Incident Summary

On August 5, 2021, at approximately 2330 hours, I was on duty in the County of San Miguel displaying my badge of office and operating a marked patrol unit. I was patrolling 7th street in Las Vegas, New Mexico. I observed a grey in color vehicle pull out of the Allsups gas station on 7th and Grand. I then noticed the driver's side window was down and the driver was not using his seat belt. When the driver saw me, he then pulled back into the Allsups parking lot.

I initiated my emergency equipment and conducted a traffic stop. I made a driver's side approach to the vehicle where I made contact with the driver. I advised the driver why I stopped him, I asked him for his license, he advised he did not have one and also stated multiple time if the registered owner could come get the vehicle. I then asked him to step out of the vehicle so I could identify him. He took approximately two minutes to step out of the vehicle. When he finally did so, he seemed very nervous and uneasy. When I asked him to step back to my vehicle, he began to throw things out of his pockets back into his vehicle. At that time, I advised him to stop and give me his hands. As I attempted to grab his hands, he attempted to evade by running from me.

I then caught the male individual and a fight ensued Mr. Lucero fell to the ground and I attempted to gain control of him by garbing his hands but was unsuccessful. We disengaged and Mr. Lucero stood up and attempted to evade a second time by running away. I gave Mr. Lucero several commands to stop, when he refused I deployed my department issued taser striking him in the back. He then fell to the ground on the front side of his body. As a result of falling he sustained a small laceration to the right side of his head. I was then able to gain control of the individual later identified as Mr. Patrick Lucero. After I placed Mr. Lucero in

my unit, he provided me with his social security number. I ran his social security number threw our dispatch, and they advised me Mr. Lucero had multiple warrants. Mr. Lucero also had a revoked driver's license, and he did not have a driver's license. After the incident, EMS responded and rendered aid to Mr. Lucero.

During the tow inventory a crystal-like substance was located sticking out of a crown royal bag. The same Crown Royal bag i witnessed him throw into the car earlier. The two inventory was stopped at that time, the vehicle was sealed with evidence tape and the vehicle was transported to the NMSP Office. Officer Pretlow followed the vehicle and secured it in the evidence lot as evidence. Refer to his report for further.

On 8/06/21 at approximately 1440 hours a search warrant that I drafted was telephonically approved by District Court Judge Abigail Aragon. I began my search at 1630 hours, during the search three bags of a crystal-like substance along with a blue scale were located in the vehicle. These items were collected as evidence. The three bags containing the substance were field tested and tested positive for Meth. They were entered into the NMSP Evidence tracker system and secured in the evidence vault.

This case is currently pending court, if any other information arises a supplemental report will be completed.





Incident Summary

On August 05, 2021, at approximately 23:03 hours, I was on patrol in the area of Candelaria Road NE and Edith Boulevard NE in the City of Albuquerque attempting to locate armed robbery/carjacking suspects who fled from New Mexico State Police in the area of Edith Boulevard and Martinez Lane.

Prior to attempting to locate the suspects, I was advised that one of the suspects involved in the armed robbery/carjacking was a light complexed Hispanic female with blonde hair.

As I was traveling eastbound on Candelaria Road towards Interstate 25 in attempts to locate the suspects, I observed a female subject standing at the northwest corner of the Dahl Kitchen and Bath Studio building, located at 1500 Candelaria Road NE, matching the description of the female armed robbery/carjacking suspect New Mexico State Police were searching for. I activated my emergency lights on my fully marked New Mexico State Police patrol vehicle, exiting my vehicle and ordering the female subject to come over to me and to stand in front of my patrol vehicle.

As the female subject stood in front of my patrol vehicle, I contacted New Mexico State Police Sergeant Wright via a telephone call, notifying him that I located a female subject matching the description of the armed robbery/carjacking suspect we were looking for. As I was on the telephone call with Sergeant Wright, I asked the female subject if she possessed an ID card. As I disconnected the telephone call with Sergeant

Wright, the female subject threw her food and drink items that she was carrying onto the ground, and started to flee, sprinting eastbound on Candelaria Road from my patrol vehicle.


I immediately began to pursue the female subject on foot, pursing and sprinting after her on foot eastbound on Candelaria Road. I shouted to the female while I was pursuing and sprinting after her "Ima tase you" in attempts to deter the female subject from fleeing on foot and to have her stop. As the female kept sprinting eastbound on Candelaria Road, then sprinting south towards the Jule-Art building, I then shouted "taser", aiming and deploying my Axon Taser (Serial Number: X29008ECD) towards the female subject, as the female was gaining distance on me and not stopping. The taser deployment was successful, with the taser prongs successfully striking the female subject on her leg and what appeared to be her back. The female immediately went to the ground as a result of the successful taser deployment. As the female laid on the ground, I advised her to not move. As the female continued to move on the ground, disregarding my instructions, I activated my arc switch on my axon taser, activating my taser once again in attempts to gain compliance from the female. The female stated to me "I'm sorry, I'm sorry" and stopped moving.

