I helped provide care for the children throughout 2017 by teaching them sign language, taking them to events and activities, preparing meals for them, changing their diapers, and buying them toys, clothes and food.

I have been the primary care giver for the minor children for the last three months, and would like them to maintain their current schedule while this matter is pending. Sage and Sadie are enrolled in a daycare program that they enjoy and are doing well with the stable schedule I have established. Before the minor children were in my care, they bounced around to different addresses with their mother, Jamie Clark, and were placed into foster care for a period of time.

Since their Mother, Jamie Clark, returned to Oregon in late November due to being evicted from her residence in Illinois, she has exercised sporadic parenting time. She has had parenting time on some weekends but no set schedule has been established. The most consistent schedule that their Mother has established is that she calls or video chats with the children during the week. I regularly attempt to facilitate time between Mother and the minor children by having the minor children regularly call Mother and offering parenting time to Mother. To the best of Petitioner's knowledge, Father has not had parenting time with the minor children since February 2017.

I love Sage and Sadie very much and have seen them advance in many ways since they have been in my care. Since the minor children came to live with me in November 2018, I have been their sole care provider. I have put the minor children on a schedule which provides them stability; something I can tell they enjoy and are benefitting from. For example, Sage has been learning her number and shapes while Sadie has learned to walk and run and how to use sign language to communicate. I work on these things with the girls on a daily basis. For all these reasons, I respectfully request that the court maintain the status quo for Sage and Sadie Clark until there is a further order from the court. ORS 109.767 (1) Declarations: A. I have not participated, as a party or witness or in any other capacity, in any other proceeding concerning the custody of or parenting time or visitation with the children other than Linn Co. Circuit Court Case No. 17DR17271 B. I know of no proceeding that could affect the current proceeding, including proceedings for enforcement and proceedings relating to domestic violence, protective orders, termination of parental rights and adoptions; C.
