical personal arrived to keep him from running into traffic and getting struck by a vehicle. I proceeded to grab the male's arm in order to apply handcuffs, the male proceeded to pull away as he pushed my hands away with his hands. He proceeded to run towards the concrete barrier towards US Highway 84/285 where I was able to obtain control of the male's right arm briefly. He continued to resist by squirming, pulling away from me. I was unable to maintain control of the male due to him squirming and being sweaty, causing my grip to slip. The Santa Fe County Deputy and I conducted a leverage takedown on the male in order to obtain control. The Santa Fe Deputy was able to successfully apply handcuffs after conducting the leverage takedown. Immediately upon applying handcuffs, the male was escorted back to his feet where medical personal arrived on scene and transported him to the nearby hospital.

Incident Summary

Patrolling on Hwy 11 Columbus road mile marker 28 and verified the speed of a vehicle southbound at 89 miles per hour in a posted 55 mile per hour zone. I made a U-turn and turned on my emergency equipment. The vehicle kept speeding southbound and made a right turn onto Rivera Road skidding. As I turned onto Rivera road I saw the vehicle making another right turn onto Emerald street again leaving skid marks on the dirt roads. I turned onto Emerald road and did not see any tail lamps in front of me anymore. I saw skid marks on the dirt road that lead to the property to my left. I stopped and saw a lot of dust and saw the tail lights of the vehicle I was attempting to stop on the west side of the mobile home. I then saw the tail lights turn off. I advised dispatch of my stop and to send another unit to my location. I walked to where the vehicle was parked and observed no one was in the vehicle any longer. A female came out of the residence after awhile asking in Spanish what I needed. She went back to her front door and a male came back to the car. Male stated he was the driver, stated he was 15 years of age. Male was becoming agitated with me asking about the car and having my weapon out. The male was asked to come to my unit, male got to the gate and refused to cooperate any further. I explained to the male that I wanted him by my car and did not want him to run again. The male was still uncooperative and stated he was on probation. Several commands and effort was given to the male to come to my unit. I went to place the male subject under investigative detention and he began to scream and resist. The male subject put his arms and hands together refusing to give me his hands. The male subject still screaming and wanting to pull away, was put on the ground with minimal force to keep him from being combative. The male would not cooperate and was being given commands to give me his hands. I waited for another unit to arrive so we could put the handcuffs on the male subject without causing any harm. I held the male subject down with my right hand as I waited. LCSO Deputy arrived on scene and I put the handcuffs on the male subject. The male subject refused to get up and would not walk to

my unit. The deputies attempted to put the male subject in my back seat as I spoke with the female which was identified as his mother. The male subject was being combative with the deputies using his legs and would not stay sitting in the back of my patrol unit. The male subject who was identified by his mother as Irvin Salas, while still cuffed kept fighting with deputies and through himself on the ground by the passenger side doors. His mother Ms. Arroyo stated her son had a broken hand in the past. An ambulance was called to check on his hand. Ms. Arroyo stated she always has problems with her son and he destroyed her home on the inside and that's why he is on probation. I called Diana Porter with JPO office and explained what I had. JPO Porter advised if the mother Ms. Arroyo was willing to take custody of Irvin, to release him to her and get her the paperwork on next business day. Irvin was transported to hospital to have his right hand checked.