I notified New Mexico State Police Communications that I was in a foot pursuit with the female subject and advised my location and to start me medical attention and rescue for the female subject. I continued to order the female subject who was still laying on the ground, as well as the male subject prone out on the sidewalk, to stay on the ground, to not move, and to keep their hands up and visible until assisting New Mexico State Police Officers arrived at my location.





Incident Summary

On August 7, 2021 at approximately 5:12 p.m, Officer Fares Martinez was given a call for service. The call for service was located on 219 Paradise Lane in Bosque, NM. Officer Martinez was involved in a use of force where he went hands on with Anselmo Chavez as he tried to place him in Handcuffs.

Officer Martinez did not enter the incident into Blue team because he did not have access to the system. Office reached out to Captain Mendoza but he had retired and later reached out to Lt. Eric Armijo from Internal Affairs. Officer Fares was on special assignment in Albuquerque for a speed operation for two weeks. Officer Martinez submitted a letter to resign shortly after returning to district.

I am submitting this use of force incident in place of Officer Martinez.

I have reviewed the Use of Force incident which involved Officer Fares Martinez while responding to a call for service, domestic dispute involving husband and wife. Officer Fares Martinez was assisted by Socorro County Sheriffs Office, Deputy Freddy Garza. I reviewed the video and audio to both officers who were involved in the incident. They are attached to this incident.

The below is what I observed while reviewing the video belonging to Officer Fares:

- 1. Officer Martinez talking to Mr. Chavez while standing on opposite sides of a private fence.
- 2. I walked up to the scene and asked Mr. Chavez to open the gate and talk to the officer.
- 3. Mr. Chavez refused to come outside the gate. I wanted him to come outside the gate because he had the opportunity to return to his home and obtain a weapon. The wife indicated to dispatch there were weapons in the home.

- 4. I opened the gate and Officer Garza went around me and took Mr. Chavez to the ground. The video shows Mr. Chavez took a defensive position when we entered the gate.
- 5. The video shows Mr. Chavez fell to the ground and placed his hands between him and the ground, he was facing down actively resisting.
- 6. I observed on the video Officer Garza delivered a right knee strike to the back left side belonging to Mr. Chavez.
- 7. Officer Martinez was trying to get control of Mr. Chavez hands as Mr. Chavez actively resisted.
- 8. The two officer's gained control and handcuffed Mr. Chavez after a short struggle.
- 9. The video shows I stood to the side keeping the dogs from biting the officers and Mr. Chavez.
- 10. Officer Martinez and I were not wearing our hat at the time.

I did review Officer Garza's video and the below is what was observed of the incident.

- 1. Officer Garza's video fell immediately off of his body and fell to the ground.
- 2. The video shows me attempting to keep the dogs from biting the officer as they try to gain to apprehend Mr. Chavez.
- 3. The black dog did grab Officer Martinez right ankle during the struggle, the officer was not hurt by the bite the dog grabbed the boot.

The below is my finding of the incident:


- 1. Sgt. Salazar was not recording and not wearing his hat. I was not recording because my watch guard body camera battery died.
- 2. I did have my tazer in hand but never deployed, it is an indication of use of force.
- 3. Officer Fares Martinez was not wearing his hat.
- 4. Officer Fares Martinez used the necessary amount of force during the encounter, he did not exceed the force necessary to apply handcuffs on a male who was actively resisting the officer.
- 5. Officer Garza placed his right knee on the back of Mr. Chavez neck, Officer Garza is the officer who delivered a knee strike to Mr. Chavez upper back.

Overall, I was in violation of the recording policy and not wearing my hat. I will make sure my battery is sufficiently always charged and make sure my hat is always worn. The recording policy was violated and hat's not worn. Officer Fares Martinez did not exceed the amount of force necessary to make the arrest on Mr. Chavez. Mr. Chavez did sustain a broken rib which was caused by Officer Garza, the video clearly shows Officer Garza delivering the knee strike. I am not able to enter Officer Fares Martinez as the primary officer because he is no longer with the department. Officer Garza video of the incident is not attached but is available to be reviewed.


When I got to his residence, I observed Mr. Palmer with his child walking up the stairs to his apartment. I opened my door and advised him that he was under arrest, at that time he attempted to evade me by running to his front door. When we arrived at his front door, I garbed him by his arm and told him to put his child down and come with me. He then pulled away and closed the door striking the right side of my body. As Mr. Palmer slammed the door on me, I believed he was attempting to evade with any force necessary. I was then able to open the door and escort him back outside to my patrol unit.

