Man Dies from Injuries in May Shooting

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Homicide Branch are investigating a May shooting that killed a man in Northwest, D.C.

On **Thursday, May 18**, 2023, at approximately 6:54 p.m., Third District officers responded to the intersection of 1st Street and Q Street, Northwest, for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a man with gunshot wound injuries. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment of critical injuries. Shortly after, another man was located at a local hospital with a non-life-threatening gunshot wound.

On Sunday, October 1, 2023, the critically injured man died while receiving treatment for his injuries. He has been identified as **28-year-old Malik Lyons**, of Bowie, MD.

The Metropolitan Police Department currently offers a reward of up to **\$25,000** to anyone that provides information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for each homicide committed in the District of Columbia.