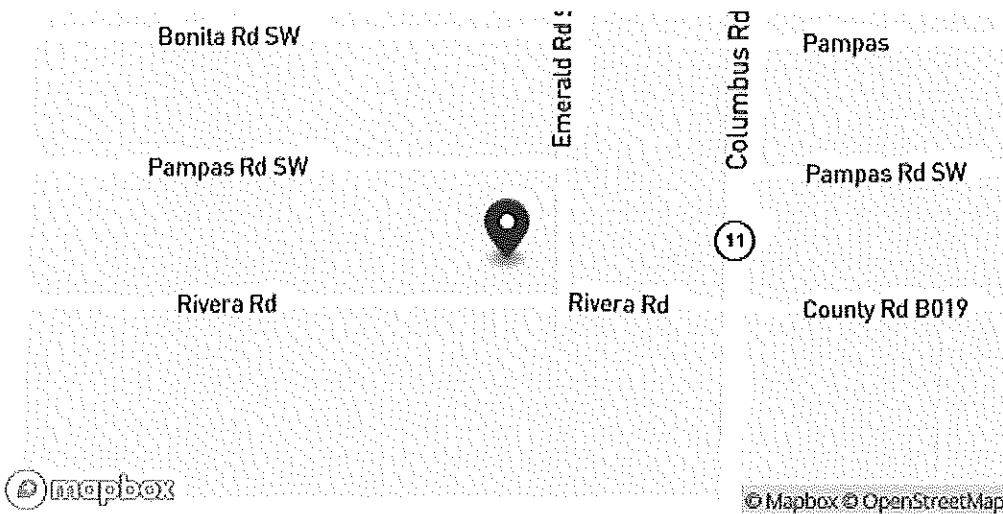

Incident Summary

On August 5, 2021, at approximately 2333 hours I was patrolling on Alamo Street in Las Vegas NM. I was in a marked New Mexico State Police unit displaying my badge of office when I observed a Silver Mercedes passenger car bearing NM registration plate AZJR48, traveling westbound on Alamo Street. I ran a query check on the license plate on the vehicle through NMSP dispatch. Dispatch advised the vehicle had suspended registration.

I initiated my emergency equipment and conducted a traffic stop on the above mentioned vehicle. The vehicle pulled onto a private parking lot off Alamo Street and a male subject exited the driver side door. The male was later identified as Gonzalo Anaya. The male subject got out of the car, looked at me and then turned and started walking away from me towards a residence. I asked the male subject what he was doing and advanced towards him in an attempt to detain him. I grabbed the male subject by his arm and immediately felt him tense up and begin to pull away from me with force. At this time the male subject began reaching towards his waistband in front of his body. I pulled his arms and yelled at him to let me see his hands due to officer safety concerns. I could hear the male subject had a slurred speech and could smell a strong odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his person at this time.

I grabbed Gonzalo by his right arm and advised NMSP Sergeant Chavez to grab his left arm. During this time, he continued to resist and was attempting to move his arms towards the front of his body. Both myself and Sgt. Chavez gave verbal commands for Gonzalo to show us his hands. He continued to disobey these orders. I advised to Gonzalo to not reach for anything. I placed a single cuff on his right arms before the male subject was lowered to the ground. While on the ground the male subject continued to pull his arms to the

front of his body with officers attempting to secure them behind his back. I advised Gonzalo to calm down and asked why he jumped out of his car. Gonzalo advised he did so because he was already on his property.

During the altercation at some point Gonzalo received a laceration to the left side of his head. Once in handcuffs I advised NMSP Officer Conrad Mares to contact dispatch to send an Ambulance to the scene to make sure Gonzalo was ok. Gonzalo was clenching a set of keys in his hand that I advised him to let go of several times. I advised Gonzalo the keys could be used as a weapon, and he could not have them in his hands. Gonzalo resisted my attempts to remove the keys several times before successfully taking them out of his hands.

I stood Gonzalo up and advised him to sit down on a chair that was in front of the residence. Gonzalo continued to pull away once in cuffs after standing him up. NMSP Ofc. Mares and I leaned the male subject over the hood of his car to conduct a search prior to arrest. A cellphone was found in his pocket, as well as a switch blade knife in his right front pocket.