As we were walking down the stairs Mr. Palmer became argumentative and was refusing to walk down the stairs. I then grabbed Mr. Palmers Left arm and placed him in the escort position as per my training. I escorted him to the bottom of the stairs where I attempted to place handcuffs on him. Mr. Palmer pulled away at that time. I was able to handcuff him and escorted him to my patrol unit. While at my patrol unit Mr. Palmer stiffened up and began pushing back against me. I then escorted him to the ground to regain control of him. Mr. Palmer did not sustain any injuries during the altercation.




On August 11, 2021, I, Juan Cordova, was on duty driving a marked patrol unit, wearing my full uniform displaying my badge of office in Sandoval County, New Mexico. I was on the I25 exit to US 550 parked at the red light, when I observed a white in color passenger car bearing NM license plate AGTT05. I ran the license plate in my unit and it returned as STOLEN. I initiated my emergency lights and siren and the vehicle fled west on US 550. The vehicle continued to flee at a high rate of speed on NM 313 passing in a no passing zone where other vehicles were present and driving speeds up to 80 mph. The vehicle exited NM 313 at the Pueblo Overpass east on I25 and at this point I was able to successfully perform a PIT maneuver on the vehicle. I observed that the vehicle was traveling less than 30 mph when making the turn, and I accelerated on the drivers side then made contact with the drivers side rear bumper with my passenger side push bumper of my patrol unit. This caused the suspect vehicle to lose control and swerve left striking a guard rail directly over I25. The vehicle then bounced off of the guard rail and struck the opposite guard rail on the south side of the overpass, then came to a stop as the vehicle was disabled, and the suspects were safely taken into custody.



Incident Summary

On August 12, 2021, at approximately 03:45 PM, I, was on duty in full uniform displaying my badge of office. I was patrolling in a marked unit in Velarde, New Mexico and County of Rio Arriba. I was assisting Adult Probation and Parole (APPO) in conducting a home visit on a probationer identified as Jeremy Sanchez, who is considered a high-risk target. The Target Residence is the listed residence provided as Jeremy Sanchez's residence through Adult Probation and Parole. The address to the residence is 816 County Road 57 Lyden. This home visit was conducted in conjunction with an operational plan with the Espanola Police Department.

As officers arrived at the residence, I observed Jeremy Sanchez and an unidentified male, not wearing a shirt, standing outside of the residence. As officers drove onto the property, the unidentified male ran into the residence through the front door. I approached the residence and conducted a walk around of the exterior to assure the unidentified male did not run out of the residence through the back door, while APPO entered the residence. After assuring the male did not run outside, I proceeded inside the residence. As I entered, APPO Leonard Martinez advised me to check the dryer. I approached the dryer, and observed the dryer door fluttering, commands were given for the male to open the dryer to which he did not comply. 

Incident Summary

On Saturday, August 14, 2021, at 1557 hours, I assisted TCPD officers who were on a call at a business, and not answering welfare checks. As I approached the business, I saw through the front windows that TCPD officers were actively struggling with a suspect. The officers had the suspect pinned against a wall inside the business. I saw TCPD Officer Frazier had control of the suspects left arm and Officer Bloomquist had control of his right arm. I heard the suspect yelling. I approached and told the suspect to calm down. I grabbed his right arm at his wrist with my left hand. Officer Bloomquist told me the suspect was armed.

The suspect was armed with a handgun and actively resisting so I pulled my department issued X2 Taser and pointed it at the suspect. I still had control of his right wrist with my left hand and held the Taser in my right hand. Officer Frazier had control of the suspects left wrist. I saw the suspect had baggy loose clothing. I looked for an area on the suspects body where I could effectively deploy the Taser if I chose to, though thought it would likely be ineffective due to the loose clothing so I decided not to deploy it. I was also concerned I may inadvertently hit and expose Officer Frazier.

Officer Bloomquist was able to free one of his hands while I had control of the suspect's right arm. Officer Bloomquist was able to grab the suspects firearm. The firearm was concealed on the suspects waist. Officer Bloomquist grabbed and threw the firearm across the floor of the business.

I ordered the suspect to put his hands behind his back and he said "no." All three of us ordered the suspect to get on the ground. The suspect pulled back as we tried to pull his arms. I grabbed the back of the suspect near his right shoulder with my right hand and my left hand was still gripping his right wrist. I pulled

the suspect toward me and down while Officer Bloomquist tripped him with his left leg. The suspect fell to the ground on his back. He continued to flail his legs and pull his arms away from us. I told him to turn onto his stomach and he would not comply. He replied at one point "fuck no." I placed my knees on his upper torso and used my body weight to pin him to the ground. The suspect's chin and mouth went up against my upper shin on my right leg. I was concerned he was going to bite me, so I pushed his face to the side with an open hand and moved my leg so he couldn't.

