

OVERVIEW
The study was conducted for CNN by SSRS with a representative sample of registered voters in Nevada. SSRS is an independent research company. Surveys were obtained online ( $\mathrm{n}=895$ ) and by telephone ( $n=356$ ) for a total sample of $n=1,251$, from September 29-October 6, 2023. The margin of sampling error for total registered voters is $+/-4.6$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The design effect is $\mathbf{2 . 8 0}$. The study includes an oversample of registered Republicans in order to reach a total of 650 likely Republican caucusgoers. For results among likely Republican caucusgoers, the margin of sampling error is +/- 5.3. The oversample of registered Republicans was weighted to its proper size within results for the full population of registered voters. Results for subgroups with fewer than $\mathrm{N}=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "SN" because samples of that size carry larger margins of sampling error and can be too small to be projectable with confidence to their true values in the population.

## MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of $n=\mathbf{1 , 2 5 1}$ registered voters who live in Nevada were surveyed online and by telephone from a registrationbased sample purchased by SSRS from L2. Sampled voters were invited to participate in the study through multiple contact methods, including a mailed postcard invitation to a random half of the sample, SMS (text-message) invitation in collaboration with Survey160 to a different random half of the sample (who had a cell phone number on record), email invitations to those with an email address, and multiple telephone call attempts to voters with a telephone number on record. Sampled voters who received the postcard could complete the survey online (including by scanning a QR code on mobile devices) or by calling into a toll-free number. All respondents were screened for age, state of residence, and voter registration status prior to administering the survey. Respondents who said they were under 18, living outside of Nevada, or not registered to vote were excluded from the survey. Surveys were conducted in English and Spanish.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $+/-4.6$ percentage points. Results for the sample of 650 likely Republican caucusgoers have a margin of sampling error of $+/-5.3$ percentage points.

Among the entire sample, 29\% described themselves as Democrats, $26 \%$ described themselves as Republicans, and $45 \%$ described themselves as independents or members of another party.

All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics. The entire sample was weighted to reflect Census figures for the state's registered voters for gender, age, education, and race/ethnicity. The sample was also weighed to parameters from the L2 voter file for party registration, primary vote history, home value, and National Election Pool (NEP) region. Finally, the sample was weighted among self-reported 2020 voters for recalled 2020 vote within NEP regions. The benchmark for recalled 2020 vote was taken from county-level National Election Pool (NEP) presidential election results provided by CNN. To offset the oversample of registered Republicans, the three categories of party registration (Republican, Democratic, and Other/Non-Partisan) were weighted to their correct share of L2's Nevada voter file.

Surveys were conducted among a representative sample of the adult registered voters, age 18 or older, of Nevada. Members of demographic groups not shown in the published crosstabs are represented in the results for each question in the poll. Crosstabs on the pages that follow only include results for subgroups with a minimum N=125 unweighted cases. Results for subgroups with fewer than $\mathrm{N}=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "SN" because samples of that size carry larger margins of sampling error and can be too small to be projectable with confidence to their true values in the population.