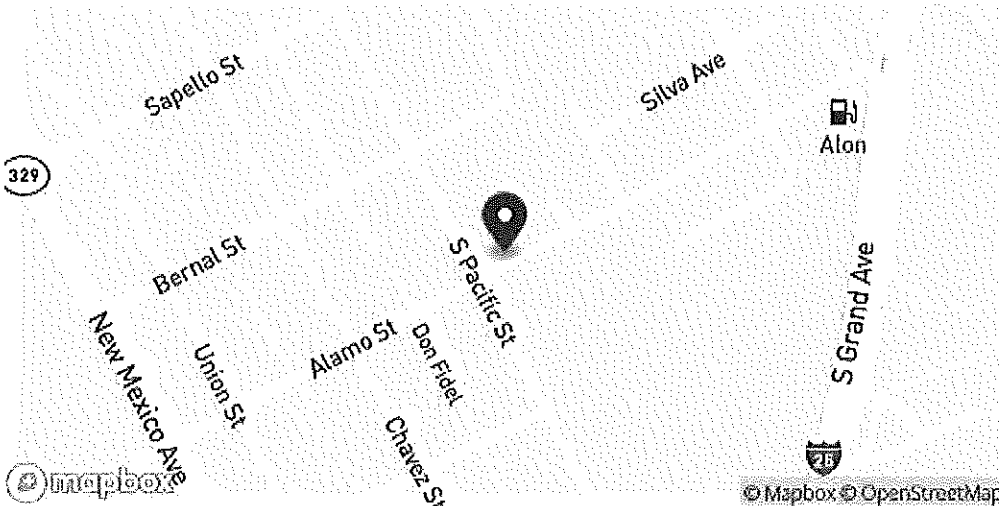

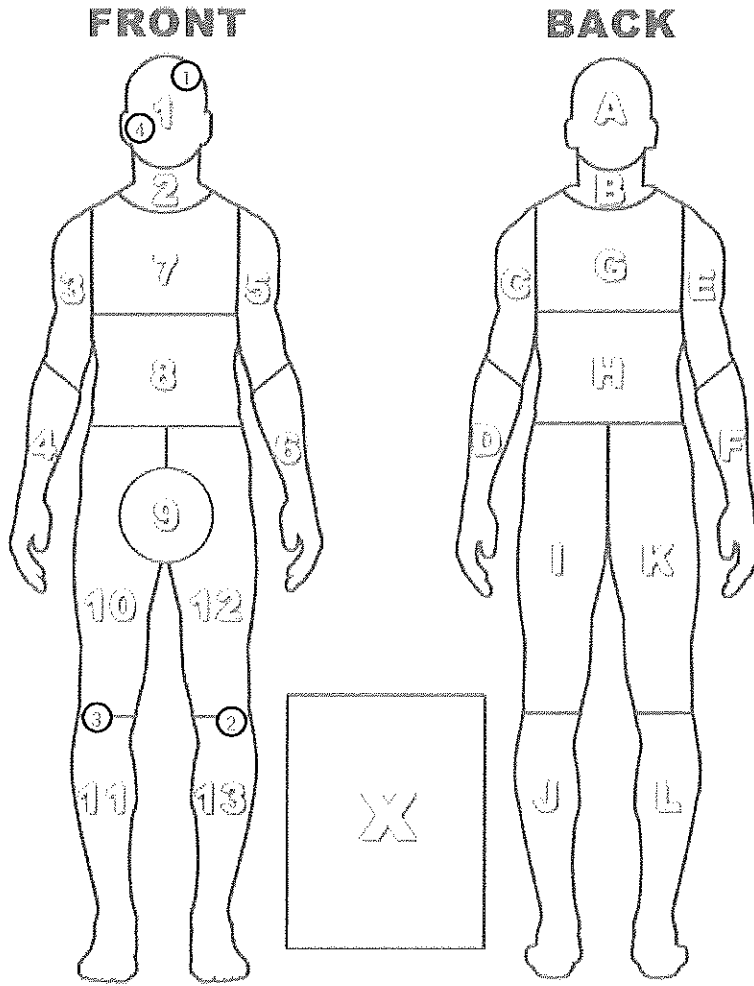

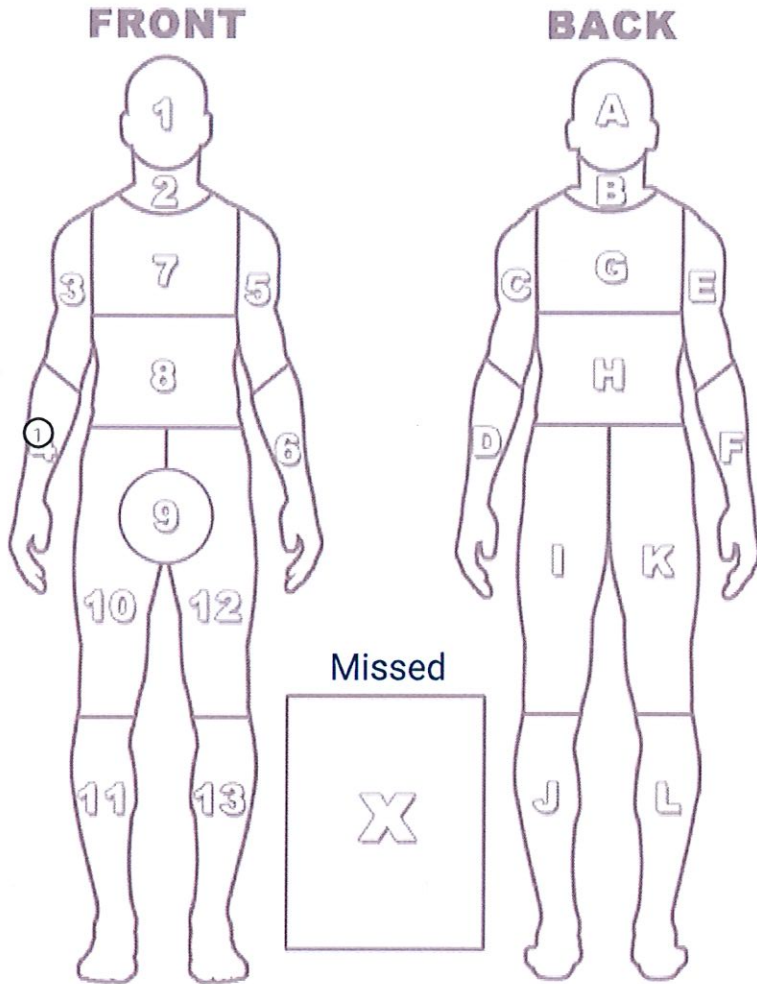

Incident Summary

On August 4, 2021 at approximately 2333 hours while on patrol I heard New Mexico State Police Officer Levy Lujan call out at traffic stop on Alamo Street in Las Vegas, New Mexico 87701. I went to assist Officer Lujan when I seen New Mexico State Police Sergeant Joseph Chavez running from his police vehicle to assist Officer Lujan. A male subject later identified as Gonzalo Anaya was resisting Officers as they were trying to detain him. Gonzalo was taken down to the ground. Gonzalo continued to resist Officers and ignored commands to stop resisting and place his hands behind his back.

I assisted Officers in pulling Gonzalo's hands out from under his body and held him down by pushing down on his back and shoulder area with my hand and forearm. Gonzalo was stood up and continued to resist by pushing back into Officer Lujan. Officer Lujan and I placed Gonzalo face down on his hood so we could speak to him and calm him down. Officer Lujan and I placed arm arms under Gonzalo's arms and on his shoulders to hold him down as he calmed down. Once Gonzalo was calm he sat in a chair while he was seen by medical personnel.

Gonzalo again became irate while being seen by medical personnel stood up and disconnected the medical equipment used to treat him. Gonzalo was escorted to Officer Lujan's police vehicle and placed inside. Gonzalo continued to resist and would not let me put his seat beat on. Once I was able to get his seat belt on this ended my involvement in the incident.