We continually told him to turn over onto his stomach and he did not comply. Officer Bloomquist unholstered his department issued Taser. He pointed it at the suspect and spark tested it. Once the Taser was sparked the suspect reached toward it, receiving a short shock. The suspect began yelling, saying "no" and "that shit hurts."

I grabbed the suspects right arm and yanked it back toward me to turn him onto his stomach. The suspect turned over and then tried to get up. I pushed the back of his neck with my right hand and forced him back down onto the ground. I put my knees on his back and used my bodyweight to pin him to the ground. Officer Frazier placed hand restraints on his left hand. The suspect tucked his right hand under his body and would not provide it. I held the suspects left hand while Officer Frazier and Bloomquist gained control of his right hand. The suspect was secured in hand restraints at that time. The suspect continued flailing his legs and trying to get up.

I held him down until he calmed down. We then helped him up and walked him to the back of a TCPD unit. The suspect told us he was not injured. I saw red marks on his forehead, which were photographed. TCPD Officer Bloomquist transported the suspect to the Sierra Vista Hospital where he was evaluated and released with no injuries. The suspect was identified as Gilbert Robledo. The incident was witnessed by an employee who was identified as Juan Contreras.

TCPD is the primary agency in this incident. Robledo was booked into the Sierra County Detention Center for Aggravated Burglary, Battery on a Peace Officer, Felon in Possession of a Firearm, unlawful carry of a firearm, concealing identity and Resisting, Evading or Obstructing an Officer. TCPD is following up and other charges are pending.

I arrived on scene witnessing Officer Torrez attempting to gain control of a male subject, I exited my unit and proceeded to help assist to place the male subject, later identified as Mr. Michael Tapia, in investigative detention by securing his left arm, wrist, and proceeded to place his hands behind his back with the reasonable amount of force necessary.

As we proceeded to place him in the back of the unit, he would tense up and push back. At this moment I preceded to physically push with a reasonable amount of force on Mr. Tapia's chest area to trey and get him into the back seat of Officer Torrez patrol unit.

As Mr. Tapia was speaking with EMS personnel, he proceeded to try and kick me in between my legs toward my genital area, in which I proceeded to forcible push Mr. Tapia within arm's length away from me to keep him off balance. After this incident Mr. Tapia proceeded to lunge at medical personnel headfirst in an aggressive manner, in which I proceeded to pull him towards the rear right panel of Officer Torrez patrol unit. I then proceeded to place my palm on his chin area and push his chin in an upward motion to stop him from lunging forward with this head.

I proceeded to help place Mr. Tapia in the back of Officer Torrez patrol unit in which he proceeded to kick me in my right hand, in which I proceeded to hold down his legs near the knee area to stop him from kicking.

As Mr. Tapia was medically cleared for Alta Vista Regional Hospital, we proceeded to try and place him in the back of Officer Torrez patrol unit. I proceeded to push in a continuous motion on Mr. Tapia's right side to place him in the back if the unit unaware that is was holding onto the bottom of the wheel well. While I was pushing Mr. Tapia, he proceeded to let go of the wheel well and his right side of his head hit the support beam of the patrol vehicle.





Incident Summary

Mr. Tapia kept walking towards me, and I told him again, at this time he complied. As I was conducting a Terry Frisk for his and my safety, Mr. Tapia begin to push against me and turned around in an aggressive manner and proceeded to take a fighting stance. I told Mr. Tapia again to place his hands on my patrol vehicle after pulling away, which he complied. Mr. Tapia begin to drop his body towards the ground as I attempted to check for any weapons. I grabbed Mr. Tapia's right wrist with my right hand and his right shoulder area with my left hand. NMSP Officer Anthony Robinson arrived on scene to assist with detaining Mr. Tapia. I gained control of Mr. Tapia's right arm. Mr. Tapia continued to resist; I applied the right amount of force to Mr. Tapia's right shoulder/arm area against my left front side vehicle to gain control. Officer Robinson was to able retrieve his handcuffs to place on Mr. Tapia's hands which were behind his back, double locking them for his safety.

Emergency Medical Service (EMS) arrived on scene to check Mr. Tapia for any medical issues. Mr. Tapia begin lunging toward EMS personnel and kicking their equipment, at that time we tried placing Mr. Tapia back inside the vehicle. Mr. Tapia began kicking and not obeying verbal commands given to stop kicking. To shut the door on the patrol vehicle, I proceeded to try and hold down Mr. Tapia's legs and noticed he was attempting to still kick his legs. I gained control of his right leg putting it on top of his left and held them by the ankle area. EMS personnel assisted with holding Mr. Tapia's legs in that position while I placed ankle restraints on Mr. Tapia's ankles.

