A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ISRAEL AS IT DEFENDS

ITSELF IN THE WAR LAUNCHED BY THE TERRORIST

ORGANIZATION HAMAS; REQUESTING EMERGENCY

PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN

EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, early Saturday, militants from Gaza fired a deadly barrage of rockets and sent gunmen into southern Israeli territory in a large-scale surprise assault that killed hundreds of Israeli citizens; and

WHEREAS, innocent civilians, including women and children, have been targeted, taken hostage, injured and murdered in this series of attacks, including hundreds of concert attendees at the Tribe of Nova trance music festival near Kibbutz Reimat, "a tribal journey, where the essence of unity and love combines forces with the best music," according to the festival's website; and

WHEREAS, at least nine Americans have been killed in the attacks; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday, Israel declared war against Hamas, the Palestinian militant group based in Gaza; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville stands with Israel and condemns these
terrorist attacks; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby mourns lives lost through these violent acts and stands unequivocally allied with Israel as it defends itself in the war launched by the terrorist organization Hamas.

Requesting emergency passage upon introduction 1 Section 2. 2 pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage upon introduction 3 of this Resolution is requested due to the volatile war time conditions in Israel. 4 Section 3. Effective Date.