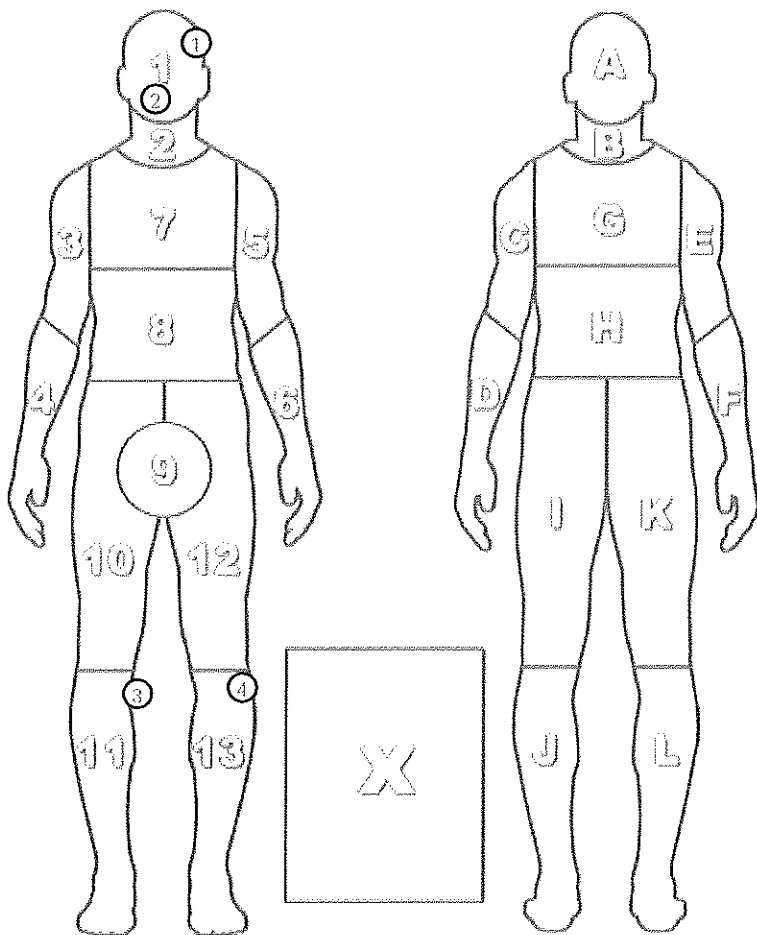

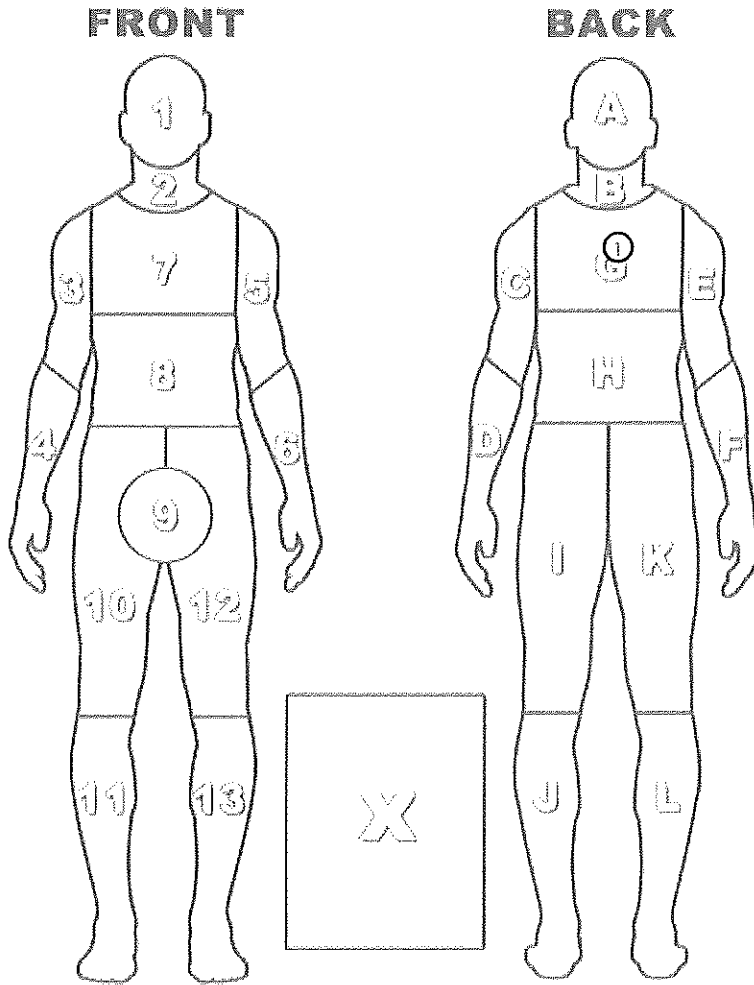

Incident Summary

On August 4, 2021, I was patrolling the area of Chavez Street near the intersection of Alamo Street in Las Vegas NM County of San Miguel. I was in full uniform displaying my badge of office in a marked New Mexico State Police unit. I observed Officer L. Lujan who was in a fully marked New Mexico State Police unit traveling east on Alamo Street and heard via radio Officer Lujan advising dispatch via radio running the vehicles registration plate in front of him. I heard via radio dispatch advising the registration plate was coming back with its vehicle insurance and registration suspended. At this time, I observed Officer Lujan engage his emergency equipment and conduct a traffic stop on said vehicle. Upon my arrival at Officer Lujan's traffic stop, I placed my unit near Officer Lujan's passenger front door also with my emergency lights engaged. I observed a male subject exit his vehicle and began to walk away from his vehicle. Officer Lujan began giving the male subject commands which the male subject failed to follow and still attempted to walk away from Officer Lujan. At this time, I observed Officer Lujan go hands on with the male subject and observed the male subject start to resist by attempting to pull away from Officer Lujan and not give Officer Lujan his hands when asked to do so. I immediately made contact with