Mr. Tapia was medically cleared for incarceration. Officer Robinson and I attempted to place Mr. Tapia inside my patrol vehicle. Mr. Tapia with his right hand grabbed the rear right side wheel well on my patrol vehicle to resist being placed inside the backseat. I told Mr. Tapia to get inside the vehicle and he continued to resist. I had Mr. Tapia by his right-side bicep with my right hand and my left hand was on his back area. I applied reasonable amount of force to aid Mr. Tapia to place him inside of my patrol unit and Mr. Tapia's grip on the wheel well loosened. Mr. Tapia's right-side of his head hit the metal support beam of the cage. I asked Mr. Tapia if he needed medical attention, which he said "no".




On September 16, 2021 I was patrolling on US 84/285 within the county of Rio Arriba. At approximately 09:52 AM, I observed a white Chevrolet Cruz traveling north bound at a high rate of speed. I confirmed the speed (with my radar) to be 60MPH in a 45MPH construction zone. I turned around and attempted to catch up to the vehicle. As I got behind the vehicle, I initiated my emergency equipment and attempted to make a traffic stop. The vehicle pulled off the roadway and was coming to a slow roll. The vehicle continued the slow roll for approximately 45 seconds. The vehicle then appeared to come to a stop. I observed the driver side door open for a brief second. The door then abruptly closed and the vehicle accelerated and drove off. I followed the vehicle with my emergency equipment and engaged a vehicle pursuit. With my emergency equipment engaged the vehicle continued to flee as it traveled north on US Highway 84. The vehicle then turned left onto County Road 135. After getting onto County Road 135 the vehicle then turned right onto County Road 456. As we traveled west on County Road 456 I observed on opportunity to safely attempt a Pursuit Intervention Technique Under 35 MPH at 19 MPH. The attempt was unsuccessful and the vehicle continued to flee. The vehicle then turned right onto an un-named dirt trail. As we continued down the dirt trail, the vehicle started to gain distance. As the vehicle took a sharp right curve, I observed the vehicle once again and I sped up to catch up to the vehicle. The vehicle then came to an abrupt stop. I was unable to stop my vehicle fast enough due to the amount of sand on the roadway and collided with the rear of the vehicle. I then observed a male with a red shirt and blue jean shorts exit the driver door and flee on foot. I pursued the

male on foot while giving him verbal commands. The male continued to flee. As we ran through the trees and brush, I deployed my taser. The taser deployment was unsuccessful. The male continued to flee. The male then stopped and turned around and faced me. I deployed my taser to prevent the male from fleeing once again. The deployment was unsuccessful and the male fled again. I eventually lost the male on foot as he ran through a residential area. After further investigation, the male was located inside a residence and placed under arrest without further incident. The male was cuffed behind his back with the double locked activated. The male was transported to the Espanola Presbyterian Hospital where he was cleared for incarceration.





Incident Summary

On September 19, 2021, I was patrolling the city of Los Lunas, NM in Valencia County. On this day I was clearly wearing badge of office and wearing my Class A uniform. I was also driving a marked patrol unit. At 2300 I received a call from dispatch about a wrong way driver on I-25 going north on the south bound lane. Dispatch advised me we had received more than 5 calls about this individual. One of the reporting parties was following the vehicle and giving us updates on the location of said vehicle.

One of the reporting parties was able to give us the description of the vehicle: a red in color Chevrolet truck.

New Mexico State Police Officer Najera was a few miles behind me and was attempting to set up spikes somewhere around mile marker 190.

I was able to encounter said vehicle around mile marker 185. The vehicle was on my lane/ fast lane going around 70 miles per hour. I positioned my unit on the west side shoulder and waited for the vehicle to pass me. Once the vehicle passed, I quickly accelerated and attempted to do a traffic stop.

I got behind the vehicle and attempted a traffic stop, but vehicle refused to stop. New Mexico State Police Sergeant Kuehl had advised me to do a PIT maneuver over 35 miles per hour if the vehicle did not stop.

Since the vehicle was not stopping and was travelling at 70 miles per hour at oncoming traffic it was my legal obligation to remove the vehicle and make the road safe. I accelerated and attempted to PIT the vehicle but there was a vehicle coming on the other lane. Once we passed that vehicle, I performed a successful PIT on

the vehicle. The red truck went into the west shoulder and rolled over. My patrol unit travelled to the median and got stuck in the dirt.

The truck came to a rest on its roof. Since the red truck rolled over, I immediately called for an ambulance and a fire truck. Once Officer Najera came to my location, we started to do an approach to the vehicle. I could hear a man's voice inside the vehicle. There was absolutely no way for the individual to exit the vehicle unless we broke the driver side window. The individual came out and was placed under arrest.







Incident Summary

On September 22, 2021, at approximately 1600 hours I did a welfare check on a stranded motorist at the 191-mile marker on Interstate 40 westbound in Torrance County. I arrived to find Haiyan Deng in a silver Honda CRV with a blown tire. I checked on her, she stated she had people coming from Albuquerque to help her so I left the area.

I then received a call at approximately 1900 hours from Sergeant Joshua Campos who notified me the vehicle welfare check I made earlier with Haiyan Deng, was reported as a homicide suspect out of New York. Sergeant Campos indicated she may have a gun, to not let her back in the vehicle, and to watch her hands at all times.

I made contact with Ms. Deng again and began speaking with her outside of her vehicle. She stated she wanted a sweater out of her car. I told her I would retrieve the sweater as I did not know if anyone else was in the car or if there were any weapons in the car. She then attempted to go to the passenger front door. I stopped her, took hold of her arm, and placed one handcuff on her right wrist. She immediately started resisting me so I pushed her up against the SUV. I attempted to handcuff her and she was actively resisting me by holding her arm away from me, not allowing me to pull it behind her to handcuff her left arm. She was able to pull the front passenger door open, causing me to place her down on the ground. I laid on her to prevent her from fighting me further, returning to the vehicle, or fleeing the area. She kept her left arm under her and would not comply with my orders to give me her arm. I was then able to get both of her arms in front of her while holding her down.

I then placed her in investigative detention and checked her for weapons, finding none. I reported the incident to Sergeant Josh Campos and Lieutenant Jeremy Vaughan.






On May 13, 2021, I made a traffic stop on Interstate 40 near milepost 167. I made contact with Nikolas Johnson, the driver of the vehicle. Mr. Johnson refused to sign the traffic citation while on traffic stop. I asked Mr. Johnson to step out of his vehicle several times while I was standing at his driver-side door open. With my left hand, I grabbed Mr. Johnson's left wrist telling him to step out of his vehicle. Mr. Johnson refused to step out pulling away from me. While holding Mr. Johnson's left wrist, giving him commands to step out I placed my handcuff around his left wrist with my right hand. Mr. Johnson stepped out of his vehicle and I escorted him to the front of my police unit with one handcuff on. Mr. Johnson was resisting arrest while I was placing the second handcuff behind his back. After the second handcuff was placed behind Mr. Johnson's back, he continued trying to pull away from me while searching his pant pockets. Mr. Johnson kept trying to pull away from my grip around his bicep. I verbally warned Mr. Johnson if he continued to keep pulling away from me, he was going to be placed on the ground. With my foot, I swept Mr. Johnson's feet from under him placing him on the ground for our safety.

Mr. Johnson did not complain of any injuries, nor did I observe any. I did not sustain any injuries during the encounter. Sergeant Kurtis Ward was briefed on the matter and reviewed the video of the incident with me. I had some periods of green screen on my video, which was reported to my direct supervisor, Lieutenant Jeremy Vaughan.







Incident Summary

On September 28, 2021, at approximately 05:54 AM. I was traveling southbound on highway 84/285 near mile post 187. Officer Jerome Martinez with the New Mexico State Police conducted a traffic stop on a black in color pickup for running two red lights. I stopped to check on Officer Martinez for officer safety. I exited my patrol unit and was standing by my driver side door as Officer Martinez made a passenger side approach on the pickup. I observed the driver of the pickup yelling at Officer Martinez. Officer Martinez directed the driver to turn off the vehicle and to exit the pickup. The driver continued to argue with Officer Martinez and eventually the driver complied and exited the pickup slamming the driver door.


The driver was directed to stand in front of Officer Martinez patrol unit. The driver was highly irate and said "suck my dick, I'm right fucking here" as the driver was standing near the tailgate of the pickup. The driver was given multiple directives to stand in front of the unit for officer safety not knowing if the driver had any weapons or if he was attempting to get one from bed of the pickup due to his aggressive behavior. I advised the driver, he was being detained for the traffic violation and Officer Martinez needed to run his information for his investigation and to proceed to the unit as he was directed. The driver then got closer to the pickup and turned his body getting closer to the driver side; looking towards the driver side of the pickup. From the drivers demeanor, I directed the driver to not get closer to the driver door to make sure he would not get back into the pickup to evade officers.