Officer Lujan and the male subject and grabbed ahold of the subjects left wrist and performed an empty hand technique (wrist lock for pain compliance) in an attempt for the male subject to comply with verbal commands being given to him. The male subject still refused and was escorted down to the ground by Officer Lujan. During This time the male subject left side forehead contacted the concrete ground which caused a laceration on his left side forehead. The male subject still was resisting and failing to follow commands to give both of his hands, which shortly after Officer Lujan was able to retrieve his right hand and place handcuffs on the non-cooperative subject behind his back securing both hands. The male subject was stood up by Officer Lujan and sat down on a chair nearby. Officer Lujan contacted dispatch and requested EMS to our location once the male subject was

secured. During my close encounter with this male subject, I could smell a strong odor of alcohol emitting off his breath and person. The male subject was treated for his injury and was still being non-cooperative with EMS on scene. Officer Lujan read the New Mexico Implied Consent Advisory to the male subject which the male subject refused to take any tests. Officer Lujan transported the male subject to Alta Vista Regional Hospital where he was medically cleared for incarceration and treated for his injury.

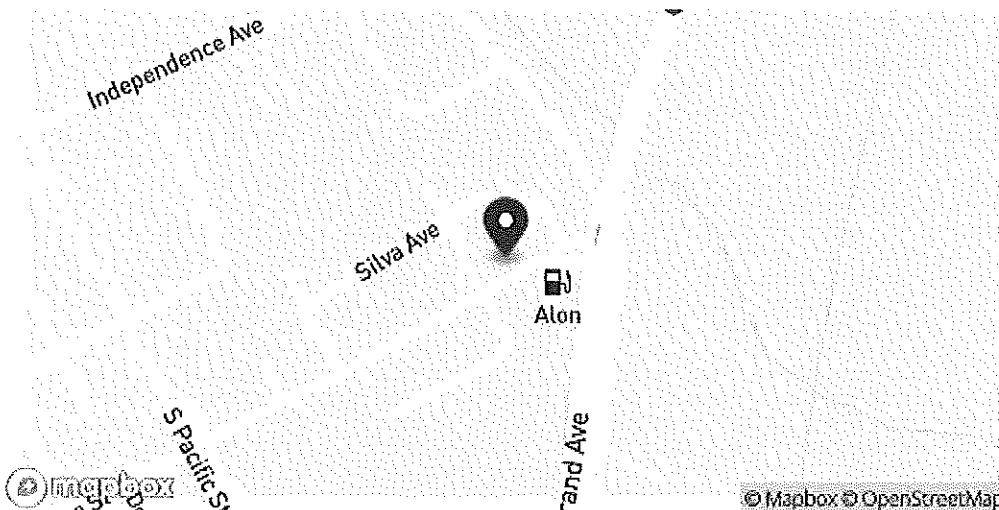