As the driver turned my direction to walk towards the patrol unit. The driver said, "fucking people bug me bro". As the driver began walking towards the patrol unit, the driver walked in close proximity of me and flared his right arm in my direction and said "move!". The driver was directed to not touch me. The driver stopped walking and turned around closing distance with me in a bladed stance making his hands into a closed fist. I was in fear of receiving a battery from the male and how close he was to me. The driver said, "I didn't fucking touch you", for officer safety, the driver was directed to get back. I placed my hands on the driver's chest in attempts to create space between the driver and myself. The driver was then placed on the hood of the patrol unit. The driver continued to resist officers' control. I then grabbed the drivers left leg and swept his foot to get the male on the ground to regain control. The driver was directed to place his hands behind his back but to no avail. The driver continued to resist on the ground by not allowing officers to place handcuffs behind his back. The driver complied with directives and handcuffs were placed behind the drivers back which were double locked.







Incident Summary

On September 24, 2021, New Mexico State Police Intel Bureau issued a BOLO – Attempt to Locate bulletin in reference to kidnapping investigation New Mexico State Police Agent Cruzita Romero was currently investigating. Included in the bulletin, was a silver and black Mitsubishi Mirage which was believed to be occupied by Lucas Naranjo and Aspen Newman, both suspects in the kidnapping investigation. The vehicle was bearing New Mexico Registration plate PXR018.

On September 28, 2021, at approximately 06:02 PM, I, Officer Estevan Trujillo was traveling westbound on State Road 76 milepost 4 and observed said vehicle traveling eastbound on State Road 76. I conducted a uturn and began traveling eastbound on State Road 76, later catching up to said vehicle. As the vehicle continued traveling eastbound approaching milepost 6, I activated my emergency equipment and attempted to conduct a traffic stop with said vehicle.

Once my emergency equipment was activated, said vehicle failed to stop and began fleeing from me eastbound on State Road 76 milepost 6. The vehicle made a left turn onto County Road 87 and later made a left turn onto County Road 89. The vehicle continued traveling at rate of speed higher than the posted speed limit of 25 mile per hour, through a residential area. The vehicle continued fleeing on County Road 89 before merging back onto County Road 87 and failing to stop for a posted stop sign. Once back on County Road 87 the vehicle continued fleeing and later merged onto County Road 95. The vehicle continued traveling on County Road 96 and later made a right turn and continued traveling westbound onto State Road 76 failing to stop for a posted stop sign. The vehicle continued fleeing traveling at speeds higher then the posted speed limit of 35 and over

taking vehicles in a no passing zone. As the vehicle continued westbound on State Road 76 milepost 6, New Mexico State Police Officer Migel Flores deployed his department issued tire deflation device (stop sticks) and successfully deflated the two front tires and the right rear tire of the vehicle. The vehicle continued fleeing westbound on State Road 76 with 3 deflated tires and gradually lost the tires until the vehicle was traveling on rims. As the vehicle continued on State Road 76 milepost 4, the vehicles speeds decreased within 35 miles per hour at which point I initiated a pursuit intervention technique (PIT) but was unable to disable the vehicle.

After the pit, the vehicle continued fleeing westbound on State Road 76, as it was nearing the intersection of County Road 88, New Mexico State Police Officer Elizabeth Ogaz attempted to deploy her department issued stop sticks but was unsuccessful. The vehicle continued fleeing westbound on State Road 76 it began having difficulty maneuvering due to the deflated tires. As the vehicle approached the intersection of State Road 76 and State Road 106, New Mexico State Police Sergeant Dezjuan Shields was stationary, outside of his unit, attempting to direct eastbound traffic off the roadway to avoid a collision with said vehicle. As the vehicle passed Sergeant Shields, he was able to positively identify Lucas Naranjo as the driver of said vehicle.

The vehicle continued fleeing westbound on State Road 76 and as it approached the intersection of South McCurdy Road, the vehicle traveled into the eastbound lane passing a car stopped a red traffic light and traveled through the intersection failing to stop for a posted red light and continued fleeing westbound on State Road 76.

As the vehicle approached the intersection of State Road 68, New Mexico State Police Dispatch advised to terminate the pursuit per Sergeant Shields, at which point I deactivated my emergency equipment. After deactivating my emergency equipment, I continued traveling westbound on State Road 76 and observed said vehicle make a right turn onto State Road 68 and the vehicle continued traveling northbound on State Road 68 until I lost visual.

An identification inquiry on Mr. Naranjo revealed his New Mexico Driver's License was suspended and it also showed two active warrants issued for his arrest. The first warrant was issued on the charge of Kidnapping, Aggravated Battery, Conspiracy, Aggravated Assault and Intimidation of a Witness. The second warrant was issued for failure to appear on traffic offense.

Incident Summary

On September 29th, 2021, I, New Mexico State Police (NMSP) Officer Alexander Apodaca was on duty in Bernalillo County, in the state of New Mexico (NM), in full uniform, displaying my badge of office and was driving a fully marked NMSP patrol vehicle.

While at the Dion's restaurant for lunch, I was contacted by a witness who stated she observed a vehicle burglary. I checked the vehicle and confirmed that the vehicle had been broken into. I identified the victim of the burglary and asked for a time delay and a description of the perpetrator. I was given a description of a male wearing dark colored pants and a black sweater. I started to process the scene by taking photographs when the witness stated that the described male was back in the parking lot.

I approached the male subject and asked to speak with him. The male, who was later identified as Mr. Steven Torres, ran on foot in an attempt to evade police. I yelled multiple commands to stop while chasing Mr. Torres on foot in the parking lot of Dion's. I warned Mr. Torres that if he continued to run I would Tase him. I yelled the warning multiple times. Two undercover federal agents tried to stop Mr. Torres from running by standing in his way. Mr. Torres ignored my commands. One of the federal agents attempted to grab Mr. Torres to prevent him from running but was unsuccessful.


I thought Mr. Torres had pushed the agent out of the way to evade police. Mr. Torres continued to run. I

deployed my department issued Taser device. The prongs struck Mr. Torres and Mr. Torres fell to the ground. I immediately ran to Mr. Torres' location and attempted to handcuff him. Mr. Torres would not voluntarily provide his arms for the handcuffs. NMSP Officer Eric Jackson and the two undercover federal agents assisted in handcuffing Mr. Torres. Officer Jackson called for an ambulance and Central Communications dispatch notified NMSP Sergeant Kurtis Ward of the incident. The undercover federal agents were later identified as Mr. Clarence Davis and Mr. Frank Chavez of the DEA. A short time later, the ambulance arrived and removed the Taser prongs from Mr. Torres. The ambulance decided to transport Mr. Torres to the hospital for a full examination. This is a synopsis of events, for full details refer to body/dash camera video of the incident.

My body camera was inoperative and was replaced the following day.





Incident Summary

On Wednesday September 6, 2021 at approximately 5:06 PM, I Officer Joshua Martinez of the New Mexico State Police was on duty in my official capacity displaying my badge of office #122. I was patrolling in the Village of Chimayo, County of Rio Arriba.

ASSIGNMENT

I was patrolling New Mexico Highway 76 near mile post 5 in Chimayo setting up for a traffic operation.

ARRIVAL/INVESTIGATION

I was parked on the shoulder of NM 76 near mile post 5 with New Mexico State Police Office James Jeantete. Officer Jeantete visually witnessed a gray in color sedan traveling eastbound on Highway 76 with no registration plate. Officer Jeantete merged onto Highway 76 to conduct a traffic stop on said vehicle. I proceeded after him. The sedan started to accelerate at a higher rate of speed than the posted speed limit of 40 mph. The gray sedan merged into the westbound lane no traveling in the opposite lane of travel passing other motor vehicles in a no passing zone. We initiated our emergency lights and sirens. The driver failed to bring the vehicle to a stop and proceeded to flee eastbound at a high rate of speed. I notified dispatch I would take over communications for the pursuit.

The Hyundai sedan continue to flee eastbound until it made an immediate left turn onto County Road 95

northbound. Officer Jeantete initiated a PIT on the driver side rear fender while the speeds were below 30mph. The driver accelerated as he attempted to PIT but was unsuccessful. Officer Jeantete attempted to PIT the passenger side of the vehicle as the road started to narrow but was unsuccessful. Officer Jeantete moved back to the driver side to PIT, which was successful and stopped the fleeing vehicle. The vehicle came to a complete stop, the driver later identified as Luke Velasquez and the passenger later identified as Reynaldo Dominguez immediately exited the vehicle.

Luke and Reynaldo were given lawful verbal commands to stop, both occupants fled on foot evading arrest. Officer Jeantete pursued after Reynaldo, after he failed to comply with lawful orders and continued to flee on foot. I pursed after Luke as he fled on foot down a private driveway. I gave Luke multiple verbal commands to stop or I would deploy my department issued taser. Luke ignored my commands and continued to flee. Luke proceeded to run down the driveway and around to the back yard of the residence. Unknown if Luke was armed or if he would find a weapon of opportunity in the backyard, I warned Luke I was going to deploy my department issued taser. I announced taser taser taser and deployed but missed. I deployed my second taser cartridge and made contact with Luke in his upper shoulder and small of his back. The taser was effective rendering Luke unable to continue fleeing on foot. I was able to take Luke into custody without further incident.